### THE MATCHUP

- Loyola women's basketball concludes a three-game homestand on Wednesday, hosting local rivals UMBC for the first time in five years.
- The Greyhounds will be looking for their first two-game winning steak since topping Monmouth (64-48, Dec. 20) and Dartmouth (72-56, Dec. 31) midway through the 2019-20 season.

### **LAST TIME OUT**

- Laura Salmerón scored 15 points to lead four Loyola players in double figures, and Charia Roberts made several key plays late in the fourth quarter and overtime of a 68-59 victory for the Greyhounds over Fairleigh Dickinson on Sunday.
- Loyola earned its first win under new head coach Danielle O'Banion, and the first win
  overall for the program since Feb. 26, 2020. Lex Therien (10 points, 11 rebounds, four
  steals) recorded her first collegiate double-double, while Taleah Dixon (14 points) and Bri
  Rozzi (12 points, five rebounds) also finished in double figures.
- The Greyhounds ended the fourth quarter on a 10-2 run, and they outscored the Knights (0-2) by a 13-4 margin in extra time to clinch their first overtime victory since Jan. 2, 2017 at Lafayette.

### **ROBERTS DELIVERS IN CRUNCH TIME**

- Charia Roberts nearly secured a victory for Loyola without requiring overtime, as she
  converted a tough basket inside to put the Greyhounds in front with 7.8 seconds remaining in regulation.
- After FDU rallied to tie the score, Roberts completed a 3-point play early in overtime which gave the home side a two-possession lead at 60-55.
- Loyola was still up by five with 1:22 left when she drew a key charge on defense which led to FDU's No. 2 leading scorer Chloe Wilson fouling out of the game.
- Roberts finished with nine points and five rebounds in 35 minutes of game action. She is averaging 9.3 points and 6.3 boards three games into her sophomore season.

### **SERIES HISTORY**

- Loyola leads 27-13 in a series which dates back to 1973.
- The teams have faced off six times in the last decade, which each side posting three victories during that span.
- The Greyhounds posted a 70-65 road victory in the last meeting on Dec. 10, 2016. A pair of 2020 graduates in Alexis Gray (17 pts, 5-10 3FG) and Stephanie Karcz (13 pts, 16 reb) led the way for Loyola.

### **SCOUTING UMBC**

- The Retrievers have split their first two games this season, falling 61-52 at Colgate on Saturday after beginning the year with a 79-33 win over Division III Gettysburg.
- Danae Marquez (4-7 FG, 3-4 3FG) led the offense with 11 points off the bench at Colgate. UMBC was limited to 31 points in the first three quarters over the weekend.
- The Retrievers were limited to eight games during the COVIDimpacted 2020-21 campaign. They played their final game on Jan. 4 and officially discontinued the season on Jan. 29.
- Eight new players, including six transfers, are included in this year's 11-player roster. Returners include two former third team All-America East performers in Janee'a Summers and Onome-Juliet Esadah.
- UMBC went 10-18 (6-10) during its last full season in 2019-20.

### **QUICK NOTES FROM FDU**

- Loyola shot over 75 percent from the free throw line for a third-straight game to begin the season (78.3%, 18-23).
- **Taleah Dixon** hit 8 of 10 free throw attempts, and she is shooting 88.9 percent (16-18) from the charity stripe through three games.
- Laura Salmerón's team-high 15 points included a 6 for 9 shooting performance from the field. She was recognized on Monday as an honorable mention selection for the Patriot League's Rookie of the Week.
- Lex Therien's double-double (10 points, 11 rebounds) was the program's first since her older sister Isabella totaled 16 points and 11 boards in last year's Patriot League quarterfinal at Bucknell. She played a team-high 39 minutes in Sunday's victory.
- The Greyhounds went to overtime for the first time since Jan. 11, 2020 at Lafayette. They are now 3-9 in OT dating back to March 4, 2011.
- **Bri Rozzi's** 12 points were her most in a game since she scored a career-high 13 vs. Holy Cross on Jan. 2, 2020. She also led the team in +/- (+17) and fouls drawn (8).
- Loyola snapped an 18-game losing overall dating back to a 64-54 home win over Navy on Feb. 26, 2020.

