## Quick Hits About The 'Hounds

- Loyola University Maryland men's soccer is back at Ridley Athletic Complex on Tuesday, hosting NJIT in its second-to-last non-conference game of the regular season.
- This will be the first-ever meeting between Loyola and NJIT.
- The Greyhounds are 3-1 at home this season, including a 4-2 victory over Lafayette in their most-recent contest on Oct. 5.
- Loyola has scored 10 goals in its first four games at Ridley this season.
- Seniors **Brian Saramago** and **Barry Sharifi** were each named to the 2019 MAC Hermann Trophy Watch List after earning third team All-America status last fall. Saramago is the Patriot League Preseason Offensive Player of the Year, while Sharifi was chosen as the conference's Preseason Midfielder of the Year.
- Chase Vosvick** is the two-time defending Patriot League GK of the Year.
- Sixth-year head coach **Steve Nichols** has received three-straight Patriot League Coach of the Year awards.

## Last Time Out

- Nick Jennings converted a penalty kick with 4:12 remaining in the opening half, and Lehigh withstood a barrage of Loyola shots to hold on for a 1-0 victory over the Greyhounds on Saturday.
- Loyola saw its three-game winning streak come to an end despite a 25-10 advantage in shots, including a 17-5 margin in the second half.
- Loyola's 25 shots were its most in a game since a 26-shot effort against Canisius on Oct. 9, 2005.
- Brian Saramago** and **Josh Fawole** led the Greyhounds with six shots apiece, while **Barry Sharifi** had five shots for the visitors.
- Lehigh (8-3-1, 4-0-1) moved into a tie with Navy for first place in the Patriot League standings. Will Smith made seven saves in goal to secure the clean sheet.

## Series History

- This will be the first-ever meeting between Loyola and NJIT.
- The Greyhounds are 3-0-1 lifetime against the eight current members of the Atlantic Sun Conference.
- Loyola drew 1-1 against Stetson in 2014, topped Liberty by a 2-0 final in the 2007 NCAA tournament and recorded a pair of wins against Jacksonville in 1988 and 1974.

## About the Highlanders

- NJIT (5-3-4, 2-1 A-Sun) is coming off back-to-back victories over North Florida (2-0) and VMI (5-0), and the Highlanders are 3-0-1 in their last four contests overall.
- Redshirt junior forward Rene White leads the A-Sun and ranks fifth in Division I with 11 goals through the team's first 12 games. He has scored in seven games, tallying multiple goals in four of those contests.
- NJIT averages 2.25 goals per game overall, a figure which ranks 15th nationally.
- The Highlanders went 6-11 (1-5 A-Sun) last season. They were projected to finish seventh out of eight teams in this year's Atlantic Sun preseason poll.

## Two More 2018 NCAA Tournament Teams Upcoming

- Following Tuesday's matchup with NJIT, Loyola's next two contests will be against teams which qualified for the 2018 NCAA Tournament.
- The Greyhounds are at defending Patriot League champions Colgate at 2:30 p.m. on Saturday, and they travel to a Wake Forest squad which was ranked No. 6 in the latest United Soccer Coaches Division I poll next Tuesday night.
- Loyola had six 2018 NCAA tournament teams on its schedule this fall.

## Quick Notes

- Six Loyola players have combined for eight Patriot League weekly awards so far in 2019, with **Justin Ingram**, **Davey Mason**, **Brian Saramago**, **Jonathan Sousa**, **Barry Sharifi** (2x) and **Chase Vosvick** (2x) each earning recognition.
- Loyola is 4-1 this season when scoring multiple goals. Saturday's loss at Lehigh dropped the Greyhounds to 1-5 in one-goal games on the year.
- The Greyhounds have outshot their opponents in each of the last eight games, and they have tied or had a greater number of corner kicks in 11-consecutive contests.
- Four of Loyola's seven defeats have come to teams ranked in the most-recent United Soccer Coaches Division I Top 25 poll (James Madison, Navy, NC State, Virginia Tech).
- **Brian Saramago** leads the Patriot League and ranks 22nd nationally in shots per game this season (3.67, 44 total). He recorded his third collegiate hat trick during Loyola's 4-0 victory over Army West Point on Sept. 21.
- Saramago is tied for 17th all-time in team history in goals (29) and he is tied for 14th all-time in assists (19).
- **Daniel Osuji** has played 1091 out of a possible 1095 minutes in Loyola's first 12 games this season. Three players (Osuji, **Jacob Denison** and **Davey Mason**) have started all 12 contests.
- Ten different Greyhounds have scored at least one goal in 2019, and 13 players have recorded at least one point.

