Quick Hits About The 'Hounds

- Loyola University Maryland men's soccer, the first in Patriot League history to finish atop the regular standings in three-consecutive seasons, turns its attention to the postseason on Tuesday with a 7 p.m. home semifinal matchup against Lafayette.
- The Leopards advanced past the quarterfinals with a 2-1 home victory over No. 5 Colgate on Saturday. Lafayette is in the Patriot League tournament for the first time since winning the conference in 2012.
- The Greyhounds are searching for their playoff victory since joining the Patriot League, as they have been upset in each of the past three semifinals.
- Loyola is aiming for its first conference championship and NCAA tournament appearance since winning the MAAC title game in 2009.
- Tuesday's winner will face either No. 1 Lehigh or No. 6 Bucknell in Saturday's Patriot League title game. The Bison upset No. 3 Navy by a 2-0 final in the weekend's other quarterfinal matchup.

Last Time Out

- Jordan Wiley** scored his first collegiate goal in the 44th minute, as Loyola closed out the regular season with a 1-0 home victory over American last Wednesday.
- The Greyhounds improved to 8-1-1 over their past 10 contests dating back to Oct. 2, while the Eagles were eliminated from postseason contention with the defeat.
- Loyola finished the regular season with a home record of 6-1, outscoring opponents by a 23-6 margin at Ridley Athletic Complex.
- Wiley's game-winning strike came after he stole the ball from an American defender and lofted a shot over charging goalkeeper John Mino and into the back of the net.
- Loyola led 13-3 in shots, 7-1 in shots on goal, and 5-0 in corner kicks.

Series History

- Loyola leads 7-2-1 in a series which dates back to 1986.
- The Greyhounds have won four in a row overall over Lafayette, including a 4-2 victory at Ridley on Oct. 5 this season. **Barry Sharifi** had a pair of goals, while **Daniel Osuji** and **Josh Fawole** added solo strikes in the win.
- This will be the first playoff meeting between the two sides.
- Lafayette's last win over Loyola was a 1-0 double overtime triumph on Nov. 8, 2014.

About the Leopards

- Lafayette (9-6-4, 4-3-2) has made it into the semifinals despite being projected to finish last out of 10 teams in this year's Patriot League preseason poll.
- Saturday's quarterfinal victory over Colgate snapped a six-game winless run for the Leopards, who went 0-3-3 to conclude the regular season.
- Lafayette scored just two goals in those final six regular season contests after totaling a Patriot League-high 29 goals in the season's first 12 games.
- Two of the Leopards' All-Patriot League performers this season had the goals in Saturday's playoff win, as Marcos Kitromilides (Second Team) converted a PK in the eighth minute and Ryan Goncalves (Third Team) scored the game-winner in the 58th minute.
- Defender Christian Williams was also a third team All-Patriot League honoree in 2019.

Loyola Tops Conference with Eight All-Patriot League Selections

- Loyola led the Patriot League in all-conference honorees for a third-straight season, with eight Greyhounds recognized by the league office last Thursday.
- Josh Fawole**, **Barry Sharifi** and **Brian Saramago** were first team selections, while **Justin Ingram**, **Davey Mason** and **Chase Vosvick** landed on the second team and **Nico Brown** and **Daniel Osuji** were named to the third team.
- Sharifi (6 G, 3 A) was honored as the conference's Midfielder of the Year, becoming the first men's soccer player in Patriot League history to receive three major awards in his collegiate career, and Osuji (3 G, 1 A) became the third Greyhound in the last four years to be chosen as Rookie of the Year.
- Saramago (8 G, 9 A) is the first men's soccer player in conference history to be named first team All-Patriot League in all four collegiate seasons. He leads the Patriot League in points (25) and ranks tied for fifth nationally in assists.
- Fawole (8 G, 2 A) and Vosvick (8-7-1, 1.26 GAA, .630 save pct.) both become three-time all-conference honorees. Fawole was previously second team All-Patriot League in 2017 and 2018, while Vosvick was the two-time defending Goalkeeper of the Year.

