#### THE MATCHUP

- After three road contests to begin the 2019-20 season, Loyola hosts Howard in its home opener at Reitz Arena on Wednesday evening.
- The Greyhounds will be away from Baltimore for their following five games, not returning to Reitz until a 1 p.m. matchup against Monmouth on Dec. 20.

#### **LAST SEASON**

- The Greyhounds went 7-24 (5-13) a year ago, ranking eighth out of 10 teams in the Patriot League standings. Loyola topped Navy by a 58-45 final in the Patriot League opening round before falling at Bucknell in the quarterfinals.
- Sr. F Stephanie Karcz earned third team All-Patriot League and All-Defensive Team status in 2018-19, while So. G Taleah Dixon became the fifth Greyhound in the last six years named to the conference's All-Rookie Team.
- Loyola returns six players who earned double-digit starts last season in Karcz, Dixon, Jr. F Isabella Therien, Jr. F Delaney Connolly, Sr. G Alexis Gray and Sr. G Hannah Niles.
- Therien, the 2018 Patriot League Rookie of the Year, averaged a team-high 14.3 ppg before missing the last nine contests due to injury.

#### **KARCZ BY THE NUMBERS**

- **Stephanie Karcz** has received seven Patriot League postseason awards in her first three collegiate seasons. The 2017-18 Patriot League Defensive Player of the Year, she is a three-time All-Defensive Team selection, a two-time All-Patriot League performer (first team in 2017-18), and she was also an All-Rookie Team honoree as a freshman.
- Karcz currently has 945 points and 825 rebounds, giving her a chance to become the fourth player in team history to reach 1,000 in both categories.
- Karcz has ranked fourth in DI in steals per game in each of the last two seasons (4.24 spg in 2018-19). Her 324 career steals are 2nd all-time at Loyola, 23 back of the team record.
- Karcz set a new single-game team and Patriot League record with 22 rebounds in last year's playoff game against Navy. She also holds Loyola's single-season rebounding record, grabbing 317 boards as a sophomore in 2017-18.
- Karcz has 296 career assists (9th all-time at Loyola), 19 career double-doubles and two triple doubles.

#### **LOOKING AHEAD**

 Loyola heads to St. Francis Brooklyn for a non-conference tilt beginning at 1 p.m. on Sunday.

#### **LAST TIME OUT**

- So. G Laryn Edwards scored a career-high 17 points, while Sr. G **Stephanie Karcz** chipped in 13 points, nine rebounds and six steals for Lovola in a 75-46 victory at Fairleigh Dickinson last Wednesday.
- Fr. F **Emily McAteer** added 11 points off the bench for the Greyhounds, who outscored the Knights by a 42-16 margin in the second half to break open what had been a three-point game at the break.
- Loyola's 29-point win was its largest since a 74-30 victory over Lipscomb to begin the 2016-17 season.
- Edwards scored nine of her 17 points during a decisive 23-9 third guarter for the visitors. She shot 6 for 9 from the field (4-5 3FG).

#### **SCOUTING HOWARD**

- The Bison (2-2) are coming off a 92-80 win over Saint Peter's on Sunday. They have also topped UMBC (72-61) this season, with their two defeats coming to La Salle (78-62) and #25 South Florida (82-53).
- Five different players scored in double figures on Sunday, with Sarah Edmond and Brooklyn Fort-Davis contributing 16 points apiece. Howard shot 8 for 13 as a team from 3-point range.
- Howard, which went 18-13 (10-6 MEAC) in 2018-19, was ranked 3rd out of 11 teams in this year's MEAC preseason poll.

#### **COACHING STAFF ADDITION**

- The Greyhounds added a former collegiate and WNBA standout to their coaching staff this summer, with **Chasity Melvin** joining Loyola for her first year as an assistant coach.
- Melvin, a 1998 NC State graduate, was the first in team history to reach 2,000 points and 1,000 rebounds, leading the Wolfpack to the Final Four as a senior.
- She was a first-round WNBA draft pick, ultimately playing 12 seasons in the league.
- Melvin became the first female coach in the history of the Charlotte Hornets franchise when she joined their G-League affiliate, the Greensboro Swarm, for the 2018-19 season.

#### **GRAY APPROACHING 3-POINT MILESTONE**

- Sr. G **Alexis Gray** is now fourth in team history with 124 career 3-pointers made after making a trio of 3's in Loyola's season opening games at Notre Dame and Northwestern. She is 33 back of program-record holder Nicole Krusen (2011-14).
- Gray set a single-season team record with 64 made 3-pointers as a sophomore in 2017-18.
- She ranked second in the Patriot League in 3's per game that season (2.2), and she was third in the conference in 3-point field goal percentage (35.2, 64-182).
- Gray has totaled 10+ points on 29 occasions through her first three collegiate seasons.

