THE MATCHUP

- Loyola women's basketball returns to Reitz Arena for a Wednesday night matchup against Morgan State, as the two Baltimore schools face off for the first time since the 1984-85 season.
- The Greyhounds are looking to win four-consecutive home games during a single season for the first time since January, 2016.

LAST TIME OUT

- Bri Rozzi dribbled around a Lex Therien screen, stepped back and knocked down an 18foot jumper with 11 seconds remaining to lift Loyola to a 56-55 win over visiting Mount St. Mary's on Saturday.
- Taleah Dixon led all players with a season-high 23 points to go with six rebounds and two steals. Rozzi totaled 13 points, while Therien had 12 and a team-high eight rebounds.
- The Greyhounds have won three games in a row at Reitz Arena for the first time since a
 five game run from the end of the 2015-16 season through the first two home contests of
 the 2016-17 campaign.

DOWN TO THE WIRE

- Saturday's matchup against the Mount was the sixth time in eight contests this season that Loyola has been in a one-possession game during the final minute of regulation.
- The Greyhounds are now 3-3 in those contests after previously managing comeback victories over FDU (68-59, OT) and UMBC (63-57).
- Loyola is now 1-3 in games decided by three points or fewer following previous last-second defeats to George Mason (53-51), Hofstra (55-53) and Howard (61-59).
- The Greyhounds have held fourth-quarter leads in seven of eight games this season under first year head coach **Danielle O'Banion**.

LOOKING AHEAD

- The Greyhounds hit the road for their final two non-conference games of the regular season, beginning with a 2 p.m. matchup at Toledo on Saturday.
- Patriot League play begins with a 7 p.m. home game against Army West Point on Thursday, Dec. 30.

SERIES HISTORY

- Morgan State leads 11-2 in a series which began in 1974 but is resuming on Wednesday for the first time in 36 years.
- The Bears won each of the last eight meetings during the late 1970's and early 1980's, including a 74-64 victory in the last meeting to conclude the 1984-85 season.
- Loyola's last win in the series was a 78-68 home triumph during the 1976-77 season.

SCOUTING MORGAN STATE

- The Bears (5-4) have won each of their last five games, including a 58-46 home victory over Hofstra on Monday. This will be their second matchup against a Patriot League school, as they topped Navy by a 71-50 final last Thursday.
- Morgan State, which went 12-4 (8-2 MEAC) during the shortened 2020-21 season, was ranked second in the MEAC preseason poll.
- Gr. F Dahnye Redd, Sr. G Ashia McCalla and Jr. G Ja'niah Henson were all first team Preseason All-MEAC selections, with Redd voted as the conference's Preseason Player of the Year.
- Redd has reached double figures in 7 of 9 games on the year, and she led all scorers with 20 points (9-14 FG) to go along with 10 rebounds during last week's win at Navy.

QUICK HITS FROM MOUNT ST. MARY'S

- Taleah Dixon's 23 points were the most by a Loyola player this season, as she became the first Greyhound to score 20+ points since Feb. 13, 2021 (Isabella Therien - 21 pts vs. Navy).
- Dixon (8-16 FG, 3-7 3FG) totaled 20+ points for the fourth time in her collegiate career, and the first time since she had a career-best 26 during the 2019 Patriot League quarterfinals at Bucknell.
- **Bri Rozzi** played all 40 minutes for a second time this season and set a new career high with five made field goals.
- Loyola shot a season-best 92.3 percent (12 for 13) from the free throw line. The Greyhounds were led at the charity stripe by Dixon (4-4 FT) and Lex Therien (6-7 FT).
- The Greyhounds snapped a three-game losing streak to the Mount, picking up their first win in the series since Dec. 3, 2016.
- Ava Therien made her season debut in the victory, making her first appearance since Feb. 22, 2020 after missing all of last year due to an offseason medical condition. She contributed two points in six minutes off the bench.
- The Greyhounds improved to 3-1 this season at Reitz Arena, and they are now 1-4 when scoring fewer than 60 points.

