THE MATCHUP

 Loyola women's basketball heads back to the nation's capital for a second-straight Wednesday, as the Greyhounds face Howard to wrap up a stretch of three-consecutive road games.

LAST TIME OUT

- Milan Bolden-Morris scored a game-high 21 points, while Kelsey Ransom added 15 points and five assists to help Georgetown top Loyola by a 66-55 final last Wednesday.
- **Bri Rozzi** totaled a career-high 15 points for the Greyhounds, while **Taleah Dixon** and **Charia Roberts** (8-10 FT) added 12 points each and **Lex Therien** grabbed 12 rebounds.
- The Hoyas (3-2) shot 57.5 percent from the field overall and hit 8 of 9 field goal attempts in the fourth quarter to close out the victory.
- Rozzi scored 10 of her 15 points in the fourth, as she surpassed her previous career-best scoring effort of 13 which was set on two previous occasions.

MORE ON ROZZI

- **Bri Rozzi's** career-high scoring output at Georgetown included a 3 for 7 output from 3-point range. She has hit eight 3-pointers in the last three games alone, and is shooting 42.9 percent (12 for 28) from long distance overall on the year.
- Rozzi ranks second in the Patriot League in 3-point field goal percentage, and she is fifth in the conference in 3's per game (2.0).
- One of three team captains this season (along with Taleah Dixon and Laryn Edwards),
 Rozzi is averaging a team-high 33.8 minutes per game while starting all six contests. She
 has reached double figures in 4 of 6 games, and is also shooting 84.2 percent (16 for 19)
 from the free throw line.

LOOKING AHEAD

SERIES HISTORY

- Both teams have four wins in a series which dates back to 2002.
- Howard earned a 75-69 victory at Reitz in the most-recent meeting on Nov. 20, 2019, outscoring the Greyhounds 28-20 over the final 10 minutes after trailing 49-47 through three guarters.
- Current senior **Laryn Edwards** (11 pts) was one of three Loyola players in double figures in that matchup.
- Loyola is 0-3 in its three previous games at Burr Gymnasium, including a 40-37 setback during its last trip on Nov. 28, 2012. The Greyhounds' last win over Howard came on Nov. 20, 2013 (72-62).

SCOUTING HOWARD

- The Bison (2-4) will be playing at home for the first time this season on Wednesday. They had won back-to-back games at Saint Peter's (62-52) and Mount St. Mary's (56-49) before falling 96-52 at Towson over the weekend.
- Howard went 15-4 (10-2 MEAC) during the abbreviated 2020-21 season, dropping a 59-57 decision to North Carolina A&T in the 2021 MEAC championship game.
- Four starters return from last year's team, including 2021 MEAC Rookie of the Year Anzhane Hutton, third team All-MEAC performer lyanna Warren and All-Rookie team selection Kaiya Creek. Howard was picked first in this year's MEAC Preseason poll.

QUICK HITS FROM GEORGETOWN

- Charia Roberts' 12 points matched a season and career high, while her eight made free throws were also a new career best.
- **Taleah Dixon** (12 points) hit 4 of 8 field goals attempts, including 2 of 4 shots from 3-point range, to reach double figures for a fifth time in six games to begin the year.
- With her 12 rebounds, **Lex Therien** has now reached double figures on the glass in three of the last four games. She ranks second in the Patriot League in rebounds per game (9.8) and leads the conference in offensive rebounds per game (4.0).
- Laura Salmerón dished out a team-high four assists for the Greyhounds, and she has 10 assists in the last three games overall.
- Georgetown shot 57.5 percent from the field (23-40) and 57.1 percent from 3-point range (8-14), both of which were the highest by a Loyola opponent this season.
- The Greyhounds forced a season-high 20 turnovers and had a 21-14 advantage in points off turnovers.
- Last Wednesday marked the first time in six games this season that Loyola did not hold a lead in the fourth quarter.

