Quick Hits About The 'Hounds

- Loyola University Maryland men's soccer looks for a season-best third win in a row on Tuesday, traveling to Mount St. Mary's for a non-conference game beginning at 7 p.m.
- The Greyhounds have won four of their last six games overall since starting the year with four consecutive one-goal defeats.
- Loyola is 1-4 away from Ridley Athletic Complex this season, earning its first victory in its most-recent road contest at Bucknell last Wednesday.
- Seniors **Brian Saramago** and **Barry Sharifi** were each named to the 2019 MAC Hermann Trophy Watch List after earning third team All-America status last fall. Saramago is the Patriot League Preseason Offensive Player of the Year, while Sharifi was chosen as the conference's Preseason Midfielder of the Year.
- Chase Vosvick** is the two-time defending Patriot League GK of the Year.
- Sixth-year head coach **Steve Nichols** has received three-straight Patriot League Coach of the Year awards.

Last Time Out

- Barry Sharifi** scored twice, while **Daniel Osuji** and **Josh Fawole** added solo strikes in a 4-2 victory for Loyola over Lafayette on Saturday.
- Brian Saramago** chipped in a pair of assists for the Greyhounds, who handed the Leopards (7-3-1, 3-1) their first conference defeat of the season.
- Saramago logged his 75th career point, while Sharifi is up to 51 points during his time at Loyola.
- Matt Dabrowski** made a pair of saves to improve to 2-0 in goal on the year.
- Justin Ingram** and **Kristinn Pétursson** added assists in the victory, with Pétursson picking up his first collegiate point.
- Osuji and Fawole each scored their second goals of the season. Sharifi now has a team-high four goals in 2019.

Series History

- Loyola leads 24-4-1 in a series which dates back to 1954.
- The Greyhounds have won 19 games in a row over the Mountaineers, including a 3-1 victory at Ridley Athletic Complex last season.
- Brian Saramago** recorded the second of his three collegiate hat tricks in the win, breaking open a scoreless tie at halftime with goals in the 50th, 53rd and 65th minutes. Loyola had advantages in both shots (15-9) and corners (4-1).
- Mount St. Mary's last win over Loyola was a 2-0 victory on Oct. 23, 1964.

About the Mountaineers

- Mount St. Mary's (4-4, 1-1 Northeast Conference) snapped a four-game losing streak with a 2-1 overtime victory over St. Francis Brooklyn on Sunday. The Mountaineers have faced three Patriot League opponents, dropping 1-0 decisions to both Army and Navy and topping Bucknell by a 2-1 final on Sept. 6.
- Sophomore forward Yann Kouemi has scored four of the team's nine goals on the year.
- Mount St. Mary's has already doubled its win total from last year's mark of 2-10-4 (1-5-2 NEC). The program returned to competition in 2018 after being discontinued from 2013-17.
- The Mountaineers were ranked seventh out of 10 schools in the 2019 Northeast Conference preseason poll.

More Weekly Award Honorees

- Loyola received two out of the Patriot League's five weekly award winners on Monday, with **Barry Sharifi** chosen as Midfielder of the Week while **Jonathan Sousa** received Defender of the Week accolades.
- Sharifi is honored for the second time this season and the ninth time overall in his collegiate career.
- Sousa takes home his first-career weekly accolade.
- Six Loyola players have combined for eight Patriot League weekly awards so far in 2019, with **Justin Ingram**, **Davey Mason**, **Brian Saramago** and **Chase Vosvick** (2x) recognized previously.

Quick Notes

- Half of Loyola's six defeats in 2019 have come to teams currently ranked in the United Soccer Coaches Division I Top 25 national poll (Virginia Tech, James Madison, Navy). The Greyhounds will also travel to current #3 Wake Forest later this month on Tuesday, Oct. 22.
- Loyola's 4-2 win over Lafayette on Saturday was its first when surrendering a goal this season. Each of its previous three victories were clean sheets.
- The Greyhounds have outshot their opponents in each of the last six games, and they have tied or had a greater number of corner kicks in nine-consecutive contests.
- Brian Saramago** ranks fourth in the Patriot League in shots per game this season (2.80, 28 total). He recorded his third collegiate hat trick during Loyola's 4-0 victory over Army West Point on Sept. 21.
- Daniel Osuji** has each played all 915 minutes in Loyola's first 10 games this season. Four players (Osuji, **Jacob Denison** and **Davey Mason**) have started all 10 contests.
- Nine different Greyhounds have scored at least one goal in 2019, and 12 different Loyola players have recorded at least one point.

