Ouick Hits About The 'Hounds

- Loyola University Maryland men's soccer looks to remain unbeaten at home this season, returning to Ridley Athletic Complex to host #25 Navy at 12 p.m. on Saturday.
- The Greyhounds have outscored opponents 6-0 at Ridley in 2019, including a 4-0 win over Army in the Patriot League opener for both teams last Saturday.
- Loyola has a 14-4-2 record at Ridley dating back to the start of the 2017 season.
- Seniors Brian Saramago and Barry
 Sharifi were each named to the 2019
 MAC Hermann Trophy Watch List after
 earning third team All-America status
 last fall. Saramago is the Patriot League
 Preseason Offensive Player of the Year,
 while Sharifi was chosen as the conference's Preseason Midfielder of the Year.
- **Chase Vosvick** is the two-time defending Patriot League GK of the Year.
- Sixth-year head coach Steve Nichols has received three-straight Patriot League Coach of the Year awards.

Last Time Out

- William & Mary scored two goals in a span of less than eight minutes midway through the second half, sending Loyola to a 2-0 road defeat on Tuesday evening
- The Greyhounds had an 11-10 edge in shots and a convincing 8-2 lead in corner kicks, but they were shutout for the first time in 2019.
- **Brian Saramago** had a team-high five shots in the defeat.
- The Greyhounds dropped to 0-4 in road games this season, while William & Mary (1-4-2) picked up its first victory on the year.
- Daniel Osuji and Jacob Denison played all 90 minutes on the backline; they are the lone two field players to appear in all 645 minutes this season.

Series History

- The series is even at 4-4-2 through the first 10 meetings all-time between the two sides.
- The Greyhounds have won three games in a row over Navy, including a 4-1 triumph in Annapolis last September.
- Brian Saramago had a goal and two assists in that win, while Sam Brown, Barry Sharifi and Nico Brown were the other goal scorers.
- Navy's last victory in the series was a 1-0 home triumph on Sept. 26, 2015.

About the Midshipmen

- Navy (8-0-0) is off to its best start since beginning the 1966 season with nine-consecutive victories.
- At #25 in the latest United Soccer Coaches' Division I poll, the Mids are nationally-ranked for the first time since October, 2014.
- Navy has won 12 games in a row dating back to last season, the longest current winning streak in Division I.
- Jacob Williams (5 G, 1 A) leads the team with 11 points, while Nicko West and Matt Nocita have scored three goals apiece. Navy has outscored opponents by a 15-2 margin this season.
- Ian Bramblett is 8-0 with six shutouts, a 0.25 GAA and a .882 save percentage in goal.

Three More Patriot League Weekly Honors

- For a second-straight week, Loyola players accounted for three of the Patriot League's
 five weekly award winners on Monday, as Chase Vosvick repeated as Goalkeeper of
 the Week, Brian Saramago earned Offensive Player of the Week status and Justin
 Ingram took home Midfielder of the Week accolades.
- Vosvick (6x goalkeeper, 3x rookie) was recognized for the ninth time in his Loyola career. He is 14-3-1 lifetime against Patriot League opposition, and he has allowed one goal or fewer in 17 of 18 career starts at home.
- Saramago received his fifth-career Offensive Player of the Week honor and his seventh
 weekly award from the conference after scoring three goals in last Saturday's 4-0 win
 over Army. Twenty of his 29 career goals have come against Patriot League teams.
- Davey Mason was also included among the honorable mention selections for the week
 after recording the primary assist on Saramago's second goal on Saturday. He had
 points in three-consecutive games (1 G, 2 A) from Sept. 8-21.

Greyhounds vs. The Patriot League

- Loyola is 21-4-3 (11-2-2 at Ridley Athletic Complex) in the regular season against Patriot League opponents over the past three-plus years under head coach **Steve Nichols**.
- The Greyhounds are looking for their first postseason Patriot League championship. They were ranked first with 12 out of 20 first-place votes in this year's Patriot League preseason poll.

