THE MATCHUP

- Loyola women's basketball hits the road for its final two non-conference games of the season, beginning with a weekend trip to Ohio to take on Toledo.

LAST TIME OUT

- Laura Salmerón** scored 15 of her season-high 18 points in the second half, but a large early deficit was too much for Loyola to overcome in a 64-55 defeat to Morgan State on Wednesday.
- The Greyhounds rallied to take the lead in the third quarter after trailing 26-6 early on.
- The visiting Bears (6-4), though, closed the game on a 13-4 run to hold on for their sixth-consecutive victory.
- Lex Therien** contributed eight points and 13 boards, **Taleah Dixon** finished with nine points and **Bri Rozzi** dished out a career-high six assists for Loyola.
- Dahnye Redd led Morgan State with 15 points, while Ashia McCalla supplied 14 points and six rebounds.
- The two Baltimore schools were facing each other for the first time since the 1984-85 season.

BREAKOUT HALF FOR SALMERÓN



- Laura Salmerón** was on fire during the final 20 minutes on Wednesday, hitting 6 of 7 field goal attempts overall and going 3 for 4 from 3-point range.
- Salmerón played the entire second half while surpassing her previous scoring high of 15, which was set in a 68-59 OT victory over Fairleigh Dickinson on November 14.
- For the year, Salmerón has started 8 of 9 games in her debut collegiate season. She has reached double figures in four of those contests, she leads the team in minutes played (33.3 per game), and she ranks tied for second in assists (19).

LOOKING AHEAD

- The Greyhounds conclude their non-conference schedule with a 2 p.m. matchup at St. Francis Brooklyn on Thursday, Dec. 23.
- Patriot League play begins with a 7 p.m. home game against Army West Point on Dec. 30.

SERIES HISTORY

- This will be just the second meeting between the two teams.
- Toledo earned a 61-45 victory during the only previous matchup, a neutral-site contest played at Vanderbilt on Nov. 28, 1999.
- This will be Loyola's first game against a MAC opponent since Nov. 16, 2001, when the Greyhounds opened the regular season with a 69-57 victory at Akron.

SCOUTING TOLEDO

- The Rockets (4-2) are coming off a dominant 86-33 home victory over St. Francis (Pa.) on Wednesday. Toledo is 2-0 at home this season, also topping Wright State by a 73-56 final on Nov. 13.
- Jr. G/F Quinesha Lockett, a third team All-MAC selection last season, is ranked 17th in Division I in points per game (20.3), and she is 22nd nationally in 3's per game (3.0). She scored 20+ points in each of Toledo's first four contests on the year.
- Jr. G Sophia Wiard leads the MAC and ranks 17th in Division I in assist to turnover ratio (3.11).
- Toledo was ranked eighth out of 12 schools in the 2021-22 MAC Preseason poll. The Rockets finished last season with an overall record of 12-12 (8-12 MAC).

QUICK HITS FROM MORGAN STATE

- Bri Rozzi's** six assists were the most by a Loyola player this season. Her previous career best was five, a mark she had reached on two separate occasions.
- Lex Therien's** 13 rebounds matched a season high, as she grabbed double-digit boards for a fourth time on the year.
- The Greyhounds out-rebounded their opponent (35-29) for a fifth time in the last seven games.
- Making her third-consecutive start, **Devynne Newman** set new season highs in minutes played (28), points (7) and rebounds (5). She his 3 of 6 shots from the field.
- The Greyhounds' 15 assists tied a season best, though their 22 turnovers were also a new season high.
- Ava Therien**, making her second appearance of the season, contributed a season-high four points (1-1 FG, 2-2 FT) in seven minutes off the bench.
- Loyola saw a three-game winning streak at Reitz Arena come to an end. The Greyhounds are now 3-2 at home this season.

