Ouick Hits About The 'Hounds

- Loyola University Maryland men's soccer looks to snap a two-game losing streak on Wednesday, traveling to Bucknell for a Patriot League matchup at 7 pm.
 - The Greyhounds are 0-5 away from Ridley Athletic Complex this season, with four of those defeats by a single goal and three against teams which reached the 2018 NCAA tournament.
- Loyola hasn't lost two-consecutive Patriot League games since the end of the 2015 season.
- Seniors Brian Saramago and Barry
 Sharifi were each named to the 2019
 MAC Hermann Trophy Watch List after
 earning third team All-America status
 last fall. Saramago is the Patriot League
 Preseason Offensive Player of the Year,
 while Sharifi was chosen as the conference's Preseason Midfielder of the Year.
- **Chase Vosvick** is the two-time defending Patriot League GK of the Year.
- Sixth-year head coach Steve Nichols has received three-straight Patriot League Coach of the Year awards.

Last Time Out

- Loyola outshot visiting Navy by a 21-4 margin, but was unable to find a goal while suffering a 2-0 defeat at Ridley Athletic Complex on Saturday.
- Nicko West and Ethan Singer had the goals for the Mids (9-0, 2-0 Patriot League) in the 27th and 39th minutes, respectively.
- Matt Nocita had a pair of team saves for Navy, as the defender cleared aside efforts by Brian Saramago and Barry
- **Sharifi** which had beaten goalkeeper lan Bramblett.
- In addition to their shot advantage, the Greyhounds earned 12 of the game's 13 corner kicks.
- Loyola lost to Navy for the first time since Sept. 26, 2015.

Series History

- Bucknell leads 7-0-0 in a series which dates back to 2005.
- Loyola has dropped each of the last three meetings by 1-0 scorelines.
- The Greyhounds had advantages in shots (13-5) and corners (4-0) last season at Ridley, but the Bison used a 52nd minute penalty kick by Tyler Peterson to secure a road victory.
- That defeat was Loyola's only setback to a Patriot League opponent during last year's regular season, with the Greyhounds going 7-0-1 in the other eight contests.

About the Bison

- Bucknell (2-3-3, 0-0-2) has played to ties in each of its last three games, including 1-1 scorelines against Colgate and American in its first two Patriot League matchups.
- Matt Thorsheim, the lone Bucknell player selected to the 2019 Preseason All-Patriot League team, leads the Bison with 11 points (4 G, 3 A). Three of his four goals have come from the penalty spot.
- The Bison (6-8-3, 3-5-1 in 2018) missed out on the Patriot League tournament last season after losing their final five conference games.

Greyhounds vs. The Patriot League

- Loyola is 21-5-3 in the regular season against Patriot League opponents over the past three-plus years under head coach **Steve Nichols**.
- The Greyhounds are looking for their first postseason Patriot League championship.
 They were ranked first with 12 out of 20 first-place votes in this year's Patriot League preseason poll.

Ouick Notes

- Half of Loyola's six defeats in 2019 have come to teams currently ranked in the United Soccer Coaches Division I Top 25 national poll (Virginia Tech, James Madison, Navy).
- Loyola has been shutout in back-to-back games for the first time since Sept. 1-4, 2017, when they tied William & Mary (0-0) and lost to Pittsburgh (1-0).
- The Greyhounds have outshot their opponents in each of the last four games, and they
 have tied or had a greater number of corner kicks in seven-consecutive contests.
- Chase Vosvick is 14-4-1 lifetime against Patriot League opposition during the regular season. He was honored as Patriot League Goalkeeper of the Week on Sept. 16 and Sept. 23 after shutting out Princeton and Army in back-to-back games earlier this fall.
- Brian Saramago ranks second in the Patriot League in shots per game this season (3.25, 26 total). He recorded his third collegiate hat trick during Loyola's 4-0 victory over Army West Point on Sept. 21.
- Vosvick and Daniel Osuji have each played all 735 minutes in Loyola's first eight games this season. Five players (Vosvick, Osuji, Jacob Denison, Davey Mason, Barry Sharifi) have started all eight contests.
- Eight different Greyhounds have scored at least one goal in 2019, and 10 different Loyola players have recorded at least one point.