Greyhounds vs. The Patriot League

- Loyola is 23-5-3 in the regular season against Patriot League opponents over the past three-plus years under head coach **Steve Nichols**.
- The Greyhounds are looking for their first postseason Patriot League championship. They were ranked first with 12 out of 20 first-place votes in this year's Patriot League preseason poll.

Program Turnaround under Nichols

- Sixth-year head coach **Steve Nichols**, a 1992 Loyola graduate, was hired to lead the Greyhounds men's soccer program on Feb. 6, 2014.
- After totaling a record of 7-21-6 (2-13-3 Patriot League) while rebuilding the program in his first two seasons, Nichols brought in Loyola's first-ever nationally-ranked recruiting class prior to the 2016 season.
- The Greyhounds went 31-17-5 (20-4-3 Patriot League) from 2016-18, topping the Patriot League regular season standings in both 2017 and 2018.
- Loyola was ranked No. 23 in the final United Soccer Coaches Top 25 poll of the 2018 regular season, entering the national rankings for the first time since 2009. The Greyhounds were included among schools receiving votes in this year's preseason Division I poll.
- Loyola is searching for its first Patriot League championship this season. A Patriot League title would clinch the program's first NCAA tournament appearance since 2009.

More on Saramago, Sharifi

- Brian Saramago** is one of 12 players in Patriot League history to be named first team all-conference three times, and he has also been named All-Northeast Region in each of his three years at Loyola.
- Saramago (29 G, 15 A) is tied for 17th in program history in career goals, and he is 21st all-time in career points. He totaled eight goals and eight assists last season.
- Barry Sharifi** received his second-straight Patriot League Midfielder of the Year honor in 2018 after totaling four goals and four assists across 17 starts. He has 17 career goals, and he is tied for 16th all-time at Loyola with 17 assists.
- Saramago and Sharifi became Loyola's first All-America honorees since 2008 last fall.

More on Vosvick

- Chase Vosvick** has earned first team All-Northeast Region status in each of his first two collegiate seasons. He is 23-15-2 with a 1.09 goals-against average, a .729 save percentage and 16 shutouts through his first 41 appearances at Loyola.
- Vosvick has limited opponents to one goal or fewer in 17 of his 19 collegiate starts at Ridley Athletic Complex.

Other All-Patriot League Returners

- Sr. F **Josh Fawole** (5 G, 2 A), Sr. F **Nico Brown** (5 G, 1 A), Sr. D **Davey Mason** (1 G, 1 A) and Jr. M **Sam Brown** (3 G, 3 A) were all second team All-Patriot League honorees in 2018, while Sr. D **Jonathan Sousa** landed on the third team after contributing to a backline which surrendered just 12 goals all season.
- Fawole was named second team All-Patriot League for a second-straight season. He currently has 14 goals (including seven game-winners) and eight assists during his time at Loyola.

Sharifi, Lussi to Captain Squad in 2019

- Senior midfielders **Barry Sharifi** and **Morgan Lussi** will serve as team captains for the 2019 season.
- Sharifi leads all active Greyhounds with 59 career starts and 62 career appearances..
- Lussi is a three-year starter who has cracked the Starting XI 33 times overall.
- Lussi's goal at Appalachian State on Sept. 1 was his first since the 2018 season opener, a 3-0 victory over Rutgers.

Nine Newcomers Join the Fold

- There are a total of nine new Greyhounds among the 2019 roster of 30 student-athletes. Jr. M **Justin Ingram** joins as a transfer from the University of Virginia, while **Jack Caldwell**, **Johan Granados**, **Jack Hosmer**, **Albert Kang**, **Matthew Lala**, **Spencer Natans**, **Daniel Osuji** and **Kristinn Pétursson** make up the incoming Class of 2023.
- Ingram won a USL2 National Championship while playing for Flint City Bucks this summer.
- Kang was a member of the Vancouver Whitecaps FC Academy in 2018, while Pétursson played 16 games with Iceland's National Youth Team.