THERIEN EARNS SECOND ROOKIE OF THE WEEK AWARD

- **Lex Therien** was announced as the Patriot League's top rookie for a second time in the last three weeks on Monday. She averaged 13.0 points and 7.5 rebounds during a 1-1 week for the Greyhounds, scoring in double figures in both contests.
- Therien reached double figures for a sixth time in eight games during Saturday's 56-55 win over Mount St. Mary's, and she scored a season-high 14 points (6-10 FG) in last Wednesday's two-point loss at Howard.
- Therien has grabbed 6+ rebounds in every contest this season. She ranks third in the Patriot League in rebounds per game (9.7) and posted double-doubles during matchups against Fairleigh Dickinson (Nov. 14) and Hofstra (Nov. 20).

DIXON LEADING THE OFFENSE

- **Taleah Dixon** has reached double figures in 7 of 9 games this season. She scored a season-high 23 points (8-16 FG, 3-7 3FG) in last Saturday's win over the Mount.
- Dixon's 13.4 points per game lead Loyola and are ranked ninth overall in the Patriot League.
- Dixon also paces the Greyhounds in both free throw percentage (86.4, 38-44) and 3-point FG percentage (40.6, 13-32). She is fourth among Patriot League shooters and 65th nationally in FT%.
- Dixon is one of three team captains for Loyola this season, along with **Laryn Edwards** and **Bri Rozzi**.

BALANCED ATTACK

- Loyola's four leading scorers are all averaging between 9.7 and 13.4 points per game (**Taleah Dixon** - 13.4, **Lex Therien** - 10.1, **Bri Rozzi** - 10.0, **Laura Salmerón** - 9.7), and **Charia Roberts** is close behind at 8.3 points per contest.
- Those five players have combined to score in double figures 26 times on the year.

DOWN TO THE WIRE

- Saturday's matchup against the Mount was the sixth time in nine contests this season that Loyola has been in a one-possession game during the final minute of regulation.
- The Greyhounds are now 3-3 in those contests after previously managing comeback victories over FDU (68-59, OT) and UMBC (63-57).
- Loyola is 1-3 in games decided by three points or fewer following previous last-second defeats to George Mason (53-51), Hofstra (55-53) and Howard (61-59).
- The Greyhounds have been tied or led in the fourth quarter in eight of nine games this season under first year head coach **Danielle O'Banion**.

WORTH NOTING

- With her 23 points last Saturday, **Taleah Dixon** became the first Greyhound to score 20+ points in a game since Feb. 13, 2021 (**Isabella Therien** - 21 pts vs. Navy).
- Dixon totaled 20+ points for the fourth time in her collegiate career, and the first time since she had a career-best 26 during the 2019 Patriot League quarterfinals at Bucknell.
- **Bri Rozzi** has played all 40 minutes twice this season (12/4 vs. Mount St. Mary's, 11/17 vs. UMBC).
- **Charia Roberts** leads Loyola in FG percentage through eight games, hitting 43.5 percent (27 for 62) of her shots from the floor.
- Loyola's 63-57 win over UMBC on Nov. 17 was the program's first victory after trailing by 14+ points in the second half since Feb. 10, 2012 vs. Iona (66-60).
- Loyola's overtime victory over FDU on Nov. 14 was the program's first in extra time since Jan. 2, 2017 at Lafayette. The Greyhounds are now 3-9 in OT dating back to March 4, 2011.

FOUR NEWCOMERS JOIN PROGRAM IN 2021-22

- Loyola's 15-member roster includes four freshmen who will be making their collegiate debuts this winter.
- Lex Therien** becomes the third Therien sister to compete for the Greyhounds, joining current junior **Ava Therien** and 2021 graduate Isabella.
- Lex was a two-time All-State performer at Cherokee HS in New Jersey, leading the team to a 92-10 record and ranking third in program history with 1,283 points.
- Therien and fellow freshman **Keegan Douglas** were named co-South Jersey Players of the Year during their senior high school seasons.
- Douglas totaled 1,624 points at Haddonfield HS while helping the program win three Colonial Conference championships. She was chosen as the conference's Player of the Year in each of her final two seasons.
- Laura Salmerón** joins Loyola after playing two seasons in Spain's second division basketball league. Salmerón, who also competed internationally for Spain's U-15 team, was a three-star ESPN recruit who received a 90 scouts grade.
- Jonelle Price** was a key contributor at Neumann-Goretti HS in Philadelphia, helping the program win a PIAA Class 3A state title.

