Ouick Hits About The 'Hounds

- Loyola University Maryland men's soccer, which was receiving votes in the latest United Soccer Coaches Division I poll, travels to Boston University for its final road game of the regular season on Saturday.
- The Greyhounds clinched a fourthstraight Patriot League tournament appearance with their victory over Holy Cross last Saturday.
- Loyola ranks 8th nationally in total assists (36), 11th in goals (35) and 19th in goals per game (2.19).
- Seniors Brian Saramago and Barry
 Sharifi were each named to the 2019
 MAC Hermann Trophy Watch List after
 earning third team All-America status
 last fall. Saramago is the Patriot League
 Preseason Offensive Player of the Year,
 while Sharifi was chosen as the conference's Preseason Midfielder of the Year.
- **Chase Vosvick** is the two-time defending Patriot League GK of the Year.
- Sixth-year head coach Steve Nichols has received three-straight Patriot League Coach of the Year awards.

Last Time Out

- Loyola scored its most goals since Oct. 22, 1999 last weekend, netting four goals in each half during a dominant 8-1 win over Holy Cross on Senior Day.
- Brian Saramago (2 G, 2 A), Nico Brown (2 G, 1 A) led the offense, while Daniel Osuji, Josh Fawole, Barry Sharifi and an own goal accounted for the other strikes
- Loyola's eight goals were tied for the most all-time in a game between Patri-

- ot League opponents.
- The Greyhounds finished October with a record of 6-1-1, outscoring opponents by a 24-9 margin during that stretch.
- with the win, Loyola moved past Navy for second place in the Patriot League standings. The Greyhounds have 15 points in league play, two back of first-place Lehigh with two games remaining in the regular season.

Series History

- Loyola and Boston U each have three wins, three losses and three ties in the first nine meetings between the two sides.
- The Greyhounds have won two-straight, including a 3-1 victory at Ridley Athletic Complex last October. Josh Fawole had two goals in that win, while Nico Brown rounded out the scoring for Loyola.
- Boston U's last win in the series was a 2-1 home victory on Oct. 10, 2015.

About the Terriers

- Boston U (4-10-1, 3-4) is tied for fifth with Bucknell in the Patriot League standings after upsetting then-No. 22
 - Navy by a 1-0 final in double overtime on Saturday.
- The Terriers have won four of their last five games overall after starting the year 0-9-1. Boston U was 0-7 in one-goal games during that initial 10-game stretch.

 Matt McDonnell leads the team and is ranked tied for second in the Patriot League with seven goals on the year.

Weekly Honors for Fawole, Mason, Rodriguez

- Loyola took home 3 of 5 Patriot League weekly awards, with Josh Fawole (Offensive Player of the Week), Davey Mason (Defensive Player) and Eddy Rodriguez (Midfielder) all recognized.
- Fawole and Mason each receive their third-career weekly accolade, while Rodriguez is honored for the first time.
- Rodriguez found Fawole for a game-tying goal with 12 seconds left in an eventual 1-1 draw at then-No. 2 Wake Forest last Tuesday. The strike was featured at No. 6 on Sports Center's Top 10 plays. Mason, meanwhile, contributed to a defense which held the Demon Deacons without a shot on goal over the final 77 minutes of the contest.

Saramago Back Atop the Patriot League

- With his six points in Saturday's win over Holy Cross, **Brian Saramago** now leads the Patriot League and ranks 28th nationally with 22 points (7 G, 8 A). He has six goals and four assists in seven games against conference opponents on the year.
- Saramago's eight assists are tied for 11th in Division I, and he is also ranked 19th nationally in shots per game (3.69, 59 total).