Program Turnaround under Nichols

- Sixth-year head coach Steve Nichols, a 1992 Loyola graduate, was hired to lead the Greyhounds men's soccer program on Feb. 6, 2014.
- After totaling a record of 7-21-6 (2-13-3 Patriot League) while rebuilding the program in his first two seasons, Nichols brought in Loyola's first-ever nationally-ranked recruiting class prior to the 2016 season.
- The Greyhounds went 31-17-5 (20-4-3 Patriot League) from 2016-18, topping the Patriot League regular season standings in both 2017 and 2018.
- Loyola was ranked No. 23 in the final United Soccer Coaches Top 25 poll of the 2018
 regular season, entering the national rankings for the first time since 2009. The Greyhounds were included among schools receiving votes in this year's preseason Division
 I poll.
- Loyola is searching for its first Patriot League championship this season. A Patriot League title would clinch the program's first NCAA tournament appearance since 2009.

More on Saramago, Sharifi

- **Brian Saramago** is one of 12 players in Patriot League history to be named first team all-conference three times, and he has also been named All-Northeast Region in each of his three years at Loyola.
- Saramago (29 G, 15 A) is tied for 17th in program history in career goals, and he is 21st all-time in career points. He totaled eight goals and eight assists last season.
- **Barry Sharifi** received his second-straight Patriot League Midfielder of the Year honor in 2018 after totaling four goals and four assists across 17 starts. He has 15 career goals, and he is tied for 16th all-time at Loyola with 17 assists.
- Saramago and Sharifi became Loyola's first All-America honorees since 2008 last fall.

More on Vosvick

- **Chase Vosvick** has earned first team All-Northeast Region status in each of his first two collegiate seasons. He is 23-14-2 with a 1.07 goals-against average, a .737 save percentage and 16 shutouts through his first 40 appearances at Loyola.
- Vosvick has limited opponents to one goal or fewer in 17 of his 18 collegiate starts at Ridley Athletic Complex.

Other All-Patriot League Returners

- Sr. F Josh Fawole (5 G, 2 A), Sr. F Nico Brown (5 G, 1 A), Sr. D Davey Mason (1 G, 1 A) and Jr. M Sam Brown (3 G, 3 A) were all second team All-Patriot League honorees in 2018, while Sr. D Jonathan Sousa landed on the third team after contributing to a backline which surrendered just 12 goals all season.
- Fawole was named second team All-Patriot League for a second-straight season. He
 currently has 13 goals (including seven game-winners) and eight assists during his
 time at Loyola.

Sharifi, Lussi to Captain Squad in 2019

- Senior midfielders Barry Sharifi and Morgan Lussi will serve as team captains for the 2019 season.
- Sharifi leads all active Greyhounds with 56 career starts and 59 career appearances...
- Lussi is a three-year starter who has cracked the Starting XI 32 times overall.
- Lussi's goal at Appalachian State on Sept. 1 was his first since the 2018 season opener, a 3-0 victory over Rutgers.

Nine Newcomers Join the Fold

- There are a total of nine new Greyhounds among the 2019 roster of 30 student-athletes. Jr. M Justin Ingram joins as a transfer from the University of Virginia, while Jack Caldwell, Johan Granados, Jack Hosmer, Albert Kang, Matthew Lala, Spencer Nattans, Daniel Osuji and Kristinn Pétursson make up the incoming Class of 2023.
- Ingram won a USL2 National Championship while playing for Flint City Bucks this summer
- Kang was a member of the Vancouver Whitecaps FC Academy in 2018, while Pétursson played 16 games with Iceland's National Youth Team.