MOVING UP THE PATRIOT LEAGUE RANKINGS

- Loyola has shown improvement in several areas during the program's first six games under new head coach Danielle O'Banion.
- The Greyhounds are currently third among Patriot League schools in 3-point FG% (34.1) and fourth in assists per game (11.8) after ranking last in both categories last winter.
- Loyola is additionally fourth in rebounding margin (+1.5) after finishing ninth out of 10 conference schools in 2020-21, and the program also ranks fourth in scoring defense (61.8 ppg) and free throw percentage (75.2).

BALANCED ATTACK

- Loyola has used the same starting lineup in each of the first six games - Taleah Dixon, Charia Roberts, Bri Rozzi, Laura Salmerón and Lex Therien - and those five have combined for 19 doubledigit scoring performances.
- All five starters are averaging between 9.3 and 12.2 points per game. The highest scoring total for any player was 15-point efforts by both Rozzi and Salmerón.
- Roberts leads the starters in field goal percentage (44.7, 21-47).

CLUTCH AT THE LINE

- Loyola has shot over 70 percent from the free throw line in five of its first six games, including a season-best 81.8 percent output (9 for 11) at Hofstra on Saturday, Nov. 20.
- Loyola hit 10 of 13 free throws in the fourth, including each of its last six attempts, to close out a victory over UMBC on Nov. 17.
- Taleah Dixon (85.3%, 29-34) ranks third in the Patriot League in free throws made, and she is fourth among conference shooters in FT percentage.

WORTH NOTING

- Loyola is searching for its first road victory since a 50-44 triumph over Navy on Feb. 1, 2020.
- The Greyhounds have outrebounded their opponent by an overall margin of 140-116 during the past four games. They also have a sizable advantage in free throw attempts (73-40) during those four contests
- Bri Rozzi became the first Greyhound to play the entire game since Jan. 5, 2020 (Laryn Edwards vs. Lehigh) during Loyola's victory over UMBC.
- Loyola rallied past the Retrievers after trailing 37-23 early in the third quarter. The program's last win after falling behind by 14+ points in the second half was a 66-60 triumph over Iona back in 2012.
- Loyola's 68-59 OT win over FDU on Nov. 14 was the program's first in overtime since Jan. 2, 2017 at Lafayette. The Greyhounds are now 3-9 in OT dating back to March 4, 2011.

THERIEN NAMED PATRIOT LEAGUE ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

- **Lex Therien** received her first-career Patriot League weekly award last Monday after averaging 12.5 points and 11.0 rebounds per game during a 1-1 week for the Greyhounds.
- Therien contributed a season-high 13 points (6-11 FG) and nine rebounds in a 63-57 win over UMBC on Nov. 17, as Loyola rallied from a second-half 14+ point deficit for the first time since Feb. 10, 2012. Six of her rebounds came on the offensive end to help the Greyhounds finish with a convincing 38-27 advantage on the glass.
- Therien followed that effort with her second double-double in the last three games at Hofstra on Saturday. She hit all four of her free throws and picked up six more offensive rebounds.
- Therien is the program's first Patriot League weekly award winner since Emily McAteer was named Rookie of the Week on Jan. 13, 2020.

FIVE NEWCOMERS JOIN PROGRAM IN 2021-22

- Loyola's 16-member roster includes five freshmen who will be making their collegiate debuts this winter.
- **Lex Therien** becomes the third Therien sister to compete for the Greyhounds. joining current junior Ava Therien and 2021 graduate Isabella.
- Lex was a two-time All-State performer at Cherokee HS in New Jersey, leading the team to a 92-10 record and ranking third in program history with 1,283 points.
- Therien and fellow freshman **Keegan Douglas** were named co-South Jersey Players of the Year during their senior high school seasons.
- Douglas totaled 1,624 points at Haddonfield HS while helping the program win three Colonial Conference championships. She was chosen as the confernce's Player of the Year in each of her final two seasons.
- **Laura Salmerón** joins Loyola after playing two seasons in Spain's second division basketball league. Salmerón, who also competed internationally for Spain's U-15 team, was a three-star ESPN recruit who received a 90 scouts grade.
- **Jonelle Price** was a key contributor at Neumann-Goretti HS in Philadelphia, helping the program win a PIAA Class 3A state title.
- Vanessa Stolstajner joins the Greyhounds as a walk-on. She was a two-time All-State performer at Cromwell HS (CT), winning a Class A state title in 2019.