Quick Notes

- Loyola, which was receiving votes in the latest United Soccer Coaches Division I poll, ranks 6th nationally in total assists (40), 8th in goals (39) and 14th in goals per game (2.17).
- The Greyhounds have allowed just two shots on goal in the last 347 minutes of game action dating back to the first half of a 1-1 draw with No. 2 Wake Forest on Oct. 22. They allowed one goal or fewer in each of their final seven regular season games.
- With **Jordan Wiley**'s goal vs. American, he became the 11th different Loyola player to score this season. Fifteen different Greyhounds have at least one point in 2019.
- Loyola is 8-1 this season when scoring multiple goals, and 8-1-1 when holding opponents to one goal or fewer.
- The Greyhounds have outshot their opponents in 12 of 18 games, and they have tied or had a greater number of corner kicks in 15 of 18 contests.
- Loyola is 27-9-3 against Patriot League opponents over the past three-plus years under head coach **Steve Nichols**.
- Mason and **Jacob Denison** have started every game for the Greyhounds on the back-line this season.

Program Turnaround under Nichols

- Sixth-year head coach **Steve Nichols**, a 1992 Loyola graduate, was hired to lead the Greyhounds men's soccer program on Feb. 6, 2014.
- After totaling a record of 7-21-6 (2-13-3 Patriot League) while rebuilding the program in his first two seasons, Nichols brought in Loyola's first-ever nationally-ranked recruiting class prior to the 2016 season.
- The Greyhounds went 31-17-5 (20-4-3 Patriot League) from 2016-18, topping the Patriot League regular season standings in both 2017 and 2018.
- Loyola was ranked No. 23 in the final United Soccer Coaches Top 25 poll of the 2018 regular season, entering the national rankings for the first time since 2009. The Greyhounds were included among schools receiving votes in this year's preseason Division I poll.
- Loyola is searching for its first Patriot League championship this season. A Patriot League title would clinch the program's first NCAA tournament appearance since 2009.

More on Saramago, Sharifi

- Brian Saramago** is the only player in Patriot League history to be named first team all-conference four times, and he has also been named All-Northeast Region in each of his three years at Loyola.
- Saramago (34 G, 23 A) is tied for 14th in program history in career goals, tied for 9th in career assists and alone in 14th in career points (91). He totaled eight goals and eight assists last season.
- Barry Sharifi** received his second-straight Patriot League Midfielder of the Year honor in 2018 after totaling four goals and four assists across 17 starts. He has 19 career goals, and he is tied for 15th all-time at Loyola with 19 assists.
- Saramago and Sharifi became Loyola's first All-America honorees since 2008 last fall.

More on Vosvick

- Chase Vosvick** has earned first team All-Northeast Region status in each of his first two collegiate seasons. He is 29-16-3 with a 1.06 goals-against average, a .721 save percentage and 18 shutouts through his first 49 appearances at Loyola.
- Vosvick has limited opponents to one goal or fewer in 20 of his 22 collegiate starts at Ridley Athletic Complex.

Other All-Patriot League Returners

- Sr. F **Josh Fawole** (5 G, 2 A), Sr. F **Nico Brown** (5 G, 1 A), Sr. D **Davey Mason** (1 G, 1 A) and Jr. M **Sam Brown** (3 G, 3 A) were all second team All-Patriot League honorees in 2018, while Sr. D **Jonathan Sousa** landed on the third team after contributing to a backline which surrendered just 12 goals all season.
- Fawole was named second team All-Patriot League for a second-straight season. He currently has 20 goals (including eight game-winners) and 10 assists during his time at Loyola.

Sharifi, Lussi to Captain Squad in 2019

- Senior midfielders **Barry Sharifi** and **Morgan Lussi** will serve as team captains for the 2019 season.
- Sharifi leads all active Greyhounds with 66 career starts and 70 career appearances.
- Lussi is a three-year starter who has cracked the Starting XI 33 times overall.
- Lussi's goal at Appalachian State on Sept. 1 was his first since the 2018 season opener, a 3-0 victory over Rutgers.

Nine Newcomers Join the Fold

- There are a total of nine new Greyhounds among the 2019 roster of 30 student-athletes. Jr. M **Justin Ingram** joins as a transfer from the University of Virginia, while **Jack Caldwell**, **Johan Granados**, **Jack Hosmer**, **Albert Kang**, **Matthew Lala**, **Spencer Natans**, **Daniel Osuji** and **Kristinn Pétursson** make up the incoming Class of 2023.
- Ingram won a USL2 National Championship while playing for Flint City Bucks this summer.
- Kang was a member of the Vancouver Whitecaps FC Academy in 2018, while Pétursson played 16 games with Iceland's National Youth Team.
