THE MATCHUP

- After two unscheduled weeks off, Loyola returns to the court this weekend for a pair
 of matchups against American. The Greyhounds host the Eagles at 1 p.m. on Saturday
 before traveling to Bender Arena for a 4 p.m. contest the following afternoon.
- Loyola's last four games have been postponed due to positive COVID-19 tests within Navy and Lafayette's Tier 1 groups.

LAST TIME OUT

- With less than 24 hours to prepare for a series against the defending Patriot League regular season champions, Loyola opened its season with a pair of defeats to Bucknell on the weekend of Jan. 2-3. The Bison took the opener by a 72-44 margin and followed with a 59-44 triumph at Reitz Arena on Sunday.
- The games were scheduled on Friday evening after Loyola's contests with American and Bucknell's matchups with Navy were postponed due to COVID-19 protocols.
- Devyne Newman (16) and Taleah Dixon (14) accounted for 30 of Loyola's 44 points on Jan. 2, while Emily McAteer led the Greyhounds with 14 points, eight rebounds and a pair of blocks the following afternoon.
- **Delaney Connolly** added a team-high 10 rebounds for Loyola on Jan. 3.
- Loyola shot 85.7 percent from the free throw line last weekend, hitting 24 of 28 attempts. The team was 19 for 22 on Jan. 3, highlighted by a perfect 8 for 8 FT line from Dixon.
- The Greyhounds shot just 12.5 percent (4 for 32) from 3-point range in the two setbacks.

WELCOME TO LOYOLA

- **Devyne Newman**, a junior guard who spent her first two seasons at St. Joseph's, made the most of her Loyola debut in the season opener at Bucknell. She totaled a team-high 16 points while hitting 8 of 14 field goal attempts.
- Newman's previous career scoring high was a 12-point output during a St. Joseph's matchup against Penn on Nov. 20, 2019.

LOOKING AHEAD

 Loyola continues South division play next weekend, hosting Navy at 1 p.m. on Saturday and traveling to Annapolis for a 3 p.m. matchup on Sunday.

SERIES HISTORY

- American leads 22-7 in a series which dates back to 1977.
- Loyola earned a 56-47 home victory in the last meeting between the sides on Feb. 12 last season. **Stephanie Karcz** led the Greyhounds with 11 points, 15 rebounds and five assists. American committed 20 turnovers and shot just 32.0% from the field.
- Prior to that setback, the Eagles had won seven-straight in the series, with the last six of those victories decided by double digits.
- The Greyhounds suffered a 63-44 road defeat in last year's first matchup on Jan. 22. American led just 40-39 after three quarters, but outscored the visitors 23-5 over the last 10 minutes.
- Loyola's last win at Bender Arena was a 55-50 triumph on Feb. 27, 2016.

SCOUTING AMERICAN

- Jade Edwards, a Seconnd Team All-Patriot League honoree last season, was named PL Player of the Week on Jan. 12 after setting career-highs in points (31), rebounds (13) and steals (5) during a defeat at Lehigh. She is seventh nationally in steals per game (3.8) and she is 18th in DI in scoring (22.0 ppg).
- The Eagles, who finished last season with a record of 13-17 (8-10 PL), were ranked fifth in this year's Patriot League preseason poll.
- American's seventh-place finish in last year's Patriot League standings was its lowest since 2016. The Eagles topped the standings and claimed their second Patriot League title back in 2018.

PL FORMAT CHANGES FOR 2020-21

- In response to the continuing COVID-19
 pandemic, the Patriot League has instituted
 several changes to the basketball schedule
 for this season, including the separation of
 schools into three divisions to limit team
 travel. Loyola is grouped with American and
 Navy in the newly-created South division.
- Loyola's first four matchups against both American and Navy will count in the divisional standings, which will be used to determine seeding in this year's conference tournament. The Greyhounds have two extra games against American on the weekend of February 20, but those games will not count towards the division standings.
- Eight teams will qualify for the conference tournament, rather than the usual 10. Winners of each division will be seeded 1-3, while second-place teams will be seeded 4-6. The final two spots will be awarded based on overall win percentage against PL opponents.

LOOKING BACK

Loyola went 8-22 (5-13 PL) during the 2019-20 season, ranking eighth in the Patriot League standings and falling 72-65 to Army in the first round of the conference tournament. The Greyhounds had advanced to the quarterfinals in each of the previous four seasons, including a championship game appearance in 2016.

REJECTED

 So. F Emily McAteer recorded three blocks in Loyola's opener at Bucknell on Jan. 2, tied for the most by a Greyhound player in a game since Feb. 21, 2018.
 She added two more rejections the following evening, and is currently ranked tied for first in the conference with 2.5 blocks per game on the year.

