THE MATCHUP

- Loyola men's soccer is down to its final three games of the regular season, beginning with a 4 p.m. contest at Colgate this weekend.
- The Greyhounds can clinch their sixth-straight Patriot League tournament appearance with a victory and a tie between Bucknell and Boston University.
- Loyola has won three of its last four conference games, including victories over Navy (2-0) and American (3-0) last week.

LAST TIME OUT

- A Wake Forest squad receiving votes in the latest United Soccer Coaches national poll won its fourth-straight game on Tuesday night as the 2020 NCAA Quarterfinalists shut out Loyola, 7-0, at Spry Stadium.
- Julian Kennedy scored three times, while Colin Thomas added a goal and two assists the Demon Deacons (9-4-1 overall).
- Wake Forest finished the evening with a 13-6 edge in shots and a slim 4-3 advantage in corner kicks.

OFFENSIVE LEADERS

- **Justin Ingram** (6 G, 7 A, 19 pts) and **Kelan Swales** (5 G, 2 A, 12 pts) have factored in 14 of Loyola's 20 goals on the year.
- Ingram is tied for first in the conference in assists (18th in DI), and he is second in both points (29th in DI) and goals (60th in DI). He has totaled 13 points (4 G, 5 A) in Loyola's last seven games and received his fifth career PL Midfielder of the Week award on Monday.
- Swales totaled a career-high five points (2 G, 1 A) in a 3-0 win over William & Mary (9/29), and he added game-winning goals against both Lehigh and Boston U during conference play.
- **Daniel Tshiani** (3 G, 1 A) now ranks third on the team with seven points after scoring the game-winning goal in victories over American and Navy last week. He was honored as the PL Offensive Player of the Week on Monday.

DEFENSE STEPPING UP IN PATRIOT LEAGUE PLAY

- Loyola concluded a three-game homestand last week against two Patriot League leaders which had both been shutout only one time on the year.
- The Greyhounds blanked both American, the defending Patriot League champions, and Navy, which topped the conference standings entering the weekend, while allowing just two shots on goal in each contest.
- Defensive contributors included Jacob Denison, Jordy Luchies, Kristinn Pétursson, Matthew Lala and Jonathan Sousa. Denison was honored as the PL Defensive Player of the Week for the first time in his career on Monday.
- **Chase Vosvick** received his 11th career PL Goalkeeper of the Week award after making a pair of saves in both victories. He is 6-5-1 this season with five shutouts, a 1.13 goals-against average and a .690 save percentage.

 Loyola returns to Ridley Athletic Complex next weekend, hosting Army West Point in its regular season home finale at 1 p.m. on Saturday.

SERIES HISTORY

- Loyola leads 4-3-2 in a series which began when the Greyhounds joined the Patriot League in 2013.
- **Jonathan Sousa** provided the game-winner in the 93rd minute of a 2-1 road victory for Loyola during the last meeting on Oct. 16, 2019. **Josh Fawole** and **Eddy Rodriguez** added assists on the GWG.
- Each of the last three games between the two sides has gone to overtime, as the teams played to a scoreless draw during the 2018 regular season while Colgate edged out a 3-2 overtime win in the 2017 Patriot League semifinals.
- Loyola is 2-1-1 in four previous matchups at Colgate's Beyer-Small '76 Field.

SCOUTING COLGATE

- The Raiders (0-15-0, 0-6-0 PL) are the only team in Division I without a win or draw this season. They rank last in the Patriot League in both goals per game (0.20) and goals allowed per game (2.01).
- Sr. GK Nick Gerlach has started 10 of Colgate's 15 games in goal. He leads the conference in saves per game (4.50, 31st in Division I) and he is second in total saves (45).
- The Raiders have been outscored 31-3 on the year. Sr. F Edward Bass, Sr. F Ryan Krueger and Jr. M Max Edelstein are the team's three goalscorers.
- Colgate held a 1-0 lead at halftime of its most-recent game against Albany on Tuesday, but the Great Danes scored two goals less than three minutes apart midway through the second half to pull out a 2-1 victory.
- The Raiders have won eight Patriot League championships, including a run of threestraight titles from 2016-18.

QUICK NOTES

- The Greyhounds are 6-0-1 this season when scoring multiple goals. They are also 5-0 when leading at halftime and 4-0 when they outshoot opponents.
- Matthew Lala (2 G, 1 A) and Loc San (2 G, 1 A) are tied for fourth on the team in scoring with five points apiece.
- **Kevin Medrano** ranks second behind **Justin Ingram** with three assists on the year.
- Seven Greyhounds have combined for 12 PL weekly awards this season, led by Chase Vosvick (4x Goalkeeper of the Week) and Ingram (3x Midfielder of the Week)
- Twenty different Loyola players, including seven of the program's 12 new additions to the roster for 2021, have started at least one game this season.
- Jordy Luchies is the only Loyola player to start each of the season's first 14 games.