### **DOWN TO THE WIRE**

- Loyola has had fourth quarter leads in each of its first three games this season, with the Greyhounds breaking through for their first victory against Fairleigh Dickinson on Sunday.
- After trailing 44-34 through three quarters of Friday's home opener vs. George Mason, Loyola used a 17-3 run to jump ahead 51-47 with 2:18 remaining.
- The Patriots would recover to score the game's final six points, including a game-winning putback with five seconds left to escape with a 53-51 win.
- The Greyhounds also led by as many as 19 points in the second half
  of their season opener at Niagara. Loyola took a 62-60 advantage
  into the fourth quarter of that contest before the Purple Eagles
  pulled away late to hand the visitors an 81-71 setback.

### STRONG START FROM BEYOND THE ARC

- Loyola hit 8 of 14 attempts from 3-point range in last Tuesday's season opener at Niagara. That 57.1 percent shooting output was the program's best since Jan. 24, 2018 against Lehigh (60.0%, 6-10)
- Taleah Dixon (3-5 3FG) led the way from long distance, while Bri Rozzi (2-4 3FG) and Caramina Tañedo (2-2 3FG) also hit a pair of 3-point attempts.
- The Greyhounds' 71 overall points were the program's most in a game since Jan. 8, 2019.

### PREPPING FOR PATRIOT LEAGUE PLAY

- Wednesday's home matchup will be the third of 11 non-conference games for the Greyhounds prior to their Patriot League opener against Army on Dec. 30.
- Five of those contests will take place at Reitz Arena. After this
  week's homestand, Loyola hits the road for three straight games
  before hosting Mount St. Mary's (12/4) and Morgan State (12/8) in
  early December.
- Loyola was ranked ninth out of 10 schools in this year's Patriot League preseason poll. The Greyhounds went 8-22 (5-13 PL) during their last full season of competition in 2019-20.

### **FIVE NEWCOMERS JOIN PROGRAM IN 2021-22**

- Loyola's 16-member roster includes five freshmen who will be making their collegiate debuts this winter.
- Lex Therien becomes the third Therien sister to compete for the Greyhounds, joining current junior Ava Therien and 2021 graduate Isabella.
- Lex was a two-time All-State performer at Cherokee HS in New Jersey, leading the team to a 92-10 record and ranking third in program history with 1,283 points.
- Therien and fellow freshman Keegan Douglas were named co-South Jersey Players of the Year during their senior high school seasons.
- Douglas totaled 1,624 points at Haddonfield HS while helping the program win three Colonial Conference championships. She was chosen as the conference's Player of the Year in each of her final two seasons.
- Laura Salmerón joins Loyola after playing two seasons in Spain's second division basketball league. Salmerón, who also competed internationally for Spain's U-15 team, was a three-star ESPN recruit who received a 90 scouts grade.
- Jonelle Price was a key contributor at Neumann-Goretti HS in Philadelphia, helping the program win a PIAA Class 3A state title.
- Vanessa Stolstajner joins the Greyhounds as a walk-on. She was a two-time All-State performer at Cromwell HS in Connecticut, winning a Class A state title in 2019.

### **SENIOR LEADERS**

- Loyola's three seniors this season, Taleah Dixon, Laryn Edwards and Devyne Newman, have all been key contributors during their time with the program.
- Dixon's 414 career points are the most on the active roster. She ranked third among Patriot League freshmen in scoring at 9.7 ppg, reaching double figures in 15 of 28 appearances in 2018-19. After missing the following season due to injury, Dixon started all 13 games last winter. She led Loyola with 29 assists and was third on the team with 8.1 points per game.
- Edwards battled through injuries to appear in 12 games as a junior, tying for the team lead with 14 steals. She was Loyola's starting point guard in 2019-20, leading the Greyhounds in 3-point FG% (34.9, 22-63) and ranking second in both assists (66) and steals (34).
- Newman earned starts in 9 of 11 appearances last season after joining the program as a transfer from St. Joseph's. She reached double figures on three occasions and shot 44.9 percent on 2-point field goal attempts.

