SETTING THE SCENE

One game is in the books for the Patriot League schedule, as the Lehigh women's basketball team started off the new calendar year with a 70-40 victory over Navy at Stabler Arena on Thursday night.

The Mountain Hawks used runs of 29-7 to end the first half and 31-8 to end the second half to come away with their first league win of the season so far. The win extended Lehigh's home win streak to eight straight dating back to last season and also marks the team's sixth straight victory against a league opponent during the regular season.

It was Lehigh's bench that was the key to the success on Thursday, as the Mountain Hawks' second unit out-scored Navy's, 44-12. Mary Clougherty led the team with 15 points, adding three rebounds, going 3-for-5 from beyond the arc. Emma Grothaus also had 14 points, followed by Cameryn Benz will 11. The Mountain Hawks cashed in on 10 second chance points and shot 47.2 percent (25-for-53) from the field and 33.3 percent (7-for-21) from distance.

While not a factor in the scoring game for Lehigh, senior Camryn Buhr led her teammates in rebounds with seven, while Clair Steele had seven points off the bench. Senior Gena Grundhoffer played her first action since December 3, adding four points, going 2-for-2 from the foul line against the Midshipmen.

The win bumps Lehigh's overall record to 9-3 to open the season, the team's best start since it started 11-3 to open last year. The Mountain Hawks are currently tied for first in the Patriot League standings, while having the best overall record and winning percentage (.750) out of all 10 teams.

Against Loyola, Lehigh will look to go 2-0 to open the Patriot League season for the third consecutive season after starting the campaign off 3-0 in 2018-19 and 2-1 in 2017-18.

LEHIGH HEAD COACH SUE TROYAN

Sue Troyan (Dickinson '88) enters her 25th season at the helm of the Mountain Hawks, carrying a career record of 391-336. Since arriving in Bethlehem, she has turned the Lehigh program into a perennial Patriot League contender. A two-time Patriot League Coach of the Year, Troyan guided Lehigh to 21 wins in 2018-19, the team's most since the 2010-11 season. Under her leadership, the Mountain Hawks also won 12 Patriot League contests during the season, the most since they went 13-1 during the 2009-10 season and winning a second consecutive Patriot League title. Troyan has guided Lehigh to three league titles and three NCAA Tournament appearances during her tenure. Prior to becoming the head basketball coach, Troyan served as an assistant basketball coach and head softball coach at Lehigh, leading the softball team to a 126-90 record in five seasons.

ALL-TIME VS. LOYOLA

The Lehigh-Loyola matchup dates all the way back to the 1981-82 season, but the Patriot League moniker began during the 2013-14 campaign.

All-time, Lehigh is 12-7 against the Greyhounds and 8-4 during the Patriot League era.

The Mountain Hawks have claimed the last three matchups against Loyola, with the Greyhounds last coming out victorious, 67-64 on Jan. 24, 2018.

SCOUTING THE GREYHOUNDS

Loyola opened its Patriot League schedule on Thursday afternoon against Holy Cross in a losing effort. The Greyhounds fell to the Crusaders, 64-56 at Reitz Arena.

Loyola trailed Holy Cross, 59-39 with under six minutes remaining in regulation before trimming the deficit down to single digits, but got as close as seven points before the Crusaders held on for the win.

Stephanie Karcz led the way with 14 points, seven steals and six rebounds, increasing her lead as the Division I leader in steals per game (6.7). She has tallied at least six steals in 10 straight games. Bri Rozzi added a season-high 12 pints and four assists.

However, the comeback for the Greyhounds was led by an offensive charge from Emily McAteer in the fourth quarter where she scored 15 of her season-high 18 points. She ended the game shooting 7-for-12 from the field and 4-for-8 from downtown. McAteer also contributed seven rebounds in 18 minutes off the bench.

Loyola is 3-9 to start the season with losses in non-league play to then-No. 16 Notre Dame and then-No. 9 Maryland. The start is better than last year's start, when the Greyhounds started the 2018-19 campaign 1-12.

LOYOLA'S HEAD COACH JOE LOGAN

The winningest coach in the history of Loyola University Maryland's women's basketball program, Joe Logan enters his 15th season as head coach in 2019-20.

Logan, a 1996 Loyola graduate, has accumulated 176 victories during his tenure while guiding the Greyhounds to three conference championship games. Since joining the Patriot League prior to the 2013-14 season, Loyola players have received 18 postseason conference honors, including a pair of major award winners in 2017-18.

