THE MATCHUP

- Loyola women's basketball looks for a third-straight home victory on Saturday, as the Greyhounds take on Mount St. Mary's in Reitz Arena.
- This will be the 42nd time Loyola has faced Mount St. Mary's during the program's 51-year history.

LAST TIME OUT

- Iyanna Warren scored the game's final five points, including a go-ahead layup with 25 seconds remaining, as Howard pulled out a 61-59 victory over Loyola on Wednesday.
- The Bison (3-4) trailed by as many as 13 points in the second half, but outscored the Greyhounds by a 24-12 margin in the fourth quarter to complete the comeback.
- Taleah Dixon had a team-high 16 points for Loyola, while Lex Therien added 14 points and seven rebounds.
- Warren's game-winning basket gave Howard its first lead of the night, as the Greyhounds opened the contest on a 5-0 run and led 17-6 at the end of the first quarter.

HOME SWEET HOME

- Loyola makes its return to Reitz Arena after an 0-3 road swing which included a pair of two-point defeats decided in the final minute at Howard and Hofstra (55-53).
- The Greyhounds are 2-1 at home to start the season, posting comeback victories over Fairleigh Dickinson (68-59, OT) and UMBC (63-57) in their last two contests at Reitz.
- Loyola has similar offensive numbers home and away, but has posted stronger defensive numbers at Reitz, where opponents are averaging 56.3 points per game compared to 65.8 ppg in four road contests.

LOOKING AHEAD

- The Greyhounds remain at home for a non-conference matchup against Morgan State next Wednesday night.
- The two teams, only two miles apart from each other off Cold Spring Lane in Baltimore, will square off for the first time since the 1984-85 season.

SERIES HISTORY

- Mount St. Mary's leads 26-15 in a series which dates back to 1974.
- The Greyhounds had won eight of the last 10 meetings prior to a current three-game run for the Mount.
- Loyola dropped an 81-75 road decision during the last matchup on Dec. 6, 2019. Stephanie Karcz (10 pts, 11 reb, 9 stl, 7 ast) flirted with a quadruple double for the visitors, but Kendall Bresee totaled a game-high 25 points to lead Mount St. Mary's.
- Loyola's' last victory was a 58-53 triumph at Reitz on Dec. 3, 2016.

SCOUTING MOUNT ST. MARY'S

- The Mountaineers (1-5) are winless against Division I competition this season, with the lone victory a 102-15 rout over Division III Valley Forge on Nov. 13. The last three defeats have come against Lehigh (91-72), Howard (56-49) and Clemson (83-59).
- Mount St. Mary's made its first NCAA tournament appearance since 1995 last winter, finishing 17-7 (14-4 NEC) and topping Wagner by a 70-38 final in the Northeast Conference Championship.
- Gr. G/F Kendall Bresee leads the team in scoring (14.0 ppg), rebounding (7.4 rpg) and assists (4.4 apg). She was the NEC Player and Defensive Player of the Year in 2020-21.
- Bresee, R-Jr. G Aryna Taylor and Sr. G Michaela Harrison were the team's top three scorers last season, and all are averaging in double figures again through six games this winter.

QUICK HITS FROM HOWARD

- Charia Roberts reached double figures for a third time in the last four games, as she supplied 11 points (4-6 FG, 3-4 FT) and five rebounds.
- Loyola made changes to its starting lineup for this time this season, with Laryn Edwards and Devyne Newman both earning their first starts of the year.
- Edwards led the Greyhounds in assists (4) and steals (3) while also scoring a season-high six points (3-4 FG).
- Lex Therien's 14 points were a new seasonbest, as she hit 6 of 10 field goal attempts. Therien has reached double figures five times in her debut season, including double-double performances against FDU (10 pts, 11 reb) and Hofstra (12 pts, 13 reb).
- Loyola finished with a season-high 48.0 field goal percentage (24 for 50). The Greyhounds hit 14 of 26 shots from the floor (53.8 percent) while outscoring Howard 30-21 in the first half.
- The Bison shot 65.2 percent from the field in the second half, and they hit 9 of 12 field goal attempts during their fourth-quarter rally.
- Loyola held a fourth-quarter lead for a sixth time in seven games to begin the season.
 Three of the Greyhounds' five defeats have been decided by two points.