### **NEW SEASON, NEW OPPORTUNITY FOR ELEVEN RETURNERS**

- Loyola brings back 11 student-athletes, including four starters, from a squad which went 0-12 against Patriot League opponents during the regular season before falling at top-seeded Bucknell in the quarterfinals of the conference tournament
- The Patriot League Council of Presidents voted during the Fall of 2020 to
  play only conference games starting in early January. Of the 16 dates on
  Loyola's initial 2020-21 schedule, the Greyhounds only played their originally
  scheduled opponent on four occasions due to a variety of COVID-19 issues at
  opposing schools.
- Emily McAteer (9.2 ppg, 5.4 rpg) and Taleah Dixon (8.1 ppg, 2.3 rpg), who
  were both Patriot League All-Rookie Team honorees during their debut collegiate seasons, are Loyola's top returning scorers for the 2021-22 campaign.

### **QUICK NOTES**

- Emily McAteer was one of two Greyhounds, along with Dixon to start every game last season. She scored 10+ points in 7 of 13 appearances and also led the team with 12 blocks.
- **Charia Roberts** finished her freshman season strong last winter, contributing 7+ points and 5+ rebounds in each of her final three games. Roberts led Loyola's rookies in both scoring (3.8 ppg) and rebounding (3.5 rpg) last winter.
- Taleah Dixon (79.2%, 114-144), Laryn Edwards (76.3%, 58-76) and Bri Rozzi (78.6%, 44-56) have all shot over 75% from the free throw line in their careers. As a team, Loyola ranked fourth in the Patriot League from the charity stripe last winter at 73.2 percent.

### **SMART HOUNDS**

- Loyola posted a team grade-point average of 3.35 during the 2020-21 academic year. Kayla Sieper (3.97), Laryn Edwards (3.66), Devyne Newman (3.54) and Bri Rozzi (3.54) all have cumulative GPA's above a 3.50.
- The program has a history of academic excellence, as the Greyhounds were named to the WBCA Division I Academic Top 25 Honor Roll for five-straight seasons from 2016-20.
- Loyola was one of just three schools nationally to crack the top 15 academically in each of those five years.

### **HEAD COACH DANIELLE O'BANION**

- Danielle O'Banion was named the 12th head women's basketball coach at Loyola University Maryland in April, 2021.
- O'Banion brings 20 years of Division I coaching experience to the Greyhounds, most-recently serving her second stint as an assistant at the University of Minnesota over the past three seasons. Her teams have combined for 10 postseason appearances, including five NCAA tournaments and one run to the Final Four.
- Originally from Arlington, Virginia, O'Banion returns to the Mid-Atlantic after coaching stints at Minnesota, Memphis, Kent State and Harvard. A standout recruiter who has brought in four Top-50 classes during her career, she has also held multiple leadership positions within both the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) and Advocates for Athletic Equity (formerly Black Coaches and Administrators).
- O'Banion rejoined Minnesota in 2018 following a two-year stint as associate head coach at Memphis. During the past three seasons with the Golden Gophers, she worked primarily with the post players while also playing a key role in recruiting.
- Originally an assistant at Minnesota from 2002-07, O'Banion's
  first assistant stint coincided with the best five-year run in team
  history. The Golden Gophers made four-consecutive NCAA tournaments, advancing to one Final Four (2004) and two Sweet
  Sixteens (2003, 2005); they also added a WNIT appearance in
  2007. O'Banion worked primarily with the backcourt, coaching
  four All-Big Ten selections and one Kodak All-American (current
  Minnesota head coach Lindsay Whalen).
- O'Banion then spent four years at Memphis from 2008-12, earning a promotion to associate head coach and recruiting coordinator for the final three seasons. She helped bring in the No. 1-ranked recruiting classes in Conference USA (Top 50 nationally) in each of her first two years on-campus. Those recruits succeeded on the court with Memphis winning 78 games during her four seasons while making three postseason appearances.
- In between her two stops at Memphis, O'Banion spent four seasons as head coach at Kent State. She restored roster stability to the program, signing 17 players overall with four going on to play professionally. O'Banion was also active in fundraising, helping secure the largest-ever financial gift to the program.
- O'Banion was diagnosed with Stage 2 lymphoma cancer midway through her stint at Kent State. She managed to coach every game while going through treatment, and she announced that her cancer was in remission six months after her original diagnosis. O'Banion was presented with the U.S. Basketball Writers Association (USBWA) Pat Summitt Most Courageous Award for women's basketball at the 2016 Final Four.
- A 20-year member of the Women's Basketball Coaches' Association, O'Banion served on the WBCA Board of Directors from 2013-15 and was an Awards Committee member from 2011-12.
   She was also the second woman to be named president of Black Coaches and Administrators, serving in that role in 2011-12 following four years on the BCA Board of Directors.
- O'Banion began her coaching career as an assistant at Harvard in 2001-02, helping the Crimson win the Ivy League and earn an NCAA tournament berth in her lone season with the program.
- As an undergraduate, O'Banion was a four-year letterwinner at Boston College from 1997-2001. She helped guide the Eagles to their first two NCAA tournament appearances in program history, and she was a co-captain and Big East Academic All-Star during her senior season. She graduated from Boston College in 2001 with a bachelor's degree in psychology and Hispanic Studies minor.
- O'Banion grew up in Northern Virginia, and she prepped at Episcopal High School in Alexandria, Virginia where she was a Washington Post All-Met guard for the Maroon.