NEW SEASON, NEW OPPORTUNITY FOR ELEVEN RETURNERS

- Loyola brings back 11 student-athletes, including four starters, from a squad which went 0-12 against Patriot League opponents during the regular season before falling at Bucknell in the quarterfinals of the conference tournament.
- The Patriot League Council of Presidents voted during the Fall of 2020 to play only conference games starting in early January. Of the 16 dates on Loyola's initial 2020-21 schedule, the Greyhounds only played their originally scheduled opponent on four occasions due to a variety of COVID-19 issues at opposing schools.
- **Emily McAteer** (9.2 ppg, 5.4 rpg) and **Taleah Dixon** (8.1 ppg, 2.3 rpg), who were both Patriot League All-Rookie Team honorees during their debut collegiate seasons, are Loyola's top returning scorers for the 2021-22 campaign.

PREPPING FOR PATRIOT LEAGUE PLAY

- Wednesday's road matchup will be the sixth of 11 non-conference games for the Greyhounds prior to their Patriot League opener against Army on Dec. 30.
- Loyola returns to Reitz Arena for its next two games against Mount St. Mary's (12/4) and Morgan State (12/8). The non-conference schedule then concludes with trips to Toledo (12/11) and St. Francis Brooklyn (12/23).
- Loyola was ranked ninth out of 10 schools in this year's Patriot League preseason poll. The Greyhounds went 8-22 (5-13 PL) during their last full season of competition in 2019-20.

SMART HOUNDS

- Loyola posted a team grade-point average of 3.35 during the 2020-21 academic year. **Kayla Sieper** (3.97), **Laryn Edwards** (3.66), **Devyne Newman** (3.54) and Bri Rozzi (3.54) all have cumulative GPA's above a 3.50.
- The program has a history of academic excellence, as the Greyhounds were named to the WBCA Division I Academic Top 25 Honor Roll for five-straight seasons from 2016-20.
- Loyola was one of just three schools nationally to crack the top 15 academically in each of those five years.

HEAD COACH DANIELLE O'BANION

- Danielle O'Banion was named the 12th head women's basketball coach at Loyola University Maryland in April, 2021.
- O'Banion brings 20 years of Division I coaching experience to the Greyhounds, most-recently serving her second stint as an assistant at the University of Minnesota over the past three seasons. Her teams have combined for 10 postseason appearances, including five NCAA tournaments and one run to the Final Four.
- Originally from Arlington, Virginia, O'Banion returns to the Mid-Atlantic after coaching stints at Minnesota, Memphis, Kent State and Harvard. A standout recruiter who has brought in four Top-50 classes during her career, she has also held multiple leadership positions within both the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) and Advocates for Athletic Equity (formerly Black Coaches and Administrators).
- O'Banion rejoined Minnesota in 2018 following a two-year stint as associate head coach at Memphis. During the past three seasons with the Golden Gophers, she worked primarily with the post players while also playing a key role in recruiting.
- Originally an assistant at Minnesota from 2002-07, O'Banion's
 first assistant stint coincided with the best five-year run in team
 history. The Golden Gophers made four-consecutive NCAA tournaments, advancing to one Final Four (2004) and two Sweet
 Sixteens (2003, 2005); they also added a WNIT appearance in
 2007. O'Banion worked primarily with the backcourt, coaching
 four All-Big Ten selections and one Kodak All-American (current
 Minnesota head coach Lindsay Whalen).
- O'Banion then spent four years at Memphis from 2008-12, earning a promotion to associate head coach and recruiting coordinator for the final three seasons. She helped bring in the No. 1-ranked recruiting classes in Conference USA (Top 50 nationally) in each of her first two years on-campus. Those recruits succeeded on the court with Memphis winning 78 games during her four seasons while making three postseason appearances.
- In between her two stops at Memphis, O'Banion spent four seasons as head coach at Kent State. She restored roster stability to the program, signing 17 players overall with four going on to play professionally. O'Banion was also active in fundraising, helping secure the largest-ever financial gift to the program.
- O'Banion was diagnosed with Stage 2 lymphoma cancer midway through her stint at Kent State. She managed to coach every game while going through treatment, and she announced that her cancer was in remission six months after her original diagnosis. O'Banion was presented with the U.S. Basketball Writers Association (USBWA) Pat Summitt Most Courageous Award for women's basketball at the 2016 Final Four.
- A 20-year member of the Women's Basketball Coaches' Association, O'Banion served on the WBCA Board of Directors from 2013-15 and was an Awards Committee member from 2011-12.
 She was also the second woman to be named president of Black Coaches and Administrators, serving in that role in 2011-12 following four years on the BCA Board of Directors.
- O'Banion began her coaching career as an assistant at Harvard in 2001-02, helping the Crimson win the Ivy League and earn an NCAA tournament berth in her lone season with the program.
- As an undergraduate, O'Banion was a four-year letterwinner at Boston College from 1997-2001. She helped guide the Eagles to their first two NCAA tournament appearances in program history, and she was a co-captain and Big East Academic All-Star during her senior season. She graduated from Boston College in 2001 with a bachelor's degree in psychology and Hispanic Studies minor.
- O'Banion grew up in Northern Virginia, and she prepped at Episcopal High School in Alexandria, Virginia where she was a Washington Post All-Met guard for the Maroon.

