Ouick Hits About The 'Hounds

- Loyola University Maryland men's soccer, which secured a first-round bye in the Patriot League tournament over the weekend, hosts American to conclude the 2019 regular season at 7 p.m. Wednesday night.
- The Greyhounds can finish no lower than second in the conference standings, and they can rise to first with a victory and a Lehigh loss to Bucknell.
- Loyola ranks 6th nationally in total assists (40), 10th in goals (38) and 13th in goals per game (2.24).
- Seniors Brian Saramago and Barry
 Sharifi were each named to the 2019
 MAC Hermann Trophy Watch List after
 earning third team All-America status
 last fall. Saramago is the Patriot League
 Preseason Offensive Player of the Year,
 while Sharifi was chosen as the conference's Preseason Midfielder of the Year.
- **Chase Vosvick** is the two-time defending Patriot League GK of the Year.
- Sixth-year head coach Steve Nichols has received three-straight Patriot League Coach of the Year awards.

Last Time Out

- Josh Fawole scored twice, and he assisted on a Brian Saramago strike to factor in all three goals during a 3-0 win at Boston University on Saturday.
- Fawole opened the scoring in the 55th minute, and he and **Davey Mason** set up Saramago's goal just 34 seconds later. Saramago set up Fawole for an insurance strike with 6:20 left in regulation
- The Greyhounds held BU (4-11-1, 3-5)
- without a shot on target in the victory. They have allowed just one shot on goal overall in the last 257 minutes of game
- Jonathan Sousa recorded the primary assist on Fawole's opener.
- Saramago moved into a tie for ninth all-time at Loyola in assists (23) and he is now tied for 14th in team history in goals (34).

Series History

- Loyola leads 26-15-5 in a series which dates back to 1949.
- The Greyhounds have a 4-2 advantage since joining the Patriot League in 2013.
 They have won the last three meetings overall, including the last two by identical 4-1 scorelines.
- Sam Brown, Nico Brown, Brian Saramago and David Gunter had the goals in last season's win at American, as Loyola scored on four of its nine shots in the contest.
- American's last victory in the series was a 3-0 triumph at Ridley on Oct. 7, 2015.

About the Eagles

- American (3-10-2, 3-4-1) enters in a three-way tie with Bucknell and Colgate for fifth
 place in the Patriot League standings. Those three teams, along with Boston University
 (4-11-1, 3-5) are fighting for the final two spots in this year's Patriot League tournament
- The Eagles would lose the three-way tiebreaker with Bucknell and Colgate; they need a result vs. Loyola and help from others to qualify for postseason play.
- American is coming off a 2-0 win against Army West Point on Saturday. Other league wins came against Holy Cross (1-0) and Lafayette (2-1).
- The Eagles rank last in the Patriot League in goals scored (10 in 15 games), assists (9) and shots per game (6.7). They lead the conference in saves per game (4.8).

Fawole Repeats as Patriot League Offensive Player of the Week

- **Josh Fawole** received his second-consecutive Patriot League weekly award on Monday after leading the Greyhound at Boston U over the weekend.
- The Columbia, Md., native has totaled seven goals and two assists in Loyola's last eight games, with the Greyhounds posting a record of 6-1-1 during that stretch.
- Fawole's five points on Saturday were a new career high. He also has a career-best 18 points (8 G, 2 A) on the year and he is up to 50 points overall at Loyola (20 G, 10 A).

Saramago Back Atop the Patriot League

- **Brian Saramago** recorded three more points at BU on Saturday, totaling a goal and an assist to maintain his status as the Patriot League's top scorer in 2019.
- Saramago has 25 points (8 G, 9 A) this season, surpassing his previous career-high of 24 during a 2018 campaign which led to third team United Soccer Coaches All-America recognition. He has 18 points (5 G, 8 A) during Loyola's last eight games.
- Saramago's nine assists are tied for fourth in all of Division I, and he is also ranked 22nd nationally in shots per game (3.59, 61 total).