The Greyhounds have also consistently been among the nation's best in the classroom under Logan. Loyola was named to the WBCA Division I Academic Top 25 Honor Roll for a fourth-consecutive season in the summer of 2019. The Greyhounds are one of just three schools nationally to rank in the top 15 academically in each of the past four years, reaching as high as No. 5 following the 2017-18 season.

Last season, Loyola won three games in a row late in the year to advance to the Patriot League quarterfinals for a fourth year in a row. Two players received postseason accolades, as Stephanie Karcz earned third team All-Patriot League and All-Defensive Team status, while Taleah Dixon was named to the league's All-Rookie Team.

Karcz represented half of Loyola's two major award winners the year prior, as she was selected as the Patriot League's Defensive Player of the Year while Isabella Therien was recognized as the Patriot League Rookie of the Year. The Greyhounds won seven Patriot League games, their second-most since joining the League, and beat Bucknell, the 2016-17 Patriot League Champions, 68-65, to snap the Bison's 25-game win streak against Patriot League opponents at Sojka Pavilion.

Logan's 2015-16 squad posted the program's most successful season as a member of the Patriot League. The Greyhounds were picked to finish seventh in the preseason Patriot League coaches' poll, but Loyola went on to take third place in the conference and earn the No. 3 seed in the Patriot League Championships. There, Loyola beat Navy in the quarterfinals – handing the Midshipmen their first-ever Patriot League quarterfinals loss – and Bucknell in the semifinals, becoming only the League team during the season to beat the Bison.

At the conclusion of the season, Colleen Marshall became the first player in Patriot League history to earn recognition on the All-Patriot League First Team, the All-Defensive Team and All-Tournament teams.

Logan led the Greyhounds to arguably the most successful year in program history in 2010-11, tying the record for most wins in a single season with 21, and setting the mark for most conference wins in a single season with 15. Loyola finished 21-13 overall and 15-3 in the MAAC to place in the regular season. It was the second season Logan had led the team to at least 13 conference wins.

CLOUGHER-THREE

Junior guard Mary Clougherty has become the Mountain Hawks' 3-point scoring threat after the departure of Hailey Pascoe last season, and it's really not that close. Clougherty has four games of at least three 3-pointers made this season after going 3-for-5 from beyond the arc vs. Navy on Thursday night.

ON THE DOORSTEP OF HISTORY

Senior guard Hannah Hedstrom is already a member of the 300-assist club, getting that milestone at the end of last season, but now she just needs nine boards to get to 500 for her career. She would join Jessica Mudry (497a-505r) as the only two players with at least 300 career assists and 500 career rebounds.

RPI RULES

Heading into this week, Lehigh was ranked at No. 82 in the latest RPI rankings out of 351 Division I teams. That ranking is the second-highest mark in the Patriot League after Bucknell, who came in at No. 81. The Mountain Hawks are a step higher than Villanova (No. 82) and USC (No. 83).

BENCH PLAY

Lehigh's bench shined once again against Navy on Thursday night, out-scoring the Midshipmen, 44-12 on the night. The Mountain Hawks are 6-1 this season when their bench out-scores their opponent's.

DEFENDING HOME COURT

On Thursday against Navy, Lehigh picked up its fifth home victory of the season to start the campaign at 5-0. The Mountain Hawks have won eight straight games at Stabler Arena dating back to last season.

HONORABLE MENTION

Senior Camryn Buhr received her third Honorable Mention of the season on Monday afternoon when Patriot League weekly awards were announced. She led Lehigh to an 80-71 victory over Saint Peter's with 20 points, six rebounds, four assists, a block and a steal in just 29 minutes.

ANOTHER FAB FOUR

For the second time this season, four players scored in double-figures as Camryn Buhr notched 20 points, Mariah Sexe had 14, Emma Grothaus scored 12 and Cameryn Benz 12 in a victory over Saint Peter's last Sunday.

MOVING ON UP

Senior guard Camryn Buhr tallied her fourth 20-point game of the season against Saint Peter's last Sunday which upped her career point total to 1,125, pushing her to 15th all-time in program history past Emily Gratch (2008-12).

ALL ABOUT THAT DEFENSE

At just 57.3 points per game this season, Lehigh has the best scoring defense in the Patriot League this season through the first 12 games of the year. The Mountain Hawks scoring differential is currently at +9.9.

NON-LEAGUE SUCCESS

With the victory over Saint Peter's last Sunday, Lehigh closed out the non-league schedule with an 8-3 overall record, matching the mark from the 2018-19 campaign.

DOUBLE-DIGITS

Senior Camryn Buhr is the team-leader in double-digit scoring games this season, and by a wide margin. Buhr has nine such games in 2019-20 so far, three more than Cameryn Benz has at six.

