ON THE ROAD AGAIN

Navy is back on the road for the third time this season as the Midshipmen will play six of their next eight matches away from Annapolis. However, despite playing away from Annapolis, Navy will stay close to home over the next week as its next games come at Loyola and American, which are both less than 40 miles away from the United States Naval Academy. So far this season, Navy has picked up a pair of road victories against Mount St. Mary's (1-0) and Longwood (2-1). However, the Midshipmen have struggled on the road since the start of the 2016 season and they have gone just 5-21-2 in 28 matches away from Annapolis and Navy is just 2-12-1 against Patriot League foes away from home over the last three years.

GETTING AHEAD EARLY

Navy has continued its trend of getting ahead early and has scored in the first half of seven of the eight games played this year, with the lone outlier coming on the road against Mount St. Mary's. Against the Mountaineers, Navy tallied the games lone goal in the second half to win 1-0. The Midshipmen have led at halftime in of each of the seven games they have scored in the first half en route to outscoring their opponents in the first half 11-0. Navy has found success when leading at halftime under head coach Tim O'Donohue with a record of 15-5-1 when leading after

the first 45 minutes. The Midshipmen have only won once when trailing at the half and they have four victories when being tied at the break under O'Donohue. Navy's strong opening stanzas have paced it to outscoring the opposition 15-2 over the first eight games of the season.

SCOUTING LOYOLA

Loyola comes into the weekend with an overall record of 2-5-0 after falling on the road to William & Mary, 2-0. However, of the victories for the Greyhounds came at home against Army last weekend where Loyola grabbed a 4-0 win over the Black Knight behind a hat trick from Brian Saramago. In just two matches at home, Loyola is 2-0-0 and is outscoring opponents 6-0 at the Ridley Athletic Complex. The Greyhounds -- who were receiving votes to begin 2019 -- started the season 0-4-0 with two losses coming against teams ranked in the top 20 currently and a third who was receiving votes earlier in the season. Saramago is the teams leading scorer with three goals -- all coming against Army -- while chipping in with an assist. Barry Sharifi is the team's only other multi-goal scorer. Chase Vosvick has played all 644-plus minutes for the Greyhounds and has a .645 save percentage to go along with a 1.54 goals-against average. Loyola entered the season as Patriot League favorite after winning the previous two regular-season championships.

Loyola leads the all-time series between the Greyhounds and Midshipmen with a record of 4-3-2. Despite just the one-game lead in the series, Loyola has controlled the series as of late with three of its wins coming in each of the last three seasons. The last time Navy picked up a victory over the Greyhounds was in 2015 when the Midshipmen grabbed a 1-0 decision at home against Loyola. In games played in Baltimore, the only time Navy picked up a victory was during the first time Loyola hosted Navy in 2009 after the Midshipmen earned a 2-1 victory on the road. The two squads played to a 1-1 draw during the 2014 meeting in Baltimore and Loyola followed with home wins in 2016 and 2017 to start a three-match winning streak against Navy. Last year, the Greyhounds came to Annapolis and earned the largest win in series history with a 4-1 win against the Midshipmen. Only two matches in the entire series have been decided by more than one goal and both contests came in the last two years where Loyola won 2-0 at home in 2017 and 4-1 last year.

Following Tuesday's victory, Navy has stretched its winning streak to 12-straight matches, which is the longest in program history since the 2013 season when Navy put together a 15-match winning streak. In 2013, the Midshipmen used their winning streak to win their only Patriot League Tournament title in program history. Navy also advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament during the 2013 season before suffering a narrow loss at Wake Forest. Over Navy's 12-match streak, it has outscored the opposition 24-4 and posted eight shutouts.

Navy is off to its best start in program history since 1966. The Midshipmen come into the weekend with a record of 8-0-0, which was last done by Glenn Warner's squad on their way to the quarterfinals of the NCAA Tournament. In 1966, the Midshipmen started the season with nine-straight wins and finished the year with a record of 10-1-2 with the lone loss coming in the national tournament. Navy's 2019 squad is just the sixth team in program history to post eight consecutive wins to start a season. Of the first five times a Navy squad has started 8-0-0, each came under Navy's winningest coach, Glenn Warner, with all five occurrences happening during the 1960s. Navy won the national title in 1964, which was in the middle of the NCAA's longest winning streak of 25 matches. Throughout the 1960s, Glenn Warner posted a combined record of 102-13-9 and Navy had never lost more than two games in a season during the 10-year span.

Annapolis is home to not only the longest winning streak in NCAA Division I Men's Soccer, but it is also home to the most combined collegiate victories between a men's and women's program. With the Navy women's team posting a record of 9-1-0 and the eight wins from the Navy men's team, the 17 wins combined between the two programs are most among NCAA Division I programs. Along with the Navy men having the longest winning streak on the men's side, the women are just one win shy of the longest winning streak on the women's side as their eight-game winning streak is just shy of Virginia Tech's nine-match winning streak.

Tim O'Donohue enters his fourth season as Navy's head men's soccer coach in 2019. O'Donohue enters the 2019 season with the 39th-highest all-time NCAA winning percentage across all divisions at .736 (177-54-30).

