## Quick Hits About The 'Hounds

- Loyola University Maryland men's soccer is on the road for its final non-conference game of the regular season, taking on #2 Wake Forest in a challenging matchup at 7 p.m. on Tuesday.
- The Greyhounds have won five of their first six games in October, scoring 15 goals during that span.
- Loyola has topped the Patriot League regular season standings in each of the past two seasons.
- The Greyhounds are 2-5 away from home in 2019 (1-1 in conference play).
- Seniors **Brian Saramago** and **Barry Sharifi** were each named to the 2019 MAC Hermann Trophy Watch List after earning third team All-America status last fall. Saramago is the Patriot League Preseason Offensive Player of the Year, while Sharifi was chosen as the conference's Preseason Midfielder of the Year.
- Chase Vosvick** is the two-time defending Patriot League GK of the Year.
- Sixth-year head coach **Steve Nichols** has received three-straight Patriot League Coach of the Year awards.

## Last Time Out

- Jonathan Sousa** deflected in the game-winner 2:11 into overtime, as Loyola knocked off three-time defending Patriot League champions Colgate by a 2-1 final on the road Saturday.
- Eddy Rodriguez** and **Josh Fawole** set up the winner, with Rodriguez heading the ball to Fawole, who sent in a cross from the right side.
- Brian Saramago** added his second goal in as many games for the Greyhounds,

who are now tied for third with Lafayette in the conference standings.

- Colgate led 14-2 in shots through the first 62 minutes of the contest. Loyola held a 11-1 advantage for the final half hour of game action.
- Chase Vosvick** finished with three saves to record his second-consecutive victory in goal.

## Series History

- This will be the first-ever meeting between the two sides.
- Loyola has faced two ACC opponents this season, falling 2-1 at NC State in its season opener on Aug. 30 and dropping another 2-1 decision to then-No. 10 Virginia Tech on Sept. 6.
- Loyola's last win over an ACC foe was a 2-1 victory over Pittsburgh on Sept. 20, 2016.

## About the Demon Deacons

- Wake Forest (12-2, 5-1 ACC) has advanced to the NCAA tournament in 17 of the last 18 seasons, including a national championship run in 2007.
- The Demon Deacons are 9-0 at home this season, outscoring opponents by a 25-4 margin in those nine contests.
- Goalkeeper Andrew Pannenberg ranks 12th in Division I in goals-against average (0.58), and he is 33rd in save percentage (.784).
- Fourteen different players have recorded a point in 2019, with Bruno Lapa (6 G, 3 A, 4 GWG) leading the offense.
- Wake Forest has the most wins in Division I since the hiring of head coach Bobby Muuss in 2015, with a record of 85-13-7 during that span.

## More Weekly Honors for Sharifi, Sousa

- Barry Sharifi (Midfielder) and Jonathan Sousa (Defender) each received Patriot League weekly awards on Monday after providing the game-winning goals during a 2-0 week for the Greyhounds.
- Sharifi, who scored his team-leading third GWG in a 4-1 win over NJIT last Tuesday, is honored for a third time this season and a 10th time overall at Loyola.
- Sousa takes home his second-career weekly award. Both Sharifi and Sousa were previously recognized by the conference two weeks ago on Oct. 7.

## Quick Notes

- Brian Saramago** leads the Patriot League and is 26th in Division I with six assists this season. He has a team-high 16 points (5 G, 6 A) overall, and his 1.14 ppg rank third in the conference.
- Josh Fawole**, a two-time second team All-Patriot League selection, has points in four of Loyola's last five games (3 G, 1 A).
- Loyola's last win over a ranked opponent was a 1-0 triumph over No. 11 UMBC on Sept. 12, 2015.
- Loyola is 6-1 this season when scoring multiple goals.
- The Greyhounds have outshot their opponents in 9 of 14 games, and they have tied or had a greater number of corner kicks in 12 of 14 contests.
- Four of Loyola's seven defeats have come to teams ranked or receiving votes in the most-recent United Soccer Coaches Division I Top 25 poll (James Madison, Navy, NC State, Virginia Tech).
- Six Loyola players have combined for 10 Patriot League weekly awards so far in 2019, with Sharifi (3x), Sousa (2x), **Chase Vosvick** (2x), Saramago, **Justin Ingram**, and **Davey Mason** each earning recognition.
- Saramago leads the Patriot League and ranks 20th nationally in shots per game this season (3.64, 51 total).
- Mason and **Jacob Denison** have started every game for the Greyhounds on the back-line this season.

