Ouick Hits About The 'Hounds

- Loyola University Maryland men's soccer returns to Ridley Athletic Complex on Saturday afternoon, hosting Lafayette in a Patriot League tilt beginning at 1 p.m.
- The Greyhounds have won three of their last five games since starting the year with four consecutive one-goal defeats
- Loyola is 11-3-2 against Patriot League opponents in the regular season at Ridley over the past three-plus seasons overall.
- Seniors Brian Saramago and Barry Sharifi were each named to the 2019 MAC Hermann Trophy Watch List after earning third team All-America status last fall. Saramago is the Patriot League Preseason Offensive Player of the Year, while Sharifi was chosen as the conference's Preseason Midfielder of the Year.
- **Chase Vosvick** is the two-time defending Patriot League GK of the Year.
- Sixth-year head coach Steve Nichols
 has received three-straight Patriot
 League Coach of the Year awards.

Last Time Out

- Jonathan Sousa scored his first collegiate goal in the 64th minute, and the Loyola defense prevented Bucknell from recording a single shot on goal to lift the Greyhounds to a 1-0 road victory on Wednesday.
- Loyola earned its first road this season and also topped Bucknell for the first time in program history.
- Albert Kang and Davey Mason set up Sousa's game-winner. Kang recorded
- his first collegiate point, while Mason now has a team-high three assists on the year.
- Senior goalkeeper Matt Dabrowski recorded his second-career shutout in his first start of the season. Junior forward Jordan Wiley also cracked the Starting XI for the first time in his Greyhound
- Loyola led 10-6 in shots and 7-1 in corner kicks.

Series History

- Loyola leads 6-2-1 in a series which dates back to 1986.
- The Greyhounds have won three in a row overall over Lafayette, including a pair of 1-0 decisions in the last two regular season meetings.
- Stephen Nichols provided the game-winner in last year's contest at Lafayette, as he netted his first collegiate goal just 35 seconds into the game. Chase Vosvick made four saves in goal to secure the victory.
- Lafayette's last win was a 1-0 double overtime victory on Nov. 8, 2014.

About the Leopards

- Lafayette (7-2-1, 3-0) was projected to finish last out of 10 teams in the Patriot League preseason poll, but the Leopards are currently tied for first in the conference standings with #21 Navy and Lehigh through three games.
- Lafayette is in the midst of an offensive resurgence, leading the Patriot League with 24 goals (2.4 per game) through its first 10 contests. The Leopards haven't averaged more than one goal per game in any season since 2012.
- Fourteen different players have at least one point, with Sebastian Varela (5 G), Ryan Goncalves (4 G, 1 A) and James Gibson (2 G, 5 A) leading the way offensively.
- Goalkeeper Alex Sutton leads the conference in total saves (39), and he is second in save percentage (.796) and shutouts (3).

Streak Breakers

- Wednesday night's 1-0 win at Bucknell was noteworthy in several different capacities for the Greyhounds.
- It was their first road and one-goal victory since Nov. 3 at Lafayette last season.
- The Greyhounds improve to 1-4 in both road and one-goal games in 2019. They are also now 1-5 when scoring one goal or fewer this season.

Quick Notes

0-0-0

- Half of Loyola's six defeats in 2019 have come to teams currently ranked in the United Soccer Coaches Division I Top 25 national poll (Virginia Tech, James Madison, Navy).
 The Greyhounds will also travel to current #3 Wake Forest later this month on Tuesday, Oct. 22.
- Loyola has posted clean sheets in all three of its victories this season.
- The Greyhounds have outshot their opponents in each of the last five games, and they
 have tied or had a greater number of corner kicks in eight-consecutive contests.
- **Chase Vosvick** is 14-4-1 lifetime against Patriot League opposition during the regular season. He was honored as Patriot League Goalkeeper of the Week on Sept. 16 and Sept. 23 after shutting out Princeton and Army in back-to-back games earlier this fall.
- Brian Saramago ranks second in the Patriot League in shots per game this season (3.25, 26 total). He recorded his third collegiate hat trick during Loyola's 4-0 victory over Army West Point on Sept. 21.
- Daniel Osuji has each played all 825 minutes in Loyola's first nine games this season.
 Four players (Osuji, Jacob Denison, Davey Mason, Barry Sharifi) have started all nine contests.
- Nine different Greyhounds have scored at least one goal in 2019, and 11 different Loyola players have recorded at least one point.