GRABBING BOARDS

It pays to get more rebounds than the opponent, as Lehigh is 8-0 this season when out-rebounding the other team. On the contrary, the Mountain Hawks are 1-3 in games where their opponent gets more boards than them.

LEHIGH 70, NAVY 40

BETHLEHEM, Pa. — Thursday night was a game of runs for the Lehigh women's basketball team, who used a run of 29-7 to conclude the first half of play and ended the game on a 31-8 run to come away with a statement victory, a 70-40 win over Navy to open Patriot League play at Stabler Arena.

The first quarter was close for the Mountain Hawks (9-3, 1-0 Patriot), who came away with just a three-point lead at the end of the first 10 minutes, a 16-13 advantage over the short-handed Midshipmen (5-7, 0-1 Patriot). However, it was Lehigh that took off in the second frame, leading 25-13 with 5:05 left after Megan Walker's 3-pointer. Navy scored to make it a six-point, 26-20 game with 2:31 to go, but the Mountain Hawks ended the quarter by scoring 13 unanswered points, capped off by back-to-back-to-back 3-pointers from Mary Clougherty, Emma Grothaus and Clair Steele.

That barrage from beyond-the-arc gave Lehigh a 19-point cushion heading into the locker room.

The Midshipmen took a little run of their own to kick off the second half with a 9-0 push heading into the media timeout with 6:54 remaining. That cut the Lehigh lead to 39-29. Two buckets from Grothaus and then another make for Clougherty pushed the lead back up to 13 points with 2:10 to play. Clougherty nailed her second 3-pointer of the game to make it a 16-point Lehigh lead and Grothaus ended the quarter with a layup with 54 seconds left to give Lehigh the 50-32 lead, capping another 9-2 run to close out the third.

Lehigh opened up the fourth quarter the way they closed the other three by scoring seven straight points, ending with Clougherty's third 3-pointer of the night, causing Navy to take a 30 second timeout with 7:35 left in regulation.

A 10-2 run for the Mountain Hawks in the next four minutes or so had Lehigh up 31 points, 67-36 with 3:39 remaining. Frannie Hottinger scored Lehigh's last basket on the fast break with 2:25 left to take a 70-36 lead. Navy scored the last four points, but the Mountain Hawks held on for the 70-40 win to start off 2020 on a high note.

The Lehigh bench thrived once again as Clougherty finished with a team-high 15 points, Grothaus added 14 and Steele scored seven points. The bench out-scored Navy's, 44-12 on the evening, while the Mountain Hawks out-rebounded the Mids, 42-33.

Camryn Benz was Lehigh's third-leading scorer with 11, adding four rebounds and two steals. Camryn Buhr only scored five points, but led the team in rebounds with seven. Thursday also saw the return of Gena Grundhoffer to the lineup, notching four points and a steal, going 2-for-2 from the charity stripe.

The Mountain Hawks shot the ball well from the floor overall, shooting 47.2 percent (25-for-53), while holding Navy to just 28.1 percent (16-for-57) from the floor. Lehigh also shot a 33.3 percent (7-for-21) clip from beyond, holding the Mids to 25 percent (5-for-20).

Lehigh scored 17 points on 15 Navy turnovers while also turning in 10 second chance points and 26 points from the paint.

The win marks Lehigh's third straight season with a victory in the Patriot League opener and the Mountain Hawks' eighth straight home win at Stabler Arena dating back to last season. Lehigh is 5-0 at home so far this season.

Sue Troyan

Head Coach • 25th Season
Dickinson '88

Lehigh head women's basketball coach Sue Troyan is certainly no stranger to winning. Entering her 25th season in 2019-20 and has a career record of 391-336, and a 191-158 mark in Patriot League play, she has helped lead the Mountain Hawks to three Patriot League Championships and three NCAA Tournament appearances.

The Mountain Hawks have made it to the Patriot League semifinals in nine of the last 13 seasons, while making four appearances in the finals and capturing two league titles during that stretch.

During the 2018-19 season, the Mountain Hawks made their way back to the Patriot League semifinals under Troyan's direction, and at 21-10 overall and 12-6 in Patriot League play, finished with the team's first 20-win season since 2010-11 and finished in third place, the team's highest standing since the 2011-12 campaign.

The 2017-18 team returned to the Patriot League quarterfinals, behind a pair of All-Patriot League selections in third team honoree Camryn Buhr and second team selection Quinci Mann, who graduated as the program's sixth all-time leading scorer, and third on the school's all-time three-point list.