THERIEN EARNS SECOND ROOKIE OF THE WEEK AWARD

- Lex Therien was announced as the Patriot League's top rookie for a second time in the last three weeks on Monday. She averaged 13.0 points and 7.5 rebounds during a 1-1 week for the Greyhounds, scoring in double figures in both contests.
- Therien reached double figures for a sixth time in eight games during Saturday's win over the Mount, and she scored a season-high 14 points (6-10 FG) in last Wednesday's two-point loss at Howard.
- Therien has grabbed 6+ rebounds in every contest this season.
 She ranks third in the Patriot League in rebounds per game (9.2) and posted double-doubles during matchups against Fairleigh Dickinson (Nov. 14) and Hofstra (Nov. 20)

DIXON LEADING THE OFFENSE

- **Taleah Dixon** has now reached double figures in 7 of 8 games this season after her 23-point performance on Saturday. Her 14.0 points per game lead Loyola and are ranked eighth overall in the Patriot League.
- Dixon also paces the Greyhounds in both free throw percentage (87.5, 35-40) and 3-point field goal percentage (41.9, 13-31). She is third among Patriot League shooters and 54th nationally in FT%.
- Dixon is one of three team captains for Loyola this season, along with Laryn Edwards and Bri Rozzi.

CONSISTENT PRODUCTION FROM ROZZI

- **Bri Rozzi** has totaled 3+ field goals in every game this season, and she also has at least one 3-pointer in all eight contests for the Greyhounds.
- Rozzi reached double figures for a fifth time on the year with her 13-point effort on Saturday. She hit 5 of 10 field goals, made both of her free throws and sank her only 3-point attempt.
- Rozzi is averaging 10.9 points per game overall while shooting 40.3 percent (27 for 67) from the field and 41.2 percent (14 for 34) from 3-point range.

MOVING UP THE PATRIOT LEAGUE RANKINGS

- Loyola has shown improvement in several areas during the program's first eight games under head coach **Danielle O'Banion**.
- The Greyhounds are currently fourth among Patriot League schools in 3-point FG% (33.9) after ranking last in 2020-21.
- Loyola is also among the conference leaders in free throw percentage (2nd, 77.3), scoring defense (4th, 60.9 ppg) and turnover margin (4th, -0.75).

STRONG AT THE LINE

- With their season-best 92.3 percent performance from the free throw line on Saturday, the Greyhounds have now shot over 70 percent from the charity stripe in 7 of 8 games on the year.
- Taleah Dixon (87.5, 35-40), Bri Rozzi (82.6, 19-23), Lex Therien (73.9, 17-23) and Charia Roberts (70.8, 17-24) are all among the team leaders from the charity stripe.

WORTH NOTING

- Charia Roberts leads Loyola in field goal percentage through eight games, hitting 45.6 percent (26 for 57) of her shots from the floor.
- **Laura Salmerón** is averaging a team-high 33.3 minutes per game during her debut season. She has started 7 of 8 games and scored a season-high 15 points during a 68-59 OT win over FDU.
- Loyola's 63-57 win over UMBC on Nov. 17 was the program's first victory after trailing by 14+ points in the second half since Feb. 10, 2012 vs. Iona (66-60).
- Loyola's overtime victory over FDU on Nov. 14 was the program's first in extra time since Jan. 2, 2017 at Lafayette. The Greyhounds are now 3-9 in OT dating back to March 4, 2011.

FOUR NEWCOMERS JOIN PROGRAM IN 2021-22

- Loyola's 15-member roster includes four freshmen who will be making their collegiate debuts this winter.
- Lex Therien becomes the third Therien sister to compete for the Greyhounds, joining current junior Ava Therien and 2021 graduate Isabella.
- Lex was a two-time All-State performer at Cherokee HS in New Jersey, leading the team to a 92-10 record and ranking third in program history with 1,283 points.
- Therien and fellow freshman **Keegan Douglas** were named co-South Jersey Players of the Year during their senior high school seasons.
- Douglas totaled 1,624 points at Haddonfield HS while helping the program win three Colonial Conference championships. She was chosen as the conference's Player of the Year in each of her final two seasons.
- Laura Salmerón joins Loyola after playing two seasons in Spain's second division basketball league. Salmerón, who also competed internationally for Spain's U-15 team, was a three-star ESPN recruit who received a 90 scouts grade.
- **Jonelle Price** was a key contributor at Neumann-Goretti HS in Philadelphia, helping the program win a PIAA Class 3A state title.