Greyhounds vs. The Patriot League

- Loyola is 22-5-3 in the regular season against Patriot League opponents over the past three-plus years under head coach **Steve Nichols**.
- The Greyhounds are looking for their first postseason Patriot League championship. They were ranked first with 12 out of 20 first-place votes in this year's Patriot League preseason poll.

Program Turnaround under Nichols

- Sixth-year head coach **Steve Nichols**, a 1992 Loyola graduate, was hired to lead the Greyhounds men's soccer program on Feb. 6, 2014.
- After totaling a record of 7-21-6 (2-13-3 Patriot League) while rebuilding the program in his first two seasons, Nichols brought in Loyola's first-ever nationally-ranked recruiting class prior to the 2016 season.
- The Greyhounds went 31-17-5 (20-4-3 Patriot League) from 2016-18, topping the Patriot League regular season standings in both 2017 and 2018.
- Loyola was ranked No. 23 in the final United Soccer Coaches Top 25 poll of the 2018
 regular season, entering the national rankings for the first time since 2009. The Greyhounds were included among schools receiving votes in this year's preseason Division
 I poll.
- Loyola is searching for its first Patriot League championship this season. A Patriot League title would clinch the program's first NCAA tournament appearance since 2009.

More on Saramago, Sharifi

- **Brian Saramago** is one of 12 players in Patriot League history to be named first team all-conference three times, and he has also been named All-Northeast Region in each of his three years at Loyola.
- Saramago (29 G, 15 A) is tied for 17th in program history in career goals, and he is 21st all-time in career points. He totaled eight goals and eight assists last season.
- Barry Sharifi received his second-straight Patriot League Midfielder of the Year honor in 2018 after totaling four goals and four assists across 17 starts. He has 15 career goals, and he is tied for 16th all-time at Loyola with 17 assists.
- Saramago and Sharifi became Loyola's first All-America honorees since 2008 last fall.

More on Vosvick

- **Chase Vosvick** has earned first team All-Northeast Region status in each of his first two collegiate seasons. He is 23-15-2 with a 1.09 goals-against average, a .729 save percentage and 16 shutouts through his first 41 appearances at Loyola.
- Vosvick has limited opponents to one goal or fewer in 17 of his 19 collegiate starts at Ridley Athletic Complex.

Other All-Patriot League Returners

- Sr. F Josh Fawole (5 G, 2 A), Sr. F Nico Brown (5 G, 1 A), Sr. D Davey Mason (1 G, 1 A) and Jr. M Sam Brown (3 G, 3 A) were all second team All-Patriot League honorees in 2018, while Sr. D Jonathan Sousa landed on the third team after contributing to a backline which surrendered just 12 goals all season.
- Fawole was named second team All-Patriot League for a second-straight season. He
 currently has 13 goals (including seven game-winners) and eight assists during his
 time at Loyola.

Sharifi, Lussi to Captain Squad in 2019

- Senior midfielders Barry Sharifi and Morgan Lussi will serve as team captains for the 2019 season.
- Sharifi leads all active Greyhounds with 58 career starts and 61 career appearances..
- Lussi is a three-year starter who has cracked the Starting XI 33 times overall.
- Lussi's goal at Appalachian State on Sept. 1 was his first since the 2018 season opener, a 3-0 victory over Rutgers.

Nine Newcomers Join the Fold

- There are a total of nine new Greyhounds among the 2019 roster of 30 student-athletes. Jr. M Justin Ingram joins as a transfer from the University of Virginia, while Jack Caldwell, Johan Granados, Jack Hosmer, Albert Kang, Matthew Lala, Spencer Nattans, Daniel Osuji and Kristinn Pétursson make up the incoming Class of 2023.
- Ingram won a USL2 National Championship while playing for Flint City Bucks this summer
- Kang was a member of the Vancouver Whitecaps FC Academy in 2018, while Pétursson played 16 games with Iceland's National Youth Team.