- **Chase Vosvick** is a three-time United Soccer Coaches first team All-Region selection (2017-19) and a three-time Patriot League Goalkeeper of the Year (2017-18, Spring 2021). He was also named to the MAC Hermann Trophy Watch List prior to the 2021 spring season.
- Vosvick has started 67 of Loyola's 74 games over the past four seasons, and is 38-22-6 with a 1.04 goals-against average, .718 save percentage and 25 solo shutouts in those 67 appearances.

GREYHOUNDS EARN DRAW AT NO. 5 WEST VIRGINIA

- **Chase Vosvick** matched a career-high with seven saves, including several high-light-reel efforts, and Loyola was even in shots with nationally-ranked West Virginia for the final 65 minutes of a 0-0 draw between the two sides on Sept. 6.
- West Virginia was coming off back-to-back victories over No. 3 Pittsburgh (2-1) and No. 17 Penn State (3-1), but was held off the scoresheet for the first time this season.
- Shots were even at 6-6 after halftime, including a 5-4 edge for Loyola in the second half. **Alex Bobocea** played the final 1:05 in goal after Vosvick left due to injury.
- Loyola was playing its first ranked opponent since earning a 1-1 draw at then-No. 2
 Wake Forest back on Oct. 22, 2019.

PRESEASON PATRIOT LEAGUE HONOREES

- **Justin Ingram** was voted in August to repeat as the Patriot League Midfielder of the Year. He is one of seven Greyhounds to return as a graduate student, taking advantage of the extra year of eligibility granted by the NCAA due to COVID-19.
- Ingram was a first team United Soccer Coaches All-Region and first team All-Patriot League performer last spring after leading Loyola with nine points (3 G, 3 A).
- All three of Loyola's Spring 2021 major award winners were recognized on the Preseason All-PL Team, with Ingram joined by Sam Brown and Chase Vosvick.
- Brown was a second team United Soccer Coaches All-Region performer last season after ranking second on the team with six points (2 G, 2 A). He was the program's first Patriot League Offensive POY since Loyola joined the conference in 2013.
- Vosvick is now a four-time Preseason All-League selection. He earned his third PL Goalkeeper of the Year honor in the spring after finishing 3-1-1 with a 0.92 goalsagainst average and .722 save percentage.
- For a fourth time in the past five seasons, Loyola was projected to finish atop the Patriot League standings, as the Greyhounds (149 points, 10 first-place votes) edged American (137, 7) for the top spot in the conference's preseason poll.

LOTS OF NEW FACES

- Loyola has 12 new additions to the roster for the 2021 fall campaign, including four transfers and eight members of the recruiting Class of 2025.
- Marco Bla (Old Dominion), Tony Saldana (Carson-Newman), Daniel Tshiani (Montgomery College) and Beneyam Yifru (Gardner-Webb) join the program as transfers. The freshmen class includes Alex Bobocea, Kyle Dengler, Sean Graham, Jose Joya, Carson Kourtesis, Jordy Luchies, Jake Mayer and Jake Sweeney.
- Dengler, Joya and Mayer all played for local club powerhouse Baltimore Armour.
 Graham represented his home country of Northern Ireland up through the U-21 level, while Luchies spent several years in the youth academy at FC Emmen, which competed in the Eredivisie from 2018-21.

ALSO WORTH NOTING

- Jacob Denison, Justin Ingram and Chase Vosvick are Loyola's team captains for the 2021 fall campaign.
- Albert Kang holds a 4.0 cumulative GPA while majoring in business administration.
 He was joined by Denison and Vosvick on the Academic All-PL Team last spring.
- Loyola men's soccer combined for a team GPA of 3.47 during the most-recent spring semester. Twenty Greyhounds had GPA's above a 3.50, with Kang, Matthew Lala, Spencer Nattans and Vosvick all posting perfect 4.0 GPA's.

LAST SEASON

- With the Patriot League split into two divisions during the COVID-19 impacted spring campaign, the Greyhounds (3-2-1, 3-1-1 PL) won their final two regular season games to finish atop the South division standings.
- Loyola bested Navy (2-0) and Bucknell (2-1) in the season's final week to clinch another conference playoff appearance, but a short-handed lineup was edged 3-2 by eventual-Patriot League champions American in the semifinal round.

HEAD COACH STEVE NICHOLS

- **Steve Nichols** enters his eighth season as head coach in 2021 having guided the Greyhounds to five-straight Patriot League semifinal appearances.
- Included in that stretch is a conference record of three-consecutive Patriot League regular season championships from 2017-19, with the program recognized in the United Soccer Coaches national poll in each of those seasons.
- The Greyhounds are 50-31-10 (34-9-4 PL) over the past five-plus seasons under Nichols, and they have won 15 major Patriot League awards during that span. Nichols was named PL Coach of the Year for three-straight seasons from 2016-18.
- Nichols contributed to three-straight MAAC titles as a player at Loyola from 1989-91.
- Prior to returning to campus, he spent 17 years as head coach at local high school powerhouse McDonogh. The Eagles won eight MIAA Championships and were twice ranked as the No. 1 high school team in the nation, including during a 2013 season which culminated in a national championship.