## Greyhounds vs. The Patriot League

- Loyola is 24-6-3 in the regular season against Patriot League opponents over the past three-plus years under head coach **Steve Nichols**.
- The Greyhounds are looking for their first postseason Patriot League championship. They were ranked first with 12 out of 20 first-place votes in this year's Patriot League preseason poll.

## Program Turnaround under Nichols

- Sixth-year head coach **Steve Nichols**, a 1992 Loyola graduate, was hired to lead the Greyhounds men's soccer program on Feb. 6, 2014.
- After totaling a record of 7-21-6 (2-13-3 Patriot League) while rebuilding the program in his first two seasons, Nichols brought in Loyola's first-ever nationally-ranked recruiting class prior to the 2016 season.
- The Greyhounds went 31-17-5 (20-4-3 Patriot League) from 2016-18, topping the Patriot League regular season standings in both 2017 and 2018.
- Loyola was ranked No. 23 in the final United Soccer Coaches Top 25 poll of the 2018 regular season, entering the national rankings for the first time since 2009. The Greyhounds were included among schools receiving votes in this year's preseason Division I poll.
- Loyola is searching for its first Patriot League championship this season. A Patriot League title would clinch the program's first NCAA tournament appearance since 2009.

## More on Saramago, Sharifi

- Brian Saramago** is one of 12 players in Patriot League history to be named first team all-conference three times, and he has also been named All-Northeast Region in each of his three years at Loyola.
- Saramago (31 G, 20 A) is ranked 16th in program history in career goals, and he is tied for 16th all-time in career points. He totaled eight goals and eight assists last season.
- Barry Sharifi** received his second-straight Patriot League Midfielder of the Year honor in 2018 after totaling four goals and four assists across 17 starts. He has 18 career goals, and he is tied for 15th all-time at Loyola with 19 assists.
- Saramago and Sharifi became Loyola's first All-America honorees since 2008 last fall.

## More on Vosvick

- Chase Vosvick** has earned first team All-Northeast Region status in each of his first two collegiate seasons. He is 26-16-2 with a 1.10 goals-against average, a .723 save percentage and 16 shutouts through his first 45 appearances at Loyola.
- Vosvick has limited opponents to one goal or fewer in 18 of his 20 collegiate starts at Ridley Athletic Complex.

## Other All-Patriot League Returners

- Sr. F **Josh Fawole** (5 G, 2 A), Sr. F **Nico Brown** (5 G, 1 A), Sr. D **Davey Mason** (1 G, 1 A) and Jr. M **Sam Brown** (3 G, 3 A) were all second team All-Patriot League honorees in 2018, while Sr. D **Jonathan Sousa** landed on the third team after contributing to a backline which surrendered just 12 goals all season.
- Fawole was named second team All-Patriot League for a second-straight season. He currently has 16 goals (including seven game-winners) and nine assists during his time at Loyola.

## Sharifi, Lussi to Captain Squad in 2019

- Senior midfielders **Barry Sharifi** and **Morgan Lussi** will serve as team captains for the 2019 season.
- Sharifi leads all active Greyhounds with 62 career starts and 66 career appearances.
- Lussi is a three-year starter who has cracked the Starting XI 33 times overall.
- Lussi's goal at Appalachian State on Sept. 1 was his first since the 2018 season opener, a 3-0 victory over Rutgers.

## Nine Newcomers Join the Fold

- There are a total of nine new Greyhounds among the 2019 roster of 30 student-athletes. Jr. M **Justin Ingram** joins as a transfer from the University of Virginia, while **Jack Caldwell**, **Johan Granados**, **Jack Hosmer**, **Albert Kang**, **Matthew Lala**, **Spencer Natans**, **Daniel Osuji** and **Kristinn Pétursson** make up the incoming Class of 2023.
- Ingram won a USL2 National Championship while playing for Flint City Bucks this summer.
- Kang was a member of the Vancouver Whitecaps FC Academy in 2018, while Pétursson played 16 games with Iceland's National Youth Team.