NEW SEASON, NEW OPPORTUNITY FOR ELEVEN RETURNERS

- Loyola brings back 11 student-athletes, including four starters, from a squad which went 0-12 against Patriot League opponents during the regular season before falling at Bucknell in the guarterfinals of the conference tournament.
- The Patriot League Council of Presidents voted during the Fall of 2020 to play only conference games starting in early January. Of the 16 dates on Loyola's initial 2020-21 schedule, the Greyhounds only played their originally scheduled opponent on four occasions due to a variety of COVID-19 issues at opposing schools.
- **Emily McAteer** (9.2 ppg, 5.4 rpg) and **Taleah Dixon** (8.1 ppg, 2.3 rpg), who were both Patriot League All-Rookie Team honorees during their debut collegiate seasons, are Loyola's top returning scorers for the 2021-22 campaign.

PREPPING FOR PATRIOT LEAGUE PLAY

- Wednesday's home matchup will be the ninth of 11 non-conference games for the Greyhounds prior to their Patriot League opener against Army on Dec. 30.
- The non-conference schedule concludes with trips to Toledo (12/11) and St. Francis Brooklyn (12/23).
- Loyola was ranked ninth out of 10 schools in this year's Patriot League preseason poll. The Greyhounds went 8-22 (5-13 PL) during their last full season of competition in 2019-20.

SMART HOUNDS

- Loyola posted a team grade-point average of 3.35 during the 2020-21 academic year. Kayla Sieper (3.97), Laryn Edwards (3.66), Devyne Newman (3.54) and Bri Rozzi (3.54) all have cumulative GPA's above a 3.50.
- The program has a history of academic excellence, as the Greyhounds were named to the WBCA Division I Academic Top 25 Honor Roll for five-straight seasons from 2016-20.
- Loyola was one of just three schools nationally to crack the top 15 academically in each of those five years.

HEAD COACH DANIELLE O'BANION

- Danielle O'Banion was named the 12th head women's basketball coach at Loyola University Maryland in April, 2021.
- O'Banion brings 20 years of Division I coaching experience to the Greyhounds, most-recently serving her second stint as an assistant at the University of Minnesota over the past three seasons. Her teams have combined for 10 postseason appearances, including five NCAA tournaments and one run to the Final Four.
- Originally from Arlington, Virginia, O'Banion returns to the Mid-Atlantic after coaching stints at Minnesota, Memphis, Kent State and Harvard. A standout recruiter who has brought in four Top-50 classes during her career, she has also held multiple leadership positions within both the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) and Advocates for Athletic Equity (formerly Black Coaches and Administrators).
- O'Banion rejoined Minnesota in 2018 following a two-year stint as associate head coach at Memphis. During the past three seasons with the Golden Gophers, she worked primarily with the post players while also playing a key role in recruiting.
- Originally an assistant at Minnesota from 2002-07, O'Banion's first assistant stint coincided with the best five-year run in team history. The Golden Gophers made four-consecutive NCAA tournaments, advancing to one Final Four (2004) and two Sweet Sixteens (2003, 2005); they also added a WNIT appearance in 2007. O'Banion worked primarily with the backcourt, coaching four All-Big Ten selections and one Kodak All-American (current Minnesota head coach Lindsay Whalen).
- O'Banion then spent four years at Memphis from 2008-12, earning a promotion to associate head coach and recruiting coordinator for the final three seasons. She helped bring in the No. 1-ranked recruiting classes in Conference USA (Top 50 nationally) in each of her first two years on-campus. Those recruits succeeded on the court with Memphis winning 78 games during her four seasons while making three postseason appearances.
- In between her two stops at Memphis, O'Banion spent four seasons as head coach at Kent State. She restored roster stability to the program, signing 17 players overall with four going on to play professionally. O'Banion was also active in fundraising, helping secure the largest-ever financial gift to the program.
- O'Banion was diagnosed with Stage 2 lymphoma cancer midway through her stint at Kent State. She managed to coach every game while going through treatment, and she announced that her cancer was in remission six months after her original diagnosis. O'Banion was presented with the U.S. Basketball Writers Association (USBWA) Pat Summitt Most Courageous Award for women's basketball at the 2016 Final Four.
- A 20-year member of the Women's Basketball Coaches' Association, O'Banion served on the WBCA Board of Directors from 2013-15 and was an Awards Committee member from 2011-12.
 She was also the second woman to be named president of Black Coaches and Administrators, serving in that role in 2011-12 following four years on the BCA Board of Directors.
- O'Banion began her coaching career as an assistant at Harvard in 2001-02, helping the Crimson win the Ivy League and earn an NCAA tournament berth in her lone season with the program.
- As an undergraduate, O'Banion was a four-year letterwinner at Boston College from 1997-2001. She helped guide the Eagles to their first two NCAA tournament appearances in program history, and she was a co-captain and Big East Academic All-Star during her senior season. She graduated from Boston College in 2001 with a bachelor's degree in psychology and Hispanic Studies minor.
- O'Banion grew up in Northern Virginia, and she prepped at Episcopal High School in Alexandria, Virginia where she was a Washington Post All-Met guard for the Maroon.

