Ouick Hits About The 'Hounds

- Loyola University Maryland men's soccer returns to Patriot League play on Saturday, traveling to Hamilton, N.Y., to take on three-time defending conference champions Colgate at 2:30 p.m.
- The Greyhounds have won four of their first five games in October, scoring 13 goals during that span.
- Loyola has topped the Patriot League regular season standings in each of the past two seasons.
- The Greyhounds are 2-5 away from home in 2019 (1-1 in conference play).
- Seniors Brian Saramago and Barry
 Sharifi were each named to the 2019
 MAC Hermann Trophy Watch List after
 earning third team All-America status
 last fall. Saramago is the Patriot League
 Preseason Offensive Player of the Year,
 while Sharifi was chosen as the conference's Preseason Midfielder of the Year.
- **Chase Vosvick** is the two-time defending Patriot League GK of the Year.
- Sixth-year head coach Steve Nichols has received three-straight Patriot League Coach of the Year awards.

Last Time Out

- Loyola scored two goals in each half and held a clean sheet until the final minute during a 4-1 non-conference victory over NJIT on Tuesday.
- Josh Fawole and Barry Sharifi struck for the Greyhounds in the opening half, while Brian Saramago and an own goal accounted for the scoring after halftime.
- Saramago assisted on Fawole's opener, moving him into a tie for the Patriot

- League-lead with six helpers on the
- The Greyhounds earned the victory despite being outshot (18-15) for the first time in eight games and giving up more corner kicks (5-4) for the first time since the season opener at NC State on August 30.
- Chase Vosvick made three saves to secure his fourth win of the season in goal.

Series History

- The two teams are tied with three victories apiece and a pair of draws through the first eight meetings.
- Loyola and Colgate played to a 0-0 draw at Ridley in last season's meeting on Sept. 21. The Greyhounds were unable to find a goal despite a 14-7 lead in shots and a 15-1 edge in corner kicks.
- Loyola's last win in the series was a 2-1 victory at Colgate on Sept. 22, 2017.
 Barry Sharifi opened the scoring in the 22nd minute, and he set up TJ Walker's game-winner with 7:34 remaining in regulation.

About the Raiders

- Colgate (3-7-4, 1-3-1 Patriot League) snapped a four-game losing streak with a 1-0 double overtime victory at Vermont on Tuesday.
- The Raiders enter the weekend having lost three-straight games against Patriot League opponents. Their lone win in conference play was a 1-0 triumph at Army on Sept. 28.
- Colgate has won three-straight Patriot League tournaments, accomplishing the feat as the No. 3 seed in 2016 and 2018 and the No. 6 seed in 2017.
- Senior defender Christian Clarke was one of 11 players named to the Preseason All-Patriot League Team. The Raiders were projected to finish second out of 10 teams in the conference's preseason poll.

Offense Rounding Into Form

- Loyola is currently second in the Patriot League and 29th overall in Division I with 24 goals scored on the year.
- The Greyhounds have scored four goals on four seperate occasions in 2019, including three out of five contests overall in October.
- Ten different Greyhounds have scored at least one goal in 2019, and 13 players have recorded at least one point.

Quick Notes

0-0-0

- Six Loyola players have combined for eight Patriot League weekly awards so far in 2019, with **Justin Ingram**, **Davey Mason**, **Brian Saramago**, **Jonathan Sousa**, **Barry Sharifi** (2x) and **Chase Vosvick** (2x) each earning recognition.
- Loyola is 5-1 this season when scoring multiple goals. Last Saturday's 1-0 loss at Lehigh dropped the Greyhounds to 1-5 in one-goal games on the year.
- The Greyhounds have outshot their opponents in 9 of 13 games, and they have tied or had a greater number of corner kicks in 11 of 13 contests.
- Four of Loyola's seven defeats have come to teams ranked or receiving votes in the
 most-recent United Soccer Coaches Division I Top 25 poll (James Madison, Navy, NC
 State, Virginia Tech). Still ahead on the schedule is a matchup at #4 Wake Forest next
 Tuesday night.
- **Brian Saramago** leads the Patriot League and ranks 17th nationally in shots per game this season (3.77, 49 total). He recorded his third collegiate hat trick during Loyola's 4-0 victory over Army West Point on Sept. 21.
- Saramago is tied for 16th all-time in team history in goals (30) and he is tied for 12th all-time in assists (19).
- Jacob Denison and Davey Mason have started every game for the Greyhounds this season

Greyhounds vs. The Patriot League

- Loyola is 23-6-3 in the regular season against Patriot League opponents over the past three-plus years under head coach **Steve Nichols**.
- The Greyhounds are looking for their first postseason Patriot League championship.
 They were ranked first with 12 out of 20 first-place votes in this year's Patriot League preseason poll.