Meet the Coaching Staff

Courtney Davidson - Assistant Coach/Recruiting Coordinator

- Courtney Davidson joins the Greyhounds after most-recently serving as an assistant coach at Hartford for the past two years. A 2016 WBCA "Thirty Under 30" award recipient, she has also worked on coaching staffs at Youngstown State, Radford and the College of Charleston following a successful playing career at Michigan State.
- Davidson, who will work with Loyola's point guards, has coached eight all-conference, three all-rookie and four all-academic performers during her coaching career.
- As a player, Davidson made 101 appearances for a Michigan State squad which reached three NCAA tournaments (National Runner-Up in 2005, Sweet 16 in 2006, Second Round in 2007) and advanced to the WNIT title game during her senior season in 2008.

Simeon Spurling - Assistant Coach

- Simeon Spurling joins the staff following a three-year stint as video coordinator at UCLA. He was responsible for creating and presenting multiple scouting reports and game plans to staff.
- UCLA made the NCAA tournament during both completed seasons in his tenure, including a Sweet 16 run in 2019, and held a 26-5 record at the time of the 2020 season's cancellation due to COVID-19.
- Prior to joining UCLA, Spurling spent three years as video coordinator for the WNBA's Los Angeles Sparks, where he created video scouting reports for the team and assisted the coaching staff during film sessions and practices.
- Spurling's tenure with the Sparks included a WNBA title in 2017.

Lisa Strack - Assistant Coach

- Lisa Strack brings 11 years of Patriot League experience to the Greyhounds, spending the last seven years as an assistant fat Army following a standout playing career at American.
- Strack was promoted to Army's associate head coach in 2018 after the Black Knights posted winning seasons in each of her first four years on staff, including three 20-win seasons, two postseason appearances and a Patriot League championship in 2016.
- As an undergrad, Strack was named Patriot League Player of the Year and American's Female Athlete of the Year during her senior season in 2012. She led American to a 14-0 regular season conference record and a third WNIT appearance in four years that winter.

Annalese Lamke - Director of Basketball Operations

- Annalese Lamke spent the previous two seasons as a graduate assistant at Bethel University after playing for O'Banion as an undergrad at Minnesota. Lamke helped Bethel finish a program-best 26-2 during the 2019-20 season, winning an MIAC title to clinch an automatic spot in the NCAA Division III tournament.
- Lamke was a three-time Academic All-Big Ten selection who was honored as a Big Ten Distinguished Scholar in 2019. She appeared in 88 games overall for Minnesota, averaging 7.7 points and 5.0 rebounds per game while serving as a team captain during her senior season.