#### **SERIES HISTORY**

- Loyola leads 4-3 in a series which dates back to 2002.
- The home team has won every game in the last six meetings, with the first matchup contested at a neutral site..
- Loyola topped Howard by a 72-62 final in the most-recent contest on Nov. 20, 2013 at Reitz Arena. The last victory for the Bison was a 40-37 home triumph on Nov. 28, 2012.

#### **KEY TAKEAWAYS FROM FDU**

- Loyola's 75-46 victory at FDU was aided by a +14 turnover margin (23-9) and a 34-6 advantage in points off turnovers.
- The Greyhounds, who recorded 12 steals in their season opener at then-No. 16 Notre Dame, added 12 more thefts last Wednesday, led by six from Sr. F Stephanie Karcz and a career-high three by Sr. G Hannah Niles.
- Loyola also had a dominant 42-14 edge on points in the paint and a 21-12 advantage in free throws earned.

#### FRESHMEN ACTIVE EARLY ON

- Fr. F **Emily McAteer** became the first Loyola freshman to crack double figures this season with her 11-point effort at FDU. She hit 5 of 10 shots from the field in 16 minutes of game action.
- All five Greyhound newcomers have seen playing time throughout the first three games.
- Fr. G Bri Rozzi totaled four points and a season-high seven rebounds in 24 minutes on Wednesday, and Fr. G Mackenzie Wagner contributed nine points (2-5 3FG) and two steals in her Loyola debut at Notre Dame.

#### HOT SHOOTING START FOR HUNTER

- Gr. F **Ashley Hunter**, who missed all but four games in 2018-19 after suffering an early-season injury, has hit nine of her first 12 shots from the field this fall.
- Hunter netted a career-high 16 points (7-10 FG, 2-2 FT) in 12 minutes off the bench at Notre Dame, and she added four more points (2-2 FG) prior to fouling out at Northwestern.

#### LOGAN RETURNS FOR 15TH SEASON AS HEAD COACH

- Head coach **Joe Logan**, a 1996 Loyola graduate, has led the Greyhounds women's basketball program since the 2005-06 season.
- The winningest coach in program history, he has amassed 177 victories while guiding the Greyhounds to three conference championship games.
- Loyola has advanced to the Patriot League quarterfinals in each of the last four seasons, including a championship game appearance in 2015-16.
- Logan has coached 12 all-conference performers during his tenure, 11 All-Rookie Team honorees and five major conference award winners.
- The Greyhounds have also consistently been among the nation's best in the classroom under Logan. Loyola was named to the WBCA Division I Academic Top 25 Honor Roll for a fourth-consecutive season this summer.
- The Greyhounds are one of just three schools nationally to rank in the top 15 academically in each of the past four years, reaching as high as No. 5 following the 2017-18 season.

#### **OFF-COURT NOTABLES**

- Sr. F Stephanie Karcz is balancing her commitment to basketball
  this semester with a full-time internship student teaching at a local Baltimore area elementary/middle school. She is an elementary education major with a minor in special education.
- Jr. F Delaney Connolly, a chemistry major with a 3.98 GPA, has
  completed a pair of internships at Johns Hopkins with the goal of
  becoming an orthopedic surgeon. Connolly totaled 9.2 ppg and
  4.7 rpg last season in 30 gp (23 starts).
- In addition to the Therien sisters, there is also a brother/sister duo playing basketball at Loyola this season. Daraun Gray, the younger brother of Sr. G Alexis Gray, joined the men's basketball program as a freshman this fall.
- Sr. G Molly Taylor played for England's national team at the FIBA U20 Women's European Championships in 2017.

#### **INCOMING FRESHMEN CLASS**

- Five freshmen (Emma Glezen, Emily McAteer, Bri Rozzi, Ava Therien and Mackenzie Wagner) will join the Loyola roster for 2019-20
- The group is composed of three guards and two forwards, and they represent three different states (New Jersey - Therien, New York - Glezen and Rozzi and Pennsylvania - McAteer and Wagner).
- Therien is the younger sister of current junior Isabella Therien.
   They are the daughters of former NHL standout Chris Therien, who played in the league for 12 seasons from 1994-2006.

#### I. THERIEN AMONG PATRIOT LEAGUE OFFENSIVE LEADERS

- When healthy, Jr. F Isabella Therien has been one of the top
  offensive threats in the conference over the last two years, averaging 14.9 points and 5.0 rebounds per game across her first 42
  collegiate appearances.
- Therien ranked fourth in the Patriot League at 15.2 ppg during her Rookie of the Year campaign in 2017-18. A six-time Patriot League Rookie of the Week, her 396 points were the most for any Loyola freshman under Joe Logan.
- Therien scored 10+ points in 10 of 16 appearances last year before her season-ending injury.
