Quick Hits About The 'Hounds

- After earning a draw against the No. 2 team in the country on Tuesday, Loyola University Maryland men's soccer returns to Patriot League play with a Homecoming weekend matchup against Holy Cross.
- The Greyhounds can clinch their fourth-straight Patriot League tournament appearance with a win and a Boston U loss or tie vs. Navy. Loyola would also get in with a tie, a BU loss and a loss or tie by both Army West Point and Colgate.
- Seniors **Brian Saramago** and **Barry Sharifi** were each named to the 2019 MAC Hermann Trophy Watch List after earning third team All-America status last fall. Saramago is the Patriot League Preseason Offensive Player of the Year, while Sharifi was chosen as the conference's Preseason Midfielder of the Year.
- Chase Vosvick** is the two-time defending Patriot League GK of the Year.
- Sixth-year head coach **Steve Nichols** has received three-straight Patriot League Coach of the Year awards.

Last Time Out

- Eddy Rodriguez** set up **Josh Fawole** for a highlight-reel game-tying goal with 12 seconds left in regulation, as Loyola secured a 1-1 draw at No. 2 Wake Forest.
- Fawole's goal, a sliding half-volley which was directed in just under the crossbar, was featured on Sports Center's Top 10 plays for Tuesday, coming in at No. 6 overall.
- Loyola finished with a 6-4 edge in shots on goal, preventing Wake Forest (12-2-1) from recording a shot on target over the final 77 minutes of game action.
- Wake Forest entered the contest with a 9-0 home record on the year, outscoring opponents by a 25-4 margin during that stretch.
- The Greyhounds improve to 2-3-1 this season against teams which qualified for the 2018 national tournament.

Series History

- Loyola and Holy Cross have each earned three victories during the first six meetings between the two programs.
- The Greyhounds have won each of the last three contests, with a 107th minute goal by **Josh Fawole** clinching a 3-2 double overtime victory in last year's meeting at Holy Cross.
- Loyola came back from a 2-0 deficit in that matchup, as Fawole and **Barry Sharifi** scored in regulation to force OT.
- Holy Cross was the only team to score multiple goals against Loyola GK **Chase Vosvick** last season.

About the Crusaders

- Holy Cross (3-11, 1-5) has dropped three-straight Patriot League games, including a 6-1 defeat at Army West Point last Sunday. The Crusaders' lone league victory was a 1-0 triumph at Boston University on Oct. 2.
- All three Crusader victories have come on the road; they are 0-7 at home this season.
- Max Krause and Dylan Scanley have four goals each, combining to score eight of the team's 13 goals on the year.
- Holy Cross has been outscored 36-13 this season, giving up 3+ goals in seven of its 11 defeats.

Senior Day

- Loyola seniors **Nico Brown**, **Matt Dabrowski**, **Josh Fawole**, **Morgan Lussi**, **Davey Mason**, **Brian Saramago** and **Barry Sharifi** will be recognized in a pregame ceremony for their contributions to the program.
- The seven seniors have totaled two Patriot League regular season championships and 38 victories, including a 24-8-3 record against conference opponents, after joining a team which was 2-13-1 (0-8-1) in the year prior to their arrival.

October Turnaround

- After entering October with an overall record of 2-6-0, Loyola has posted a 5-1-1 mark through its first seven games this month, outscoring opponents 16-8 during that stretch.
- Josh Fawole** (4 G, 1 A) and **Brian Saramago** (2 G, 5 A) have led the offense with nine points apiece this month, with **Barry Sharifi** (3 G, 2 A), **Justin Ingram** (2 G, 2 A) and **Jonathan Sousa** (2 GWG) also key October contributors.