NEW SEASON, NEW OPPORTUNITY FOR ELEVEN RETURNERS

- Loyola brings back 11 student-athletes, including four starters, from a squad which went 0-12 against Patriot League opponents during the regular season before falling at Bucknell in the quarterfinals of the conference tournament.
- The Patriot League Council of Presidents voted during the Fall of 2020 to play only conference games starting in early January. Of the 16 dates on Loyola's initial 2020-21 schedule, the Greyhounds only played their originally scheduled opponent on four occasions due to a variety of COVID-19 issues at opposing schools.
- Emily McAteer** (9.2 ppg, 5.4 rpg) and **Taleah Dixon** (8.1 ppg, 2.3 rpg), who were both Patriot League All-Rookie Team honorees during their debut collegiate seasons, are Loyola's top returning scorers for the 2021-22 campaign.

PREPPING FOR PATRIOT LEAGUE PLAY

- Wednesday's home matchup will be the ninth of 11 non-conference games for the Greyhounds prior to their Patriot League opener against Army on Dec. 30.
- The non-conference schedule concludes with trips to Toledo (12/11) and St. Francis Brooklyn (12/23).
- Loyola was ranked ninth out of 10 schools in this year's Patriot League pre-season poll. The Greyhounds went 8-22 (5-13 PL) during their last full season of competition in 2019-20.

SMART HOUNDS

- Loyola posted a team grade-point average of 3.35 during the 2020-21 academic year. **Kayla Sieper** (3.97), **Laryn Edwards** (3.66), **Devyne Newman** (3.54) and **Bri Rozzi** (3.54) all have cumulative GPA's above a 3.50.
- The program has a history of academic excellence, as the Greyhounds were named to the WBCA Division I Academic Top 25 Honor Roll for five-straight seasons from 2016-20.
- Loyola was one of just three schools nationally to crack the top 15 academically in each of those five years.

Patriot League Preseason Player of the Year

Jade Edwards, American

HEAD COACH DANIELLE O'BANION

- **Danielle O'Banion** was named the 12th head women's basketball coach at Loyola University Maryland in April, 2021.
- O'Banion brings 20 years of Division I coaching experience to the Greyhounds, most-recently serving her second stint as an assistant at the University of Minnesota over the past three seasons. Her teams have combined for 10 postseason appearances, including five NCAA tournaments and one run to the Final Four.
- Originally from Arlington, Virginia, O'Banion returns to the Mid-Atlantic after coaching stints at Minnesota, Memphis, Kent State and Harvard. A standout recruiter who has brought in four Top-50 classes during her career, she has also held multiple leadership positions within both the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) and Advocates for Athletic Equity (formerly Black Coaches and Administrators).
- O'Banion rejoined Minnesota in 2018 following a two-year stint as associate head coach at Memphis. During the past three seasons with the Golden Gophers, she worked primarily with the post players while also playing a key role in recruiting.
- Originally an assistant at Minnesota from 2002-07, O'Banion's first assistant stint coincided with the best five-year run in team history. The Golden Gophers made four-consecutive NCAA tournaments, advancing to one Final Four (2004) and two Sweet Sixteens (2003, 2005); they also added a WNIT appearance in 2007. O'Banion worked primarily with the backcourt, coaching four All-Big Ten selections and one Kodak All-American (current Minnesota head coach Lindsay Whalen).
- O'Banion then spent four years at Memphis from 2008-12, earning a promotion to associate head coach and recruiting coordinator for the final three seasons. She helped bring in the No. 1-ranked recruiting classes in Conference USA (Top 50 nationally) in each of her first two years on-campus. Those recruits succeeded on the court with Memphis winning 78 games during her four seasons while making three postseason appearances.
- In between her two stops at Memphis, O'Banion spent four seasons as head coach at Kent State. She restored roster stability to the program, signing 17 players overall with four going on to play professionally. O'Banion was also active in fundraising, helping secure the largest-ever financial gift to the program.
- O'Banion was diagnosed with Stage 2 lymphoma cancer midway through her stint at Kent State. She managed to coach every game while going through treatment, and she announced that her cancer was in remission six months after her original diagnosis. O'Banion was presented with the U.S. Basketball Writers Association (USBWA) Pat Summitt Most Courageous Award for women's basketball at the 2016 Final Four.
- A 20-year member of the Women's Basketball Coaches' Association, O'Banion served on the WBCA Board of Directors from 2013-15 and was an Awards Committee member from 2011-12. She was also the second woman to be named president of Black Coaches and Administrators, serving in that role in 2011-12 following four years on the BCA Board of Directors.
- O'Banion began her coaching career as an assistant at Harvard in 2001-02, helping the Crimson win the Ivy League and earn an NCAA tournament berth in her lone season with the program.
- As an undergraduate, O'Banion was a four-year letterwinner at Boston College from 1997-2001. She helped guide the Eagles to their first two NCAA tournament appearances in program history, and she was a co-captain and Big East Academic All-Star during her senior season. She graduated from Boston College in 2001 with a bachelor's degree in psychology and Hispanic Studies minor.
- O'Banion grew up in Northern Virginia, and she prepped at Episcopal High School in Alexandria, Virginia where she was a Washington Post All-Met guard for the Maroon.

