THE MATCHUP

- Loyola women's basketball continues a stretch of three-straight road games with a mid-week trip to Georgetown.
- The Greyhounds will be looking for their first win over the Hoyas since 1978.

LAST TIME OUT

- Sorelle Ineza sank a field goal in the corner as time expired, helping Hofstra overcome another fourth-quarter rally by Loyola to send the Greyhounds to a tough 55-53 defeat on Saturday.
- Loyola scored eight-unanswered points, capped by a 3-pointer from **Bri Rozzi** with 1:57 remaining, to pull ahead 53-52 after trailing by seven. The Pride (2-1) went 1 for 2 at the free throw line to tie the score with 37 seconds left, and a defensive stop on the other end set up Ineza's game-winner.
- Lex Therien** (12 points, 13 rebounds) recorded her second double-double in the past three games, while **Taleah Dixon** added 14 points, four rebounds, four assists and three steals. Of Therien's season-high 13 boards, six came on the offensive end as Loyola led 37-30 overall on the glass.

THERIEN NAMED PATRIOT LEAGUE ROOKIE OF THE WEEK



- Lex Therien** received her first-career Patriot League weekly award on Monday after averaging 12.5 points and 11.0 rebounds per game during a 1-1 week for the Greyhounds.
- Therien contributed a season-high 13 points (6-11 FG) and nine rebounds in a 63-57 win over UMBC last Wednesday, as Loyola rallied from a second-half 14+ point deficit for the first time since Feb. 10, 2012. Six of her rebounds came on the offensive end to help the Greyhounds finish with a convincing 38-27 advantage on the glass.
- Therien followed that effort with her second double-double in the last three games on Saturday. She hit all four of her free throws and picked up six more offensive rebounds.
- For the year, Therien leads the Patriot League in total rebounds (47) and she is third in rebounds per game. One of two players in the conference with multiple double-doubles, Therien is also second in the Patriot League in steals (11).

LOOKING AHEAD

- Loyola concludes its road swing with a 7 p.m. matchup at Howard next Wednesday.

SERIES HISTORY

- Georgetown leads 11-3 in a series which dates back to 1974.
- The Hoyas have won each of the last 10 meetings, including a 45-30 victory during the most-recent matchup on Nov. 13, 2018.
- 2021 graduate **Isabella Therien** (17 points, 11 rebounds) was the lone Loyola player in double figures, as the Greyhounds were out-scored 25-9 after holding a 21-20 lead at halftime.
- Loyola's last win in the series was a 56-53 triumph during the second game of the 1978-79 season.

SCOUTING GEORGETOWN

- The Hoyas (2-2) are coming off back-to-back home defeats to Columbia (66-56, 2OT) and Davidson (70-55).
- This is Georgetown's second game versus a Patriot League school, as the Hoyas topped Navy by a 73-62 final in their season opener.
- The Hoyas only faced Big East opponents during the 2020-21 season, finishing the year with an overall record of 2-15. They went 5-25 (2-16 Big East) during their last full season in 2019-20.
- So. G Kelsey Ransom, a Big East All-Freshman Team honoree last winter, leads the conference in both assists (7.0) and steals (3.5) per game on the year.
- Gr. G Milan Bolden-Morris had a team-high 14 points in Sunday's loss to Columbia, and she leads the Hoyas with 13.0 ppg overall.

QUICK HITS FROM HOFSTRA

- Taleah Dixon's** 14 points matched a season-best, while she set new season highs in minutes played (37), assists (4) and steals (3).
- Loyola rallied to take a lead into the fourth quarter after trailing by as many as 14 points (28-14) in the first half.
- Laura Salmerón** played a season-high 39 minutes, contributing 13 points, five rebounds and two assists.
- Salmerón has reached double figures in three-straight contests, averaging 13.3 points, 5.3 rebounds and 2.3 assists per game during that stretch.
- The Greyhounds finished with a 37-30 rebounding advantage. **Lex Therien** led the way with 13 boards, and all five starters had at least four rebounds in the contest.
- Loyola's five starters accounted for 51 of the team's 53 points on the afternoon.
- After trailing 33-24 at the intermission, Loyola shot 46.7 percent from the field while outscoring the home side 19-7 in the third quarter.
- Lex Therien** led the way with six points and seven rebounds during that frame, as Loyola took a 43-40 lead into the final 10 minutes.
- Therien and Dixon have both reached double figures in 4 of 5 games to begin the year.