### **Meet the Coaching Staff**

### **Courtney Davidson - Assistant Coach/Recruiting Coordinator**

- Courtney Davidson joins the Greyhounds after most-recently serving as an assistant coach at Hartford for the past two years. A 2016 WBCA "Thirty Under 30" award recipient, she has also worked on coaching staffs at Youngstown State, Radford and the College of Charleston following a successful playing career at Michigan State.
- Davidson, who will work with Loyola's point guards, has coached eight all-conference, three all-rookie and four all-academic performers during her coaching career.
- As a player, Davidson made 101 appearances for a Michigan State squad which reached three NCAA tournaments (National Runner-Up in 2005, Sweet 16 in 2006, Second Round in 2007) and advanced to the WNIT title game during her senior season in 2008.

### **Simeon Spurling - Assistant Coach**

- Simeon Spurling joins the staff following a three-year stint as video coordinator at UCLA. He was responsible for creating and presenting multiple scouting reports and game plans to staff.
- UCLA made the NCAA tournament during both completed seasons in his tenure, including a Sweet 16 run in 2019, and held a 26-5 record at the time of the 2020 season's cancellation due to COVID-19.
- Prior to joining UCLA, Spurling spent three years as video coordinator for the WNBA's Los Angeles Sparks, where he created video scouting reports for the team and assisted the coaching staff during film sessions and practices.
- Spurling's tenure with the Sparks included a WNBA title in 2017.

### Lisa Strack - Assistant Coach

- Lisa Strack brings 11 years of Patriot League experience to the Greyhounds, spending the last seven years as an assistant fat Army following a standout playing career at American.
- Strack was promoted to Army's associate head coach in 2018 after the Black Knights posted winning seasons in each of her first four years on staff, including three 20-win seasons, two postseason appearances and a Patriot League championship in 2016.
- As an undergrad, Strack was named Patriot League Player of the Year and American's Female Athlete of the Year during her senior season in 2012. She led American to a 14-0 regular season conference record and a third WNIT appearance in four years that winter.

### **Annalese Lamke - Director of Basketball Operations**

- Annalese Lamke spent the previous two seasons as a graduate assistant at Bethel University after playing for O'Banion as an undergrad at Minnesota. Lamke helped Bethel finish a program-best 26-2 during the 2019-20 season, winning an MIAC title to clinch an automatic spot in the NCAA Division III tournament.
- Lamke was a three-time Academic All-Big Ten selection who was honored as a Big Ten Distinguished Scholar in 2019. She appeared in 88 games overall for Minnesota, averaging 7.7 points and 5.0 rebounds per game while serving as a team captain during her senior season.