Meet the Coaching Staff

Courtney Davidson - Assistant Coach/Recruiting Coordinator

- Courtney Davidson joins the Greyhounds after most-recently serving as an assistant coach at Hartford for the past two years. A 2016 WBCA "Thirty Under 30" award recipient, she has also worked on coaching staffs at Youngstown State, Radford and the College of Charleston following a successful playing career at Michigan State.
- Davidson, who will work with Loyola's point guards, has coached eight all-conference, three all-rookie and four all-academic performers during her coaching career.
- As a player, Davidson made 101 appearances for a Michigan State squad which reached three NCAA tournaments (National Runner-Up in 2005, Sweet 16 in 2006, Second Round in 2007) and advanced to the WNIT title game during her senior season in 2008.

Simeon Spurling - Assistant Coach

- Simeon Spurling joins the staff following a three-year stint as video coordinator at UCLA. He was responsible for creating and presenting multiple scouting reports and game plans to staff.
- UCLA made the NCAA tournament during both completed seasons in his tenure, including a Sweet 16 run in 2019, and held a 26-5 record at the time of the 2020 season's cancellation due to COVID-19.
- Prior to joining UCLA, Spurling spent three years as video coordinator for the WNBA's Los Angeles Sparks, where he created video scouting reports for the team and assisted the coaching staff during film sessions and practices.
- Spurling's tenure with the Sparks included a WNBA title in 2017.

Lisa Strack - Assistant Coach

- Lisa Strack brings 11 years of Patriot League experience to the Greyhounds, spending the last seven years as an assistant at Army following a standout playing career at American.
- Strack was promoted to Army's associate head coach in 2018 after the Black Knights posted winning seasons in each of her first four years on staff, including three 20-win seasons, two postseason appearances and a Patriot League championship in 2016.
- As an undergrad, Strack was named Patriot League Player of the Year and American's Female Athlete of the Year during her senior season in 2012. She led American to a 14-0 regular season conference record and a third WNIT appearance in four years that winter.

Annalese Lamke - Director of Basketball Operations

- Annalese Lamke spent the previous two seasons as a graduate assistant at Bethel University after playing for O'Banion as an undergrad at Minnesota. Lamke helped Bethel finish a program-best 26-2 during the 2019-20 season, winning an MIAC title to clinch an automatic spot in the NCAA Division III tournament.
- Lamke was a three-time Academic All-Big Ten selection who was honored as a Big Ten Distinguished Scholar in 2019. She appeared in 88 games overall for Minnesota, averaging 7.7 points and 5.0 rebounds per game while serving as a team captain during her senior season.