## Greyhounds vs. The Patriot League

- Loyola is 23-6-3 in the regular season against Patriot League opponents over the past three-plus years under head coach **Steve Nichols**.
- The Greyhounds are looking for their first postseason Patriot League championship. They were ranked first with 12 out of 20 first-place votes in this year's Patriot League preseason poll.

## Program Turnaround under Nichols

- Sixth-year head coach **Steve Nichols**, a 1992 Loyola graduate, was hired to lead the Greyhounds men's soccer program on Feb. 6, 2014.
- After totaling a record of 7-21-6 (2-13-3 Patriot League) while rebuilding the program in his first two seasons, Nichols brought in Loyola's first-ever nationally-ranked recruiting class prior to the 2016 season.
- The Greyhounds went 31-17-5 (20-4-3 Patriot League) from 2016-18, topping the Patriot League regular season standings in both 2017 and 2018.
- Loyola was ranked No. 23 in the final United Soccer Coaches Top 25 poll of the 2018 regular season, entering the national rankings for the first time since 2009. The Greyhounds were included among schools receiving votes in this year's preseason Division I poll.
- Loyola is searching for its first Patriot League championship this season. A Patriot League title would clinch the program's first NCAA tournament appearance since 2009.

## More on Saramago, Sharifi

- Brian Saramago** is one of 12 players in Patriot League history to be named first team all-conference three times, and he has also been named All-Northeast Region in each of his three years at Loyola.
- Saramago (29 G, 19 A) is tied for 17th in program history in career goals, and he is 19th all-time in career points. He totaled eight goals and eight assists last season.
- Barry Sharifi** received his second-straight Patriot League Midfielder of the Year honor in 2018 after totaling four goals and four assists across 17 starts. He has 17 career goals, and he is tied for 16th all-time at Loyola with 18 assists.
- Saramago and Sharifi became Loyola's first All-America honorees since 2008 last fall.

## More on Vosvick

- Chase Vosvick** has earned first team All-Northeast Region status in each of his first two collegiate seasons. He is 24-16-2 with a 1.11 goals-against average, a .722 save percentage and 16 shutouts through his first 43 appearances at Loyola.
- Vosvick has limited opponents to one goal or fewer in 17 of his 19 collegiate starts at Ridley Athletic Complex.

## Other All-Patriot League Returners

- Sr. F **Josh Fawole** (5 G, 2 A), Sr. F **Nico Brown** (5 G, 1 A), Sr. D **Davey Mason** (1 G, 1 A) and Jr. M **Sam Brown** (3 G, 3 A) were all second team All-Patriot League honorees in 2018, while Sr. D **Jonathan Sousa** landed on the third team after contributing to a backline which surrendered just 12 goals all season.
- Fawole was named second team All-Patriot League for a second-straight season. He currently has 15 goals (including seven game-winners) and eight assists during his time at Loyola.

## Sharifi, Lussi to Captain Squad in 2019

- Senior midfielders **Barry Sharifi** and **Morgan Lussi** will serve as team captains for the 2019 season.
- Sharifi leads all active Greyhounds with 60 career starts and 64 career appearances.
- Lussi is a three-year starter who has cracked the Starting XI 33 times overall.
- Lussi's goal at Appalachian State on Sept. 1 was his first since the 2018 season opener, a 3-0 victory over Rutgers.

## Nine Newcomers Join the Fold

- There are a total of nine new Greyhounds among the 2019 roster of 30 student-athletes. Jr. M **Justin Ingram** joins as a transfer from the University of Virginia, while **Jack Caldwell**, **Johan Granados**, **Jack Hosmer**, **Albert Kang**, **Matthew Lala**, **Spencer Natans**, **Daniel Osuji** and **Kristinn Pétursson** make up the incoming Class of 2023.
- Ingram won a USL2 National Championship while playing for Flint City Bucks this summer.
- Kang was a member of the Vancouver Whitecaps FC Academy in 2018, while Pétursson played 16 games with Iceland's National Youth Team.