Quick Notes

- Brian Saramago** leads the Patriot League and is 35th in Division I with six assists this season. He has a team-high 16 points (5 G, 6 A) overall.
- Eddy Rodriguez** has recorded assists in back-to-back games, initiating the play that led to **Jonathan Sousa's** overtime winner at Colgate and setting up **Josh Fawole's** late strike at Wake Forest.
- Loyola is 6-1 this season when scoring multiple goals.
- The Greyhounds have outshot their opponents in 9 of 15 games, and they have tied or had a greater number of corner kicks in 12 of 15 contests.
- Six Loyola players have combined for 10 Patriot League weekly awards so far in 2019, with **Barry Sharifi** (3x), Sousa (2x), **Chase Vosvick** (2x), Saramago, **Justin Ingram**, and **Davey Mason** each earning recognition.
- Sharifi (Midfielder of the Week) and Sousa (Defender) received Patriot League weekly awards for a second time in the past three weeks on Monday.
- Saramago leads the Patriot League and ranks 18th nationally in shots per game this season (3.67, 55 total).
- Mason and **Jacob Denison** have started every game for the Greyhounds on the back-line this season.

Program Turnaround under Nichols

- Sixth-year head coach **Steve Nichols**, a 1992 Loyola graduate, was hired to lead the Greyhounds men's soccer program on Feb. 6, 2014.
- After totaling a record of 7-21-6 (2-13-3 Patriot League) while rebuilding the program in his first two seasons, Nichols brought in Loyola's first-ever nationally-ranked recruiting class prior to the 2016 season.
- The Greyhounds went 31-17-5 (20-4-3 Patriot League) from 2016-18, topping the Patriot League regular season standings in both 2017 and 2018.
- Loyola was ranked No. 23 in the final United Soccer Coaches Top 25 poll of the 2018 regular season, entering the national rankings for the first time since 2009. The Greyhounds were included among schools receiving votes in this year's preseason Division I poll.
- Loyola is searching for its first Patriot League championship this season. A Patriot League title would clinch the program's first NCAA tournament appearance since 2009.

More on Saramago, Sharifi

- **Brian Saramago** is one of 12 players in Patriot League history to be named first team all-conference three times, and he has also been named All-Northeast Region in each of his three years at Loyola.
- Saramago (31 G, 20 A) is ranked 16th in program history in career goals, and he is tied for 16th all-time in career points. He totaled eight goals and eight assists last season.
- **Barry Sharifi** received his second-straight Patriot League Midfielder of the Year honor in 2018 after totaling four goals and four assists across 17 starts. He has 18 career goals, and he is tied for 15th all-time at Loyola with 19 assists.
- Saramago and Sharifi became Loyola's first All-America honorees since 2008 last fall.

More on Vosvick

- **Chase Vosvick** has earned first team All-Northeast Region status in each of his first two collegiate seasons. He is 26-16-3 with a 1.10 goals-against average, a .723 save percentage and 16 shutouts through his first 46 appearances at Loyola.
- Vosvick has limited opponents to one goal or fewer in 18 of his 20 collegiate starts at Ridley Athletic Complex.

Other All-Patriot League Returners

- Sr. F **Josh Fawole** (5 G, 2 A), Sr. F **Nico Brown** (5 G, 1 A), Sr. D **Davey Mason** (1 G, 1 A) and Jr. M **Sam Brown** (3 G, 3 A) were all second team All-Patriot League honorees in 2018, while Sr. D **Jonathan Sousa** landed on the third team after contributing to a backline which surrendered just 12 goals all season.
- Fawole was named second team All-Patriot League for a second-straight season. He currently has 17 goals (including seven game-winners) and nine assists during his time at Loyola.

Sharifi, Lussi to Captain Squad in 2019

- Senior midfielders **Barry Sharifi** and **Morgan Lussi** will serve as team captains for the 2019 season.
- Sharifi leads all active Greyhounds with 63 career starts and 67 career appearances.
- Lussi is a three-year starter who has cracked the Starting XI 33 times overall.
- Lussi's goal at Appalachian State on Sept. 1 was his first since the 2018 season opener, a 3-0 victory over Rutgers.

Nine Newcomers Join the Fold

- There are a total of nine new Greyhounds among the 2019 roster of 30 student-athletes. Jr. M **Justin Ingram** joins as a transfer from the University of Virginia, while **Jack Caldwell, Johan Granados, Jack Hosmer, Albert Kang, Matthew Lala, Spencer Natans, Daniel Osuji** and **Kristinn Petursson** make up the incoming Class of 2023.
- Ingram won a USL2 National Championship while playing for Flint City Bucks this summer.
- Kang was a member of the Vancouver Whitecaps FC Academy in 2018, while Petursson played 16 games with Iceland's National Youth Team.