DIXON LEADING THE OFFENSE

- **Taleah Dixon's** 16 points at Howard were the most by a Loyola player in a game this season. She leads the team in scoring this season (12.7 ppg), reaching double figures in 6 of 7 contests.
- Dixon also paces the Greyhounds in both free throw percentage (86.1, 31-36) and 3-point field goal percentage (41.7, 10-24). She is fourth among Patriot League shooters and 78th nationally in FT%.
- Dixon is one of three team captains for Loyola this season, along with Laryn Edwards and Bri Rozzi.

MOVING UP THE PATRIOT LEAGUE RANKINGS

- Loyola has shown improvement in several areas during the program's first seven games under new head coach **Danielle** O'Banion.
- The Greyhounds are currently fourth among Patriot League schools in both 3-point FG% (33.3) and assists per game (11.9) after ranking last in both categories last winter.
- Loyola is additionally fourth in rebounding margin (+1.6) after finishing ninth out of 10 conference schools in 2020-21, and the program also ranks fourth in scoring defense (61.7 ppg) and free throw percentage (75.6).

STRONG AT THE LINE

- The Greyhounds hit 8 of 10 free throws during Wednesday's setback at Howard, shooting over 70 percent from the line for a sixth time in seven games.
- Taleah Dixon (86.1, 31-36), Bri Rozzi (81.0, 17-21), Charia Roberts (70.8, 17-24) and Lex Therien (68.8, 11-16) are all among the team leaders from the charity stripe.

WORTH NOTING

- Charia Roberts leads Loyola in field goal percentage through seven games, hitting 47.2 percent (25 for 53) of her shots from the floor.
- The Greyhounds have outrebounded their opponent by an overall margin of 166-140 during the past five games. They also have a sizable advantage in free throw attempts (83-57) during those five contests.
- **Bri Rozzi** became the first Greyhound to play an entire game since Jan. 5, 2020 (**Laryn Edwards** vs. Lehigh) during Loyola's victory over UMBC.
- Loyola rallied past the Retrievers after trailing 37-23 early in the third quarter. The program's last win after falling behind by 14+ points in the second half was a 66-60 triumph over Iona back in 2012.
- Loyola's 68-59 OT win over FDU on Nov. 14 was the program's first in overtime since Jan. 2, 2017 at Lafayette. The Greyhounds are now 3-9 in OT dating back to March 4, 2011.

THERIEN NAMED PATRIOT LEAGUE ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

- **Lex Therien** received her first-career Patriot League weekly award last Monday after averaging 12.5 points and 11.0 rebounds per game during a 1-1 week for the Greyhounds.
- Therien contributed a season-high 13 points (6-11 FG) and nine rebounds in a 63-57 win over UMBC on Nov. 17, as Loyola rallied from a second-half 14+ point deficit for the first time since Feb. 10, 2012. Six of her rebounds came on the offensive end to help the Greyhounds finish with a convincing 38-27 advantage on the glass.
- Therien followed that effort with her second double-double in the last three games at Hofstra on Saturday. She hit all four of her free throws and picked up six more offensive rebounds.
- Therien is the program's first Patriot League weekly award winner since Emily McAteer was named Rookie of the Week on Jan. 13, 2020.

FIVE NEWCOMERS JOIN PROGRAM IN 2021-22

- Loyola's 16-member roster includes five freshmen who will be making their collegiate debuts this winter.
- Lex Therien becomes the third Therien sister to compete for the Greyhounds, joining current junior Ava Therien and 2021 graduate Isabella.
- Lex was a two-time All-State performer at Cherokee HS in New Jersey, leading the team to a 92-10 record and ranking third in program history with 1,283 points.
- Therien and fellow freshman Keegan Douglas were named co-South Jersey Players of the Year during their senior high school seasons.
- Douglas totaled 1,624 points at Haddonfield HS while helping the program win three Colonial Conference championships. She was chosen as the conference's Player of the Year in each of her final two seasons.
- Laura Salmerón joins Loyola after playing two seasons in Spain's second division basketball league. Salmerón, who also competed internationally for Spain's U-15 team, was a three-star ESPN recruit who received a 90 scouts grade.
- Jonelle Price was a key contributor at Neumann-Goretti HS in Philadelphia, helping the program win a PIAA Class 3A state title.
- Vanessa Stolstajner joins the Greyhounds as a walk-on. She was a two-time All-State performer at Cromwell HS (CT), winning a Class A state title in 2019.