Ouick Notes

1-0-0

- The Greyhounds are 7-1-1 since the start of October, outscoring opponents by a margin of 27-9 during that span. They have scored 16 goals in their last three victories at Ridley Athletic Complex.
- Loyola is 8-1 this season when scoring multiple goals, and 7-1-1 when holding opponents to one goal or fewer.
- The Greyhounds have outshot their opponents in 11 of 17 games, and they have tied or had a greater number of corner kicks in 14 of 17 contests.
- Eight Loyola players have combined for 14 Patriot League weekly awards so far in 2019, with Barry Sharifi (3x), Davey Mason (2x), Jonathan Sousa (2x), Chase Vosvick (2x), Josh Fawole (2x), Brian Saramago, Justin Ingram, and Eddy Rodriguez all earning recognition.
- Loyola is 26-6-3 in the regular season against Patriot League opponents over the past three-plus years under head coach Steve Nichols.
- Loyola's 2019 schedule included six games against teams which reached the NCAA tournament last fall, with the Greyhounds going 2-3-1 in those contests.
- Mason and Jacob Denison have started every game for the Greyhounds on the backline this season.

Program Turnaround under Nichols

- Sixth-year head coach Steve Nichols, a 1992 Loyola graduate, was hired to lead the Greyhounds men's soccer program on Feb. 6, 2014.
- After totaling a record of 7-21-6 (2-13-3 Patriot League) while rebuilding the program in his first two seasons, Nichols brought in Loyola's first-ever nationally-ranked recruiting class prior to the 2016 season.
- The Greyhounds went 31-17-5 (20-4-3 Patriot League) from 2016-18, topping the Patriot League regular season standings in both 2017 and 2018.
- Loyola was ranked No. 23 in the final United Soccer Coaches Top 25 poll of the 2018 regular season, entering the national rankings for the first time since 2009. The Greyhounds were included among schools receiving votes in this year's preseason Division I poll.
- Loyola is searching for its first Patriot League championship this season. A Patriot League title would clinch the program's first NCAA tournament appearance since 2009.

More on Saramago, Sharifi

- **Brian Saramago** is one of 12 players in Patriot League history to be named first team all-conference three times, and he has also been named All-Northeast Region in each of his three years at Loyola.
- Saramago (34 G, 23 A) is tied for 14th in program history in career goals, tied for 9th in career assists and alone in 14th in career points (91). He totaled eight goals and eight assists last season
- **Barry Sharifi** received his second-straight Patriot League Midfielder of the Year honor in 2018 after totaling four goals and four assists across 17 starts. He has 19 career goals, and he is tied for 15th all-time at Loyola with 19 assists.
- Saramago and Sharifi became Loyola's first All-America honorees since 2008 last fall.

More on Vosvick

- **Chase Vosvick** has earned first team All-Northeast Region status in each of his first two collegiate seasons. He is 28-16-3 with a 1.08 goals-against average, a .720 save percentage and 17 shutouts through his first 48 appearances at Loyola.
- Vosvick has limited opponents to one goal or fewer in 19 of his 21 collegiate starts at Ridley Athletic Complex.

Other All-Patriot League Returners

- Sr. F Josh Fawole (5 G, 2 A), Sr. F Nico Brown (5 G, 1 A), Sr. D Davey Mason (1 G, 1 A) and Jr. M Sam Brown (3 G, 3 A) were all second team All-Patriot League honorees in 2018, while Sr. D Jonathan Sousa landed on the third team after contributing to a backline which surrendered just 12 goals all season.
- Fawole was named second team All-Patriot League for a second-straight season. He
 currently has 20 goals (including eight game-winners) and 10 assists during his time at
 Loyola.

Sharifi. Lussi to Captain Squad in 2019

- Senior midfielders Barry Sharifi and Morgan Lussi will serve as team captains for the 2019 season.
- Sharifi leads all active Greyhounds with 65 career starts and 69 career appearances...
- Lussi is a three-year starter who has cracked the Starting XI 33 times overall.
- Lussi's goal at Appalachian State on Sept. 1 was his first since the 2018 season opener, a 3-0 victory over Rutgers.

Nine Newcomers Join the Fold

- There are a total of nine new Greyhounds among the 2019 roster of 30 student-athletes. Jr. M Justin Ingram joins as a transfer from the University of Virginia, while Jack Caldwell, Johan Granados, Jack Hosmer, Albert Kang, Matthew Lala, Spencer Nattans, Daniel Osuji and Kristinn Pétursson make up the incoming Class of 2023.
- Ingram won a USL2 National Championship while playing for Flint City Bucks this
- Kang was a member of the Vancouver Whitecaps FC Academy in 2018, while Pétursson played 16 games with Iceland's National Youth Team.