Meet the Coaching Staff

Courtney Davidson - Assistant Coach/Recruiting Coordinator

- Courtney Davidson joins the Greyhounds after most-recently serving as an assistant coach at Hartford for the past two years. A 2016 WBCA "Thirty Under 30" award recipient, she has also worked on coaching staffs at Youngstown State, Radford and the College of Charleston following a successful playing career at Michigan State.
- Davidson, who will work with Loyola's point guards, has coached eight all-conference, three all-rookie and four all-academic performers during her coaching career.
- As a player, Davidson made 101 appearances for a Michigan State squad which reached three NCAA tournaments (National Runner-Up in 2005, Sweet 16 in 2006, Second Round in 2007) and advanced to the WNIT title game during her senior season in 2008.

Simeon Spurling - Assistant Coach

- Simeon Spurling joins the staff following a three-year stint as video coordinator at UCLA. He was responsible for creating and presenting multiple scouting reports and game plans to staff.
- UCLA made the NCAA tournament during both completed seasons in his tenure, including a Sweet 16 run in 2019, and held a 26-5 record at the time of the 2020 season's cancellation due to COVID-19.
- Prior to joining UCLA, Spurling spent three years as video coordinator for the WNBA's Los Angeles Sparks, where he created video scouting reports for the team and assisted the coaching staff during film sessions and practices.
- Spurling's tenure with the Sparks included a WNBA title in 2017.

Lisa Strack - Assistant Coach

- Lisa Strack brings 11 years of Patriot League experience to the Greyhounds, spending the last seven years as an assistant fat Army following a standout playing career at American.
- Strack was promoted to Army's associate head coach in 2018 after the Black Knights posted winning seasons in each of her first four years on staff, including three 20-win seasons, two postseason appearances and a Patriot League championship in 2016.
- As an undergrad, Strack was named Patriot League Player of the Year and American's Female Athlete of the Year during her senior season in 2012. She led American to a 14-0 regular season conference record and a third WNIT appearance in four years that winter.

Annalese Lamke - Director of Basketball Operations

- Annalese Lamke spent the previous two seasons as a graduate assistant at Bethel University after playing for O'Banion as an undergrad at Minnesota. Lamke helped Bethel finish a program-best 26-2 during the 2019-20 season, winning an MIAC title to clinch an automatic spot in the NCAA Division III tournament.
- Lamke was a three-time Academic All-Big Ten selection who was honored as a Big Ten Distinguished Scholar in 2019. She appeared in 88 games overall for Minnesota, averaging 7.7 points and 5.0 rebounds per game while serving as a team captain during her senior season.