Quick Notes

- In addition to his Patriot League honor, **Brian Saramago** was recognized on CollegeSoccerNews.com's Division I National Team of the Week on Monday. Saramago was one of 14 players honored across the country.
- Loyola has posted three-straight shutouts against Patriot League opponents in the regular season, outscoring opponents 6-0 during that span.
- Loyola's last win over a ranked opponent was a 1-0 home victory over #11 UMBC on Sept. 12. 2015.
- Chase Vosvick's shutout streak ended at 237:47 on Tuesday night. That was the second-longest run of his career, behind only a stretch of 262:16 from Oct. 24-Nov. 9 last season.
- Vosvick, Jacob Denison and Daniel Osuji have each played all 645 minutes in Loyola's first seven games this season. Five players (Vosvick, Denison, Osuji, Davey Mason, Barry Sharifi) have started all seven contests.

Program Turnaround under Nichols

- Sixth-year head coach **Steve Nichols**, a 1992 Loyola graduate, was hired to lead the Greyhounds men's soccer program on Feb. 6, 2014.
- After totaling a record of 7-21-6 (2-13-3 Patriot League) while rebuilding the program in his first two seasons, Nichols brought in Loyola's first-ever nationally-ranked recruiting class prior to the 2016 season.
- The Greyhounds went 31-17-5 (20-4-3 Patriot League) from 2016-18, topping the Patriot League regular season standings in both 2017 and 2018.
- Loyola was ranked No. 23 in the final United Soccer Coaches Top 25 poll of the 2018
 regular season, entering the national rankings for the first time since 2009. The Greyhounds were included among schools receiving votes in this year's preseason Division
 I poll.
- Loyola is searching for its first Patriot League championship this season. A Patriot League title would clinch the program's first NCAA tournament appearance since 2009.

More on Saramago, Sharifi

- **Brian Saramago** is one of 12 players in Patriot League history to be named first team all-conference three times, and he has also been named All-Northeast Region in each of his three years at Loyola.
- Saramago (29 G, 15 A) is tied for 17th in program history in career goals, and he is 21st all-time in career points. He totaled eight goals and eight assists last season.
- **Barry Sharifi** received his second-straight Patriot League Midfielder of the Year honor in 2018 after totaling four goals and four assists across 17 starts. He has 15 career goals, and he is tied for 16th all-time at Loyola with 17 assists.
- Saramago and Sharifi became Loyola's first All-America honorees since 2008 last fall.

More on Vosvick

- **Chase Vosvick** has earned first team All-Northeast Region status in each of his first two collegiate seasons. He is 23-14-2 with a 1.07 goals-against average, a .737 save percentage and 16 shutouts through his first 40 appearances at Loyola.
- Vosvick has limited opponents to one goal or fewer in 17 of his 18 collegiate starts at Ridley Athletic Complex.

Other All-Patriot League Returners

- Sr. F Josh Fawole (5 G, 2 A), Sr. F Nico Brown (5 G, 1 A), Sr. D Davey Mason (1 G, 1 A) and Jr. M Sam Brown (3 G, 3 A) were all second team All-Patriot League honorees in 2018, while Sr. D Jonathan Sousa landed on the third team after contributing to a backline which surrendered just 12 goals all season.
- Fawole was named second team All-Patriot League for a second-straight season. He
 currently has 13 goals (including seven game-winners) and eight assists during his
 time at Loyola.

Sharifi, Lussi to Captain Squad in 2019

- Senior midfielders Barry Sharifi and Morgan Lussi will serve as team captains for the 2019 season.
- Sharifi leads all active Greyhounds with 56 career starts and 59 career appearances..
- Lussi is a three-year starter who has cracked the Starting XI 32 times overall.
- Lussi's goal at Appalachian State on Sept. 1 was his first since the 2018 season opener, a 3-0 victory over Rutgers.

Nine Newcomers Join the Fold

- There are a total of nine new Greyhounds among the 2019 roster of 30 student-athletes. Jr. M Justin Ingram joins as a transfer from the University of Virginia, while Jack Caldwell, Johan Granados, Jack Hosmer, Albert Kang, Matthew Lala, Spencer Nattans, Daniel Osuji and Kristinn Pétursson make up the incoming Class of 2023.
- Ingram won a USL2 National Championship while playing for Flint City Bucks this summer
- Kang was a member of the Vancouver Whitecaps FC Academy in 2018, while Pétursson played 16 games with Iceland's National Youth Team.