MORE NOTES FROM THE BUCKNELL SERIES

- Taleah Dixon, playing in her first games since March 2019, averaged a teamhigh 33.5 minutes in the two contests. She logged 38 minutes in Sunday's home opener.
- Loyola's team FT percentage of 85.7 percent leads all of Division I.
- **Bri Rozzi**, who earned starts in both games, recorded a career-high three steals in Saturday's season opener.
- **Caramina Tañedo** led the four Loyola freshmen in minutes played (38), points (7) and assists (3).
- Loyola's starting five of Dixon, Rozzi, Delaney Connolly, Emily McAteer and Devyne Newman accounted for 74 of the Greyhounds' 88 points scored in the two contests
- McAteer's 14 points on Sunday were four shy of her career-high of 18, which
 was established in Loyola's Patriot League opener against Holy Cross last
 season

RETURNING STARTERS FROM 2019-20

- Loyola returns a pair of starters from last year's squad, with Sr. F Delaney Connolly and Jr. G Laryn Edwards both once again expected to play key roles for the Greyhounds.
- Connolly has led the team in 3-pointers made in each of the last two seasons, hitting 41 3's as a sophomore and 32 shots from long distance last winter. She averaged a career-high 9.2 points and 4.7 rebounds per game in 2018-19.
- Edwards, the team's primary point guard last winter, averaged 7.1 points, 3.1 rebounds and 2.4 assists per game while leading the team in 3-point FG% (34.9, 22-63) and ranking second in both assists (66) and steals (34).

FINAL FAREWELL FOR KARCZ, CLASS OF 2020

- 2020 graduate Stephanie Karcz closed out her Loyola career in style, as she became the program's first NCAA statistical champion after leading Division I with 5.17 steals per game.
- The 2020 Patriot League Defensive Player of the Year and a first team all-conference selection, Karcz also led the Greyhounds in points (11.6), rebounds (9.4) and assists (3.6) per game.
- She graduated with 1,258 career points (ninth all-time at Loyola), 1,071 rebounds (second), 390 assists (fourth) and 461 steals (first). Her steals total is ranked ninth all-time in Division I.
- Other departures from the 2020 squad include **Alexis Gray**, **Ashley Hunter**, **Hannah Niles** and **Molly Taylor**.
- Gray's 147 made 3-pointers are the third-most in program history. She appeared in 94 games and scored 872 points in her Loyola career.
- Niles was the lone Greyhound to start all 30 games last season, averaging 5.7 points, 2.2 rebounds and 1.1 assists per game on the year.

SOCIAL JUSTICE INITIATIVES

- In a continuing effort to highlight social justice causes, Loyola women's basketball will be wearing different themes shooting shirts for each weekend of games this season. This weekend's shirts will have "Know Their Story" on the front and the names of Sandra Bland and Trayvon Martin on the back.
- Delaney Connolly and Taleah Dixon are both members of the Patriot League's Social Justice Coalition, while Joe Logan is a coach representative on Loyola's Student-Athletes for Social Justice (SA4SJ), a group formed this summer to develop and create a more inclusive environment, with a focus on Black Lives Matter, LGBTQ+ communities, and other marginalized groups.

WALKER, WYNN RETURN HOME TO ROUND OUT STAFF

- There are two new faces for Loyola on the sidelines this year, with Candice Walker '11 M'13 and Maya Wynn both joining the program as assistant coaches.
- Walker returns to her alma mater after spending six seasons as UMass, where she helped the Minutewomen post their first 20-win season (20-11) since 1996 last winter. She received the WBCA's prestigious Thirty Under 30 award in 2019, an honor that recognizes up-and-coming coaches at all levels of women's basketball.
- As an undergrad at Loyola, Walker appeared in 117 games across six seasons after receiving two medical redshirts. A standout at nearby Towson Catholic in high school, Walker was a MAAC All-Rookie Team honoree in 2008 after dishing out a freshman program-record 93 assists while contributing 8.2 ppg.
- Wynn is also a Maryland native, as she won a pair of IAAM A-Conference championships at McDonogh prior to attending Saint Francis University. A four-year starter at SFU, Wynn led the Red Flash to the NCAA tournament after claiming a Northeast Conference title as a senior in 2018.
- Wynn joins Loyola after spending the past year and a half as an assistant at Albright College, a Division III school in Reading, Pennsylvania. While there, she helped the Lions improve their win total by 10 games during the 2019-20 season, as they finished the year 22-6 and earned an at-large spot in the NCAA DIII tournament

I. THERIEN, DIXON LOOK TO RETURN TO PREVIOUS FORM

- Sr. F Isabella Therien and Jr. G Taleah Dixon, both major contributors to Loyola's 2018-19 squad, return to action this season after combining for just two appearances due to injuries last winter.
- Therien accounted for those two games played, seeing action in a pair of December non-conference games before her injury setback. She was Loyola's leading scorer in each of her first two collegiate seasons, earning Patriot League Rookie of the Year status in 2018 after averaging 15.2 points and 4.7 rebounds per contest. She added 14.3 points and 5.6 boards in the first 16 games of an injury-shortened 2018-19 season.
- Dixon, who missed all of last year due to an offseason injury, was a Patriot League All-Rookie Team selection following a debut season in which she contributed 9.7 points, 2.5 rebounds and 1.5 assists per game. Her 80.2 FT% (69-86) led all Patriot League freshmen.

ST. JOE'S TRANSFER, FOUR FRESHMEN JOIN PROGRAM

- There are five newcomers to the roster this season, with Jr. G
 Devyne Newman, a transfer from St. Joseph's, joined by freshmen Charia Roberts, Kayla Sieper, Bella Steidle and Caramina Tañedo.
- Newman appeared in 40 games across two seasons for the Hawks, earning the team's Best Defensive Player award last winter.
- Steidle's mother, April (Auer) Steidle, was a member of Loyola's women's basketball program from 1990-94.