Program Turnaround under Nichols

- Sixth-year head coach **Steve Nichols**, a 1992 Loyola graduate, was hired to lead the Greyhounds men's soccer program on Feb. 6, 2014.
- After totaling a record of 7-21-6 (2-13-3 Patriot League) while rebuilding the program in his first two seasons, Nichols brought in Loyola's first-ever nationally-ranked recruiting class prior to the 2016 season.
- The Greyhounds went 31-17-5 (20-4-3 Patriot League) from 2016-18, topping the Patriot League regular season standings in both 2017 and 2018.
- Loyola was ranked No. 23 in the final United Soccer Coaches Top 25 poll of the 2018
 regular season, entering the national rankings for the first time since 2009. The Greyhounds were included among schools receiving votes in this year's preseason Division
 I poll.
- Loyola is searching for its first Patriot League championship this season. A Patriot League title would clinch the program's first NCAA tournament appearance since 2009.

More on Saramago, Sharifi

- **Brian Saramago** is one of 12 players in Patriot League history to be named first team all-conference three times, and he has also been named All-Northeast Region in each of his three years at Loyola.
- Saramago (30 G, 20 A) is tied for 16th in program history in career goals, and he is tied for 17th all-time in career points. He totaled eight goals and eight assists last season.
- Barry Sharifi received his second-straight Patriot League Midfielder of the Year honor
 in 2018 after totaling four goals and four assists across 17 starts. He has 18 career goals,
 and he is tied for 16th all-time at Loyola with 18 assists.
- Saramago and Sharifi became Loyola's first All-America honorees since 2008 last fall.

More on Vosvick

- **Chase Vosvick** has earned first team All-Northeast Region status in each of his first two collegiate seasons. He is 25-16-2 with a 1.11 goals-against average, a .722 save percentage and 16 shutouts through his first 43 appearances at Loyola.
- Vosvick has limited opponents to one goal or fewer in 17 of his 19 collegiate starts at Ridley Athletic Complex.

Other All-Patriot League Returners

- Sr. F Josh Fawole (5 G, 2 A), Sr. F Nico Brown (5 G, 1 A), Sr. D Davey Mason (1 G, 1 A) and Jr. M Sam Brown (3 G, 3 A) were all second team All-Patriot League honorees in 2018, while Sr. D Jonathan Sousa landed on the third team after contributing to a backline which surrendered just 12 goals all season.
- Fawole was named second team All-Patriot League for a second-straight season. He currently has 16 goals (including seven game-winners) and eight assists during his time at Loyola.

Sharifi, Lussi to Captain Squad in 2019

- Senior midfielders Barry Sharifi and Morgan Lussi will serve as team captains for the 2019 season.
- Sharifi leads all active Greyhounds with 61 career starts and 65 career appearances..
- Lussi is a three-year starter who has cracked the Starting XI 33 times overall.
- Lussi's goal at Appalachian State on Sept. 1 was his first since the 2018 season opener, a 3-0 victory over Rutgers.

Nine Newcomers Join the Fold

- There are a total of nine new Greyhounds among the 2019 roster of 30 student-athletes. Jr. M Justin Ingram joins as a transfer from the University of Virginia, while Jack Caldwell, Johan Granados, Jack Hosmer, Albert Kang, Matthew Lala, Spencer Nattans, Daniel Osuji and Kristinn Pétursson make up the incoming Class of 2023.
- Ingram won a USL2 National Championship while playing for Flint City Bucks this summer
- Kang was a member of the Vancouver Whitecaps FC Academy in 2018, while Pétursson played 16 games with Iceland's National Youth Team.