CONTROLLING THE GLASS

- Loyola has outrebounded its opponent in each of the last three games, with an overall margin of 113-87 during that stretch.
- The Greyhounds lead the Patriot League in rebounding margin (+2.2) through five games after ranking ninth in that category last winter with a margin of -6.3.
- Lex Therien** (9.4 rpg), **Charia Roberts** (6.4) and **Bri Rozzi** (5.2) are Loyola's early leaders on the glass.

BALANCED ATTACK

- Loyola has used the same starting lineup in each of the first five games - **Taleah Dixon**, **Charia Roberts**, **Bri Rozzi**, **Laura Salmerón** and **Lex Therien** - and those five have combined for 16 double-digit scoring performances.
- All five starters are averaging between 8.8 and 12.2 points per game. The highest scoring total for any player was Salmerón's 15-point effort in last Sunday's overtime win over FDU.
- Roberts leads the starters in field goal percentage (46.3, 19-41), while Rozzi is shooting 42.9 percent (9 for 21) from 3-point range.

CLUTCH AT THE LINE

- Loyola has shot over 70 percent from the free throw line in each of its first five games, including a season-best 81.8 percent output (9 for 11) at Hofstra on Saturday.
- Loyola hit 10 of 13 free throws in the fourth, including each of its last six attempts, to close out last Wednesday's victory over UMBC.
- Taleah Dixon** (87.1%, 27-31) ranks fourth nationally in free throws made, and she is sixth in the Patriot League in FT percentage.
- Bri Rozzi** follows at 85.7 percent (12 for 14) on the year.

WORTH NOTING

- Lex Therien** is the program's first Patriot League weekly award winner since Emily McAteer was named Rookie of the Week on Jan. 13, 2020.
- Taleah Dixon**, **Laryn Edwards** and **Bri Rozzi** are Loyola's three team captains for the 2021-22 season.
- Rozzi matched her career scoring high with 13 points in last Wednesday's comeback victory over UMBC, and she became the first Greyhound to play the entire game since Jan. 5, 2020 (**Laryn Edwards** vs. Lehigh).
- Loyola rallied past the Retrievers after trailing 37-23 early in the third quarter. The program's last win after falling behind by 14+ points in the second half was a 66-60 triumph over Iona back in 2012.
- Loyola's 68-59 OT win over FDU on Nov. 14 was the program's first in overtime since Jan. 2, 2017 at Lafayette. The Greyhounds are now 3-9 in OT dating back to March 4, 2011.

DOWN TO THE WIRE

- Loyola has had fourth quarter leads in each of its first five games this season, with the Greyhounds' last two defeats coming after opponents hit game-winners in the final five seconds of regulation.
- Loyola rallied past FDU in overtime after trailing 53-45 midway through the fourth quarter. That victory was the first under new head coach **Danielle O'Banion**, and it snapped an 18-game losing streak for the program dating back to Feb. 26, 2020.
- After trailing 44-34 through three quarters of its home opener vs. George Mason on Nov. 12, Loyola used a 17-3 run to jump ahead 51-47 with 2:18 remaining.
- The Patriots would recover to score the game's final six points, including a game-winning putback with five seconds left to escape with a 53-51 win.
- The Greyhounds also led by as many as 19 points in the second half of their season opener at Niagara. Loyola took a 62-60 advantage into the fourth quarter of that contest before the Purple Eagles pulled away late to hand the visitors an 81-71 setback.

FIVE NEWCOMERS JOIN PROGRAM IN 2021-22

- Loyola's 16-member roster includes five freshmen who will be making their collegiate debuts this winter.
- Lex Therien** becomes the third Therien sister to compete for the Greyhounds, joining current junior **Ava Therien** and 2021 graduate Isabella.
- Lex was a two-time All-State performer at Cherokee HS in New Jersey, leading the team to a 92-10 record and ranking third in program history with 1,283 points.
- Therien and fellow freshman **Keegan Douglas** were named co-South Jersey Players of the Year during their senior high school seasons.
- Douglas totaled 1,624 points at Haddonfield HS while helping the program win three Colonial Conference championships. She was chosen as the conference's Player of the Year in each of her final two seasons.
- Laura Salmerón** joins Loyola after playing two seasons in Spain's second division basketball league. Salmerón, who also competed internationally for Spain's U-15 team, was a three-star ESPN recruit who received a 90 scouts grade.
- Jonelle Price** was a key contributor at Neumann-Goretti HS in Philadelphia, helping the program win a PIAA Class 3A state title.
- Vanessa Stoltzner** joins the Greyhounds as a walk-on. She was a two-time All-State performer at Cromwell HS (CT), winning a Class A state title in 2019.