Quick Notes

0-0-0

- **Josh Fawole** has recorded points in six of Loyola's last seven games (5 G, 1 A).
- **Eddy Rodriguez** has recorded assists in three-straight games.
- Loyola is 7-1 this season when scoring multiple goals, and 6-1-1 when holding opponents to one goal or fewer.
- Jordan Wiley became the 15th Loyola player to record a point this season with his
 assist on Saturday.
- The Greyhounds have outshot their opponents in 10 of 16 games, and they have tied or had a greater number of corner kicks in 13 of 16 contests.
- Loyola's four first-half goals against Holy Cross were its most in a half since Nov. 8, 2008 at Rider.
- Eight Loyola players have combined for 13 Patriot League weekly awards so far in 2019, with **Barry Sharifi** (3x), **Davey Mason** (2x), **Jonathan Sousa** (2x), **Chase Vosvick** (2x), **Brian Saramago**, **Justin Ingram**, Fawole and Rodriguez all earning recognition.
- Loyola is 25-6-3 in the regular season against Patriot League opponents over the past three-plus years under head coach Steve Nichols.
- Loyola's 2019 schedule included six games against teams which reached the NCAA tournament last fall, with the Greyhounds going 2-3-1 in those contests.
- Mason and Jacob Denison have started every game for the Greyhounds on the backline this season.

Program Turnaround under Nichols

- Sixth-year head coach **Steve Nichols**, a 1992 Loyola graduate, was hired to lead the Greyhounds men's soccer program on Feb. 6, 2014.
- After totaling a record of 7-21-6 (2-13-3 Patriot League) while rebuilding the program in his first two seasons, Nichols brought in Loyola's first-ever nationally-ranked recruiting class prior to the 2016 season.
- The Greyhounds went 31-17-5 (20-4-3 Patriot League) from 2016-18, topping the Patriot League regular season standings in both 2017 and 2018.
- Loyola was ranked No. 23 in the final United Soccer Coaches Top 25 poll of the 2018
 regular season, entering the national rankings for the first time since 2009. The Greyhounds were included among schools receiving votes in this year's preseason Division
 I poll.
- Loyola is searching for its first Patriot League championship this season. A Patriot League title would clinch the program's first NCAA tournament appearance since 2009.

More on Saramago, Sharifi

- **Brian Saramago** is one of 12 players in Patriot League history to be named first team all-conference three times, and he has also been named All-Northeast Region in each of his three years at Loyola.
- Saramago (33 G, 22 A) is ranked 15th in program history in career goals, tied for 11th in career assists and 14th in career points (88). He totaled eight goals and eight assists last season.
- **Barry Sharifi** received his second-straight Patriot League Midfielder of the Year honor in 2018 after totaling four goals and four assists across 17 starts. He has 19 career goals, and he is tied for 15th all-time at Loyola with 19 assists.
- Saramago and Sharifi became Loyola's first All-America honorees since 2008 last fall.

More on Vosvick

- **Chase Vosvick** has earned first team All-Northeast Region status in each of his first two collegiate seasons. He is 27-16-3 with a 1.11 goals-against average, a .720 save percentage and 16 shutouts through his first 47 appearances at Loyola.
- Vosvick has limited opponents to one goal or fewer in 19 of his 21 collegiate starts at Ridley Athletic Complex.

Other All-Patriot League Returners

- Sr. F Josh Fawole (5 G, 2 A), Sr. F Nico Brown (5 G, 1 A), Sr. D Davey Mason (1 G, 1 A) and Jr. M Sam Brown (3 G, 3 A) were all second team All-Patriot League honorees in 2018, while Sr. D Jonathan Sousa landed on the third team after contributing to a backline which surrendered just 12 goals all season.
- Fawole was named second team All-Patriot League for a second-straight season. He
 currently has 18 goals (including seven game-winners) and nine assists during his time
 at Loyola.

Sharifi. Lussi to Captain Squad in 2019

- Senior midfielders Barry Sharifi and Morgan Lussi will serve as team captains for the 2019 season.
- Sharifi leads all active Greyhounds with 64 career starts and 68 career appearances...
- Lussi is a three-year starter who has cracked the Starting XI 33 times overall.
- Lussi's goal at Appalachian State on Sept. 1 was his first since the 2018 season opener, a 3-0 victory over Rutgers.

Nine Newcomers Join the Fold

- There are a total of nine new Greyhounds among the 2019 roster of 30 student-athletes. Jr. M Justin Ingram joins as a transfer from the University of Virginia, while Jack Caldwell, Johan Granados, Jack Hosmer, Albert Kang, Matthew Lala, Spencer Nattans, Daniel Osuji and Kristinn Pétursson make up the incoming Class of 2023.
- Ingram won a USL2 National Championship while playing for Flint City Bucks this
- Kang was a member of the Vancouver Whitecaps FC Academy in 2018, while Pétursson played 16 games with Iceland's National Youth Team.