O'Donohue is the sixth head coach in the 99-year history of the Navy men's soccer program. He is 12-23-7 (.298) in three seasons at Navy.

Prior to arriving at Navy, O'Donohue spent five seasons (2011-2015) as the associate head coach at the University of Connecticut and 10 seasons (2001-10) as the head coach at Division III Stevens Institute of Technology.

During the 2018 season, O'Donohue coached Navy to a fifth-place finish in the Patriot League regular season standings after going 4-5-0 in league play. The Midshipmen finished the season with a record of 5-11-1 overall following a four-game winning streak to end the year. Over the final four games of the regular season, Navy outscored the opposition 9-2 and notched a pair of shutouts.

O'Donohue coached the Patriot League Rookie of the Year in Jacob Williams and coached Third Team All-Patriot League member Matt Nocita. Williams finished second the league with 0.50 goals per game and was fourth with 1.00 points per game. Williams' eight goals were second in the Patriot League. Nocita was the only player for the Midshipmen to play all 1,557 minutes of the 2018 season.

In his second season at Navy in 2017, the Midshipmen battled rival Army West Point to a 0-0 double-overtime draw in the Star Game and Army-Navy Cup VI, which was played in front of 8,143 fans at Talen Energy Stadium in Chester, Pa. The Army-Navy game was the third-highest attended college men's soccer game in 2017.

Despite having less than two months to prepare for Navy's 2016 season opener when he was hired, O'Donohue's first team showed great potential for his program in the coming years, and was resilient, spirited and composed. Navy battled in every contest and 12 games in 2016 were decided by one goal, while four more ended in ties. The Mids were 5-9-4 overall and 1-6-2 in the Patriot League.

Navy was 4-1-3 in games played at the Glenn Warner Soccer Facility in 2016. Navy also was ranked fifth in the NSCAA Northeast Region Poll on Sept. 6, 2016 after a 1-1-1 start to the season. Brock Dudley was named to the All-Patriot League Second Team in 2016, while Sam Bascom was named to the All-Patriot League Third Team. Goalkeeper Mac Burke led the Patriot League in goals-against average (1.05).

Prior to his arrival at Navy, O'Donohue spent five years at UConn on Ray Reid's staff, and helped take the Huskies to the NCAA Tournament four times, including three straight appearances in the NCAA Quarterfinals from 2011-13. The Huskies had an overall record of 68-22-21 (.707) during O'Donohue's tenure in Storrs. In his first season at UConn in 2011, the Huskies went 19-3-3 and advanced to the NCAA Quarterfinals and then followed that season with a 17-4-1 record in 2012 with another trip to the NCAA Quarterfinals. The Huskies made their third straight quarterfinals appearance in 2013 with a 12-3-8 mark. In his final season at UConn in 2015, O'Donohue helped the squad to a 10-6-6 mark and an appearance in the NCAA Second Round after defeating Boston University in the first round.

O'Donohue had an overall record of 165-21-23 at Stevens and his winning percentage of .844 was the highest in NCAA Division III history when he left Stevens to serve as the associate head coach at UConn.

O'Donohue took Stevens to the NCAA Tournament in nine of his 10 seasons. The Ducks advanced to the NCAA Sweet 16 six times (2003, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2008 and 2009) and were the national runners-up in 2008. Messiah claimed the 2008 national title after advancing past Stevens in a penalty kick shootout. Stevens won the ECAC Championship in 2002 and O'Donohue led the Ducks to an unbeaten record of 18-0-3 in 2006.

O'Donohue led Stevens to nine conference championships during his tenure. After joining the Empire 8 in 2007, O'Donohue led Stevens to the conference championship in four straight seasons (2007 to 2010) before departing for UConn. Prior to joining the Empire 8, the Ducks won the Skyline Conference Championship in 2001, 2003, 2004, 2005, and 2006.

O'Donohue was the Skyline Conference Coach of the Year in 2003 and the Empire 8 Conference Coach of the Year in 2010. He was also named the National Soccer Coaches Association of America (NSCAA) All-Metro Region Coach of the Year in 2003 and was a finalist for the Division III NSCAA National Coach of the Year in both 2003 and 2008. Stevens was ranked in the final NSCAA Poll in each of O'Donohue's final eight seasons with the school. O'Donohue coached 12 All-Americans while at Stevens with four earning first-team honors. O'Donohue also coached seven conference players of the year, 39 NSCAA All-Region performers, five CoSIDA Academic All-Americans, and 77 all-conference athletes.

O'Donohue holds several merits from the NSCAA including a Premier Diploma and a Master Coach Diploma. He was one of the first five coaches to earn a Master Diploma at the NCAA level. He also previously served as the Region III Technical Director for the NSCAA.

O'Donohue was a four-year starter at Muhlenberg College and helped the team to four-straight NCAA Tournament appearances and a berth in the Final Four in 1995. The central midfielder earned all-conference honors in 1997. He was inducted into the Muhlenberg Athletics Hall of Fame as part of the 1995 men's soccer team. He graduated from Muhlenberg in 1998 with a degree in English. O'Donohue and his wife, Virginia, have two children, Tadgh and Tierney.