The 2015-16 team finished 18-13 overall and 10-8 in Patriot League play. Four Mountain Hawks earned All-League honors, including standout Lexi Martins who was named the Patriot League Scholar-Athlete of the Year and finished as the nation's leader in double-doubles and ranked third in the country in rebounding.

Under Troyan's guidance in 2014-15, the Mountain Hawks made their first Patriot League Championship appearance since 2010. Lehigh finished the season with a 19-11 overall record and a 9-9 league mark. The Mountain Hawks earned the six seed in the Patriot League Tournament and picked up road wins at No. 3 Holy Cross and No. 2 Army to advance to the championship. Four Mountain Hawks garnered All-Patriot League honors, while Lehigh was also represented on the Academic All-League team and landed a league-best number of players on the Patriot League Academic Honor Roll.

In 2010-11, Troyan led the Mountain Hawks to their third-straight Patriot League regular season title and Lehigh's third-straight 20-win season, the most consecutive 20-win seasons in program history. The Mountain Hawks went 21-11 which included a WNIT berth for their third straight postseason appearance.

In the previous two seasons, Troyan led Lehigh to a combined 55-11 (25-3 PL) record which included a pair of Patriot League Championships and NCAA Tournament berths.

The 2009-10 campaign brought Troyan's third Patriot League title, the team's second in a row, and second-ever Patriot League regular season title with a league record of 13-1, earning the Mountain Hawks the top seed in the tournament. Lehigh advanced to their third NCAA Tournament in school history, finishing the season with a 29-4 record. For the second season, Lehigh went undefeated at home, breaking the record set the previous year for most wins in a season (29) and league wins (13).

In 2009, Troyan won her second Patriot League title, capping off a historic season in which the Mountain Hawks broke school records in wins (26), league wins (12) and home wins (17). Lehigh won its first-ever Patriot League regular season title by rolling through the league with a 12-2 record to earn the top seed in the tournament. The Mountain Hawks completed their undefeated season at home by winning three tournament games at Stabler Arena to advance to their second NCAA Tournament in school history. Lehigh finished the season with a 26-7 record, the best in Troyan's tenure with the program, and the Lehigh head coach took home her second Patriot League Coach of the Year award.

In the 2004-05 season, Troyan led the team to 18 regular season wins – the second most in her tenure—and became the first Lehigh head coach to be named the Patriot League Coach of the Year. The Mountain Hawks have won ten plus games in all fourteen of Troyan's seasons at the helm. She has guided her troops to three Patriot League final appearances, as well as two berths in the NCAA Tournament (1997 and 2009). In 2001-02, Troyan passed Muffet McGraw as the all-time victories leader in Lehigh women's basketball history and has surpassed 200 career wins.

Throughout her coaching career, Troyan has been used to her teams faring well. Her first five years as a coach were with Lehigh's softball team. As the head softball coach, Troyan rebuilt a program that finished 7-30 prior to her appointment. In her five years as head coach, she recorded a 107-87-1 mark, won three consecutive Patriot League titles and a Coach of the Year award. In 1996-97, the women's basketball team laid claim to its first-ever Patriot League title under Troyan's tutelage.

In Troyan, Lehigh has a coach who understands the importance of relating to her players, the experience of having played collegiate basketball and the knowledge of what it

takes to be successful.

In the season prior to Troyan's appointment as basketball coach, Lehigh finished 3-24, and in the four previous years Lehigh had a combined 12-97 record. In Troyan's first season (1995-96), Lehigh finished 14-13, 5-7 in the Patriot League. In 1996-97, Lehigh set a then-school-record with seven Patriot League wins (7-5) and recorded its first-ever Patriot League Tournament victory and championship. By 2002-03, the team set a record with nine wins against league opposition and showcased the Patriot League Rookie of the Year. The 2004-05 squad surpassed that record of nine wins en route to setting a new record of 10 games, as Lehigh returned to the league tournament semifinals. In 2006-07, Lehigh's top rebounder Jenny Callen ranked in the nation's top ten by bringing down 10.9 rebounds a game. Under Troyan's guidance, the 2007-08 Mountain Hawks held opponents to just 52.9 points per game, the fifth lowest total in the NCAA. In 2008-09, the Patriot League champions led the league in scoring (67.3 points per game), field goal percentage (.428), 3-point field goal percentage (.346) and assists per game (14.4). Lehigh also set a school record for 3-pointers made in the season, sinking 196 as a team. In 2015-16, Lexi Martins finished as the nation's leader in double-doubles (24) and ranked third in all of Division I with a 13.6 rebounds per game average.