NEW SEASON, NEW OPPORTUNITY FOR ELEVEN RETURNERS

- Loyola brings back 11 student-athletes, including four starters, from a squad which went 0-12 against Patriot League opponents during the regular season before falling at Bucknell in the quarterfinals of the conference tournament.
- The Patriot League Council of Presidents voted during the Fall of 2020 to
 play only conference games starting in early January. Of the 16 dates on
 Loyola's initial 2020-21 schedule, the Greyhounds only played their originally
 scheduled opponent on four occasions due to a variety of COVID-19 issues at
 opposing schools.
- **Emily McAteer** (9.2 ppg, 5.4 rpg) and **Taleah Dixon** (8.1 ppg, 2.3 rpg), who were both Patriot League All-Rookie Team honorees during their debut collegiate seasons, are Loyola's top returning scorers for the 2021-22 campaign.

PREPPING FOR PATRIOT LEAGUE PLAY

- Saturday's home matchup will be the eighth of 11 non-conference games for the Greyhounds prior to their Patriot League opener against Army on Dec. 30.
- Loyola remains at Reitz Arena to face Morgan State next Wednesday. The nonconference schedule then concludes with trips to Toledo (12/11) and St. Francis Brooklyn (12/23).
- Loyola was ranked ninth out of 10 schools in this year's Patriot League preseason poll. The Greyhounds went 8-22 (5-13 PL) during their last full season of competition in 2019-20.

SMART HOUNDS

- Loyola posted a team grade-point average of 3.35 during the 2020-21 academic year. Kayla Sieper (3.97), Laryn Edwards (3.66), Devyne Newman (3.54) and Bri Rozzi (3.54) all have cumulative GPA's above a 3.50.
- The program has a history of academic excellence, as the Greyhounds were named to the WBCA Division I Academic Top 25 Honor Roll for five-straight seasons from 2016-20.
- Loyola was one of just three schools nationally to crack the top 15 academically in each of those five years.

HEAD COACH DANIELLE O'BANION

- Danielle O'Banion was named the 12th head women's basketball coach at Loyola University Maryland in April, 2021.
- O'Banion brings 20 years of Division I coaching experience to the Greyhounds, most-recently serving her second stint as an assistant at the University of Minnesota over the past three seasons. Her teams have combined for 10 postseason appearances, including five NCAA tournaments and one run to the Final Four.
- Originally from Arlington, Virginia, O'Banion returns to the Mid-Atlantic after coaching stints at Minnesota, Memphis, Kent State and Harvard. A standout recruiter who has brought in four Top-50 classes during her career, she has also held multiple leadership positions within both the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) and Advocates for Athletic Equity (formerly Black Coaches and Administrators).
- O'Banion rejoined Minnesota in 2018 following a two-year stint as associate head coach at Memphis. During the past three seasons with the Golden Gophers, she worked primarily with the post players while also playing a key role in recruiting.
- Originally an assistant at Minnesota from 2002-07, O'Banion's first assistant stint coincided with the best five-year run in team history. The Golden Gophers made four-consecutive NCAA tournaments, advancing to one Final Four (2004) and two Sweet Sixteens (2003, 2005); they also added a WNIT appearance in 2007. O'Banion worked primarily with the backcourt, coaching four All-Big Ten selections and one Kodak All-American (current Minnesota head coach Lindsay Whalen).
- O'Banion then spent four years at Memphis from 2008-12, earning a promotion to associate head coach and recruiting coordinator for the final three seasons. She helped bring in the No. 1-ranked recruiting classes in Conference USA (Top 50 nationally) in each of her first two years on-campus. Those recruits succeeded on the court with Memphis winning 78 games during her four seasons while making three postseason appearances.
- In between her two stops at Memphis, O'Banion spent four seasons as head coach at Kent State. She restored roster stability to the program, signing 17 players overall with four going on to play professionally. O'Banion was also active in fundraising, helping secure the largest-ever financial gift to the program.
- O'Banion was diagnosed with Stage 2 lymphoma cancer midway through her stint at Kent State. She managed to coach every game while going through treatment, and she announced that her cancer was in remission six months after her original diagnosis. O'Banion was presented with the U.S. Basketball Writers Association (USBWA) Pat Summitt Most Courageous Award for women's basketball at the 2016 Final Four.
- A 20-year member of the Women's Basketball Coaches' Association, O'Banion served on the WBCA Board of Directors from 2013-15 and was an Awards Committee member from 2011-12.
 She was also the second woman to be named president of Black Coaches and Administrators, serving in that role in 2011-12 following four years on the BCA Board of Directors.
- O'Banion began her coaching career as an assistant at Harvard in 2001-02, helping the Crimson win the Ivy League and earn an NCAA tournament berth in her lone season with the program.
- As an undergraduate, O'Banion was a four-year letterwinner at Boston College from 1997-2001. She helped guide the Eagles to their first two NCAA tournament appearances in program history, and she was a co-captain and Big East Academic All-Star during her senior season. She graduated from Boston College in 2001 with a bachelor's degree in psychology and Hispanic Studies minor.
- O'Banion grew up in Northern Virginia, and she prepped at Episcopal High School in Alexandria, Virginia where she was a Washington Post All-Met guard for the Maroon.