NEW SEASON, NEW OPPORTUNITY FOR ELEVEN RETURNERS

- Loyola brings back 11 student-athletes, including four starters, from a squad which went 0-12 against Patriot League opponents during the regular season before falling at Bucknell in the quarterfinals of the conference tournament.
- The Patriot League Council of Presidents voted during the Fall of 2020 to play only conference games starting in early January. Of the 16 dates on Loyola's initial 2020-21 schedule, the Greyhounds only played their originally scheduled opponent on four occasions due to a variety of COVID-19 issues at opposing schools.
- Emily McAteer** (9.2 ppg, 5.4 rpg) and **Taleah Dixon** (8.1 ppg, 2.3 rpg), who were both Patriot League All-Rookie Team honorees during their debut collegiate seasons, are Loyola's top returning scorers for the 2021-22 campaign.

PREPPING FOR PATRIOT LEAGUE PLAY

- Wednesday's road matchup will be the fifth of 11 non-conference games for the Greyhounds prior to their Patriot League opener against Army on Dec. 30.
- Loyola is on the road for two more games before hosting Mount St. Mary's (12/4) and Morgan State (12/8) in early December. The non-conference schedule concludes with trips to Toledo (12/11) and St. Francis Brooklyn (12/23).
- Loyola was ranked ninth out of 10 schools in this year's Patriot League pre-season poll. The Greyhounds went 8-22 (5-13 PL) during their last full season of competition in 2019-20.

SMART HOUNDS

- Loyola posted a team grade-point average of 3.35 during the 2020-21 academic year. **Kayla Sieper** (3.97), **Laryn Edwards** (3.66), **Devyn Newman** (3.54) and **Bri Rozzi** (3.54) all have cumulative GPA's above a 3.50.
- The program has a history of academic excellence, as the Greyhounds were named to the WBCA Division I Academic Top 25 Honor Roll for five-straight seasons from 2016-20.
- Loyola was one of just three schools nationally to crack the top 15 academically in each of those five years.