Troyan has mentored the Patriot League Player of the Year three times in her career with the Mountain Hawks. Jessica DePalo became the first Lehigh player to ever win the award in 2005, and Erica Prosser took home the honor after her sophomore season in 2009 and again after her senior season last year. Prosser also was named the Patriot League Defensive Player of the Year, becoming the first player in League history to earn both awards in the same season. Troyan has also coached three PL Scholar Athlete of the Year award recipients including Anne Tierney (2001 and 2002) and Lexi Martins (2016).

Prior to her latest coaching endeavor, Troyan served five years as an assistant basketball coach and two years as the Director of Athletic Program Budgets. In her first two years at Lehigh she served as a graduate assistant, before becoming Lehigh's first full-time women's basketball assistant coach.

A 1988 graduate of Dickinson College, Troyan received her B.A. in Economics. She received her M.B.A. from Lehigh in 1991.

At Dickinson, Troyan was a four-year athlete in both basketball and track. On the court, Troyan was voted the team's most valuable player following the 1988 season. She was named to the Middle Atlantic Conference First Team and Second Team All-ECAC in her senior season. Troyan was a three-time All-American in track.

Sue and her husband Fran – Lehigh's head softball coach – reside in Saucon Valley, Pa. with their daughter Katie, and sons David and Matthew.

Glenn Rigney - Associate Head Coach



The 2019-20 season marks Glenn Rigney's 16th season as the Mountain Hawks' defensive coach and his 13th season as the associate head coach.

Rigney helped lead the Mountain Hawks to their first Patriot League Championship game since 2010 during the 2014-15 season and helped mentor Lehigh's four All-Patriot League honorees.

The Mountain Hawks led the Patriot League in steals per game, averaging 8.3 per contest, during the 2013-14 season. Under Rigney's guidance in 2012-13, the Mountain Hawks ranked near the top of almost all defensive statistical measures across the Patriot League board. Lehigh ranked second in the league in field goal percentage defense, holding opponents to 35.4%. In 2010-11 under Rigney, Lehigh ranked first in the league in steals at nine per game.

Addie Micir - Associate Head Coach



The 2019-20 season is Micir's first on Lehigh's coaching staff and as associate head coach.

Last season, Micir served as an assistant on her alma mater Princeton where she helped lead the Tigers to a 22-10 overall, 12-2 Ivy League record en route to its second straight league title. She helped develop Bella Alarie, the 2018-19 Ivy League Player of the Year and First Team All-Ivy selection. Prior to her coaching stint at Princeton, Micir was assistant basketball coach at Dartmouth for five seasons. She recruited nationally and internationally, helping bring in players from 14 different states and three foreign countries.

She was a 1,000-point scorer at Princeton, a three-time All-League selection and the program's first Unanimous Ivy League Player of the Year during the 2010-11 season. Micir led the Tigers to back-to-back Ivy League crowns in 2010 and 2011, including Princeton's first outright title in 2010 since 1978.

Bernadette Devaney - Assistant Coach



Bernadette "Bernie" Devaney enters her first season as assistant coach at Lehigh after serving last season as the Director of Basketball Operations.

On the Mountain Hawks, she appeared in 111 games over four seasons from 2014-18, averaging 4.5 points, 0.8 rebounds and 1.0 assist per game. As a senior in 2017-18, she averaged career-highs of 6.5 points, 1.3 assists, and 1.1 rebounds in 18.5 minutes per game. She ranked second on the team by shooting 37.8 percent from three-point range and 82.4 percent from the free throw line. She scored a career-high 20 points on two occasions, going 6-of-9 overall and 6-of-8 from three-point range vs. Mount St. Mary's (11/29/17), and scored 20 again vs. Loyola (2/21/18) with a 7-of-10 shooting performance.

Devaney graduated from Lehigh with a bachelor's degree in management in May 2018.

Cecily Carl - Director of Basketball Operations



Cecily Carl enters her first season at the Director of Women's Basketball Operations in 2019-2020. Carl joins the Mountain Hawks' staff after a standout, four-year career at American from 2015-19.

She averaged a career-best 15.8 points per game, 5.8 rebounds and 1.4 assists in 33 games in 2018-19 en route to being named Player of the Year in the Patriot League. In four years, Carl is a three-time All-League selection, garnering Third Team honors in 2017, Second Team in 2018 and First Team in 2019. Carl also was named the league's Scholar Athlete of the Year. In 2018, Carl helped the Eagles win their second Patriot League Championship and was named the Most Valuable Player of the tournament.

She graduated with her Bachelor's degree in accounting in 2018 and received her Master's degree in sports analytics and management from AU in 2019.