Meet the Coaching Staff

Courtney Davidson - Assistant Coach/Recruiting Coordinator

- Courtney Davidson joins the Greyhounds after most-recently serving as an assistant coach at Hartford for the past two years. A 2016 WBCA "Thirty Under 30" award recipient, she has also worked on coaching staffs at Youngstown State, Radford and the College of Charleston following a successful playing career at Michigan State.
- Davidson, who will work with Loyola's point guards, has coached eight all-conference, three all-rookie and four all-academic performers during her coaching career.
- As a player, Davidson made 101 appearances for a Michigan State squad which reached three NCAA tournaments (National Runner-Up in 2005, Sweet 16 in 2006, Second Round in 2007) and advanced to the WNIT title game during her senior season in 2008.

Simeon Spurling - Assistant Coach

- Simeon Spurling joins the staff following a three-year stint as video coordinator at UCLA. He was responsible for creating and presenting multiple scouting reports and game plans to staff.
- UCLA made the NCAA tournament during both completed seasons in his tenure, including a Sweet 16 run in 2019, and held a 26-5 record at the time of the 2020 season's cancellation due to COVID-19.
- Prior to joining UCLA, Spurling spent three years as video coordinator for the WNBA's Los Angeles Sparks, where he created video scouting reports for the team and assisted the coaching staff during film sessions and practices.
- Spurling's tenure with the Sparks included a WNBA title in 2017.

Lisa Strack - Assistant Coach

- Lisa Strack brings 11 years of Patriot League experience to the Greyhounds, spending the last seven years as an assistant fat Army following a standout playing career at American.
- Strack was promoted to Army's associate head coach in 2018 after the Black Knights posted winning seasons in each of her first four years on staff, including three 20-win seasons, two postseason appearances and a Patriot League championship in 2016.
- As an undergrad, Strack was named Patriot League Player of the Year and American's Female Athlete of the Year during her senior season in 2012. She led American to a 14-0 regular season conference record and a third WNIT appearance in four years that winter.

Annalese Lamke - Director of Basketball Operations

- Annalese Lamke spent the previous two seasons as a graduate assistant at Bethel University after playing for O'Banion as an undergrad at Minnesota. Lamke helped Bethel finish a program-best 26-2 during the 2019-20 season, winning an MIAC title to clinch an automatic spot in the NCAA Division III tournament.
- Lamke was a three-time Academic All-Big Ten selection who was honored as a Big Ten Distinguished Scholar in 2019. She appeared in 88 games overall for Minnesota, averaging 7.7 points and 5.0 rebounds per game while serving as a team captain during her senior season.