HEAD COACH DANIELLE O'BANION

- **Danielle O'Banion** was named the 12th head women's basketball coach at Loyola University Maryland in April, 2021.
- O'Banion brings 20 years of Division I coaching experience to the Greyhounds, most-recently serving her second stint as an assistant at the University of Minnesota over the past three seasons. Her teams have combined for 10 postseason appearances, including five NCAA tournaments and one run to the Final Four.
- Originally from Arlington, Virginia, O'Banion returns to the Mid-Atlantic after coaching stints at Minnesota, Memphis, Kent State and Harvard. A standout recruiter who has brought in four Top-50 classes during her career, she has also held multiple leadership positions within both the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) and Advocates for Athletic Equity (formerly Black Coaches and Administrators).
- O'Banion rejoined Minnesota in 2018 following a two-year stint as associate head coach at Memphis. During the past three seasons with the Golden Gophers, she worked primarily with the post players while also playing a key role in recruiting.
- Originally an assistant at Minnesota from 2002-07, O'Banion's first assistant stint coincided with the best five-year run in team history. The Golden Gophers made four-consecutive NCAA tournaments, advancing to one Final Four (2004) and two Sweet Sixteens (2003, 2005); they also added a WNIT appearance in 2007. O'Banion worked primarily with the backcourt, coaching four All-Big Ten selections and one Kodak All-American (current Minnesota head coach Lindsay Whalen).
- O'Banion then spent four years at Memphis from 2008-12, earning a promotion to associate head coach and recruiting coordinator for the final three seasons. She helped bring in the No. 1-ranked recruiting classes in Conference USA (Top 50 nationally) in each of her first two years on-campus. Those recruits succeeded on the court with Memphis winning 78 games during her four seasons while making three postseason appearances.
- In between her two stops at Memphis, O'Banion spent four seasons as head coach at Kent State. She restored roster stability to the program, signing 17 players overall with four going on to play professionally. O'Banion was also active in fundraising, helping secure the largest-ever financial gift to the program.
- O'Banion was diagnosed with Stage 2 lymphoma cancer midway through her stint at Kent State. She managed to coach every game while going through treatment, and she announced that her cancer was in remission six months after her original diagnosis. O'Banion was presented with the U.S. Basketball Writers Association (USBWA) Pat Summitt Most Courageous Award for women's basketball at the 2016 Final Four.
- A 20-year member of the Women's Basketball Coaches' Association, O'Banion served on the WBCA Board of Directors from 2013-15 and was an Awards Committee member from 2011-12. She was also the second woman to be named president of Black Coaches and Administrators, serving in that role in 2011-12 following four years on the BCA Board of Directors.
- O'Banion began her coaching career as an assistant at Harvard in 2001-02, helping the Crimson win the Ivy League and earn an NCAA tournament berth in her lone season with the program.
- As an undergraduate, O'Banion was a four-year letterwinner at Boston College from 1997-2001. She helped guide the Eagles to their first two NCAA tournament appearances in program history, and she was a co-captain and Big East Academic All-Star during her senior season. She graduated from Boston College in 2001 with a bachelor's degree in psychology and Hispanic Studies minor.
- O'Banion grew up in Northern Virginia, and she prepped at Episcopal High School in Alexandria, Virginia where she was a Washington Post All-Met guard for the Maroon.

Meet the Coaching Staff

Courtney Davidson - Assistant Coach/Recruiting Coordinator

- Courtney Davidson joins the Greyhounds after most-recently serving as an assistant coach at Hartford for the past two years. A 2016 WBCA "Thirty Under 30" award recipient, she has also worked on coaching staffs at Youngstown State, Radford and the College of Charleston following a successful playing career at Michigan State.
- Davidson, who will work with Loyola's point guards, has coached eight all-conference, three all-rookie and four all-academic performers during her coaching career.
- As a player, Davidson made 101 appearances for a Michigan State squad which reached three NCAA tournaments (National Runner-Up in 2005, Sweet 16 in 2006, Second Round in 2007) and advanced to the WNIT title game during her senior season in 2008.

Simeon Spurling - Assistant Coach

- Simeon Spurling joins the staff following a three-year stint as video coordinator at UCLA. He was responsible for creating and presenting multiple scouting reports and game plans to staff.
- UCLA made the NCAA tournament during both completed seasons in his tenure, including a Sweet 16 run in 2019, and held a 26-5 record at the time of the 2020 season's cancellation due to COVID-19.
- Prior to joining UCLA, Spurling spent three years as video coordinator for the WNBA's Los Angeles Sparks, where he created video scouting reports for the team and assisted the coaching staff during film sessions and practices.
- Spurling's tenure with the Sparks included a WNBA title in 2017.

Lisa Strack - Assistant Coach

- Lisa Strack brings 11 years of Patriot League experience to the Greyhounds, spending the last seven years as an assistant at Army following a standout playing career at American.
- Strack was promoted to Army's associate head coach in 2018 after the Black Knights posted winning seasons in each of her first four years on staff, including three 20-win seasons, two postseason appearances and a Patriot League championship in 2016.
- As an undergrad, Strack was named Patriot League Player of the Year and American's Female Athlete of the Year during her senior season in 2012. She led American to a 14-0 regular season conference record and a third WNIT appearance in four years that winter.

Annalese Lamke - Director of Basketball Operations

- Annalese Lamke spent the previous two seasons as a graduate assistant at Bethel University after playing for O'Banion as an undergrad at Minnesota. Lamke helped Bethel finish a program-best 26-2 during the 2019-20 season, winning an MIAC title to clinch an automatic spot in the NCAA Division III tournament.
- Lamke was a three-time Academic All-Big Ten selection who was honored as a Big Ten Distinguished Scholar in 2019. She appeared in 88 games overall for Minnesota, averaging 7.7 points and 5.0 rebounds per game while serving as a team captain during her senior season.
