THE MATCHUP

 Loyola, which is ranked No. 12 in the latest IWLCA coaches' poll and #10 in the Inside Lacrosse media poll, heads to #4/3 Florida for its first road game of the season on Saturday.

LAST TIME OUT

- So. M Jillian Wilson scored four goals for a second-straight game, and Jr. A Livy
 Rosenzweig added two goals and three assists in a 14-10 victory for Loyola over Towson on Wednesday.
- **Kaitlyn Larsson** registered 10 saves in goal for the Greyhounds, who used an extended 12-3 run in the middle stages of the contest to take control.
- Wilson (6) and So. D **Katie Detwiler** (5) won 11 of Loyola's draws, with Detwiler also adding three ground balls and her first collegiate assist.
- Rosenzweig's five-point game was the 28th of her career. She now has 229 points (105 G, 124 A), moving past Rita Ciletti (1983-86) up to No. 8 all-time in program history.

QUICK NOTES

- The Greyhounds are projected to top the Patriot League standings for a seventh-consecutive season since joining the conference prior to the 2014 campaign.
- Loyola went 16-5 (9-0) last spring, winning its fourth Patriot League postseason championship in six seasons and advancing to the NCAA tournament for an eighth time in the last nine years.
- Seven opponents on Loyola's schedule were ranked in the IWLCA's preseason poll.
- **Livy Rosenzweig** became the first Greyhound to achieve first team IWLCA All-America status since 2012 last season after breaking her own school record in points (116, 46 G, 70 A) and also setting a new program mark in assists.
- Loyola led Division I in both assists per game (9.4) and shot percentage (51.3) in 2019, ranked seventh nationally in scoring margin (+6.8) and ninth in goals per game (15.9).
- Loyola holds an overall mark of 155-66 (79-12 conference) in 11+ seasons under head coach **Jen Adams**, posting winning records every year during her tenure.
- Adams has been named Patriot League Coach of the Year in five of Loyola's six seasons in the conference, including each of the last four years.

SERIES HISTORY

- Florida leads 6-1 in a series which began in 2013 and has continued every year since.
- The Greyhounds knocked off the Gators for the first time last season, as Livy Rosenzweig (4 G, 1 A) and Jr. M Sam Fiedler (3 G, 2 A) each had five points during a 15-12 win at Ridley Athletic Complex over then-No. 5 Florida on Feb. 23.
- The Gators have won all four meetings in Gainesville, including a 17-16 overtime triumph during Loyola's last trip south on Feb. 25, 2018.

SCOUTING FLORIDA

- The Gators (2-0) are coming off a 15-14 victory at defending national champions Maryland last Saturday, as they snapped an 86-game home winning for the Terrapins which dated back to 2012.
- It was also Florida's first win over the top team in the IWLCA rankings since April 12, 2012.
- Jr. M Shannon Kavanagh scored a career-high eight goals, including the game winner with 49 seconds left. A 2019 second team IWLCA All-American, she leads DI with 12 goals overall on the year.
- Florida went 14-7 (5-0) last season, winning the AAC Championship before falling 15-11 to North Carolina in the second round of the NCAA tournament.
- Kavanagh and Sr. D Kara Trombetta were both named to the 2020 Tewaaraton Award Watch List last week.

HOME SWEET HOME

- With Wednesday's victory over Towson, Loyola has now won 12 consecutive games at Ridley Athletic Complex.
- The Greyhounds have won all 12 contests by at least three goals, and six of the 12 victories have come against nationally-ranked opposition (Navy 2x, Florida, Penn State, Georgetown, Johns Hopkins).
- Loyola is 74-22 overall at home since its first contest at Ridley on March 16, 2010.

OFFENSIVE SURGE OVERCOMES SLOW START

- Loyola was held off the scoreboard for over 20 minutes to start Wednesday's game against Towson, with the Greyhounds trailing 2-0 with under nine minutes left in the opening half.
- A Livy Rosenzweig goal at the 8:39 mark began a 7-0 run which stretched into the second half. Fr. A Sydney Foster's first collegiate strike ultimately capped off a 12-3 stretch with 6:02 remaining in regulation.
- Loyola has scored 10+ goals in 17-straight games dating back to last March.

DEPTH ON DISPLAY

- Eight different Greyhounds accounted for Loyola's 14 goals on Wednesday, with Jillian Wilson (4), Livy Rosenzweig (2), Jr. M Elli Kluegel, Fr. A Emily Wills (2) all scoring multiple times.
- Sr. A Caitlyn Gunn provided a big lift off the bench, as her fourth career goal
 with 14:52 left in regulation gave Loyola an 8-5 lead and halted a 3-0 Towson
 run. Gunn's strike began a 5-0 stretch for the Greyhounds to put the game out
 of reach.

ROSENZWEIG MOVING UP PROGRAM RECORD BOOK

- **Livy Rosenzweig** holds school records in single-season points (116) and assists (70) and single-game assists (8).
- She moved up to No. 3 all-time at Loyola in both assists (124) and draw controls (184) during last Saturday's 16-7 victory over Johns Hopkins.
- Rosenzweig is 25 assists away from surpassing Annie Thomas' school-record of 148. She also ranks sixth in Patriot League history, and is seven away from moving past former teammate Hannah Powers into the top five.
- Rosenzweig has recorded points in 43 of 44 collegiate games, including each
 of the last 36 contests.

WILSON PICKS UP WHERE SHE LEFT OFF

- Jillian Wilson led all Loyola freshmen with 37 points (29 G, 8 A) in her debut season last spring, and she has supplied four goals and six draw controls in each of Loyola's first two contests in 2020.
- Wilson had three goals during Loyola's decisive 7-0 run which put the home side in front for good against Towson on Wednesday.

PATRIOT LEAGUE WEEKLY AWARD WINNERS

- Loyola accounted for three of the Patriot League's five weekly award recipients on Monday, with Katie Detwiler (Defender of the Week), Kaitlyn Larsson (Goalkeeper) and Fr. A Emily Wills (Attacker) all taking home accolades after last weekend's 16-7 win over Johns Hopkins.
- Detwiler limited 2020 Tewaaraton Watch List candidate Maggie Schneidereith (48 G, 29 A in 2019) to a single goal while also contributing three draw controls, two ground balls and one caused turnover. She receives her secondcareer weekly honor.
- Larsson matched a career-high with 12 saves in her first collegiate start, limiting Hopkins to its fewest goals total since April 13, 2018. She is now 5-0 overall at Loyola after Wednesday's win over Towson.
- Wills recorded three goals and a pair of assists in her collegiate debut, and she added two more goals in Wednesday's victory.

TWO GREYHOUNDS NAMED TO 2020 TEWAARATON WATCH LIST

- Livy Rosenzweig and Jr. M Sam Fiedler were selected to the 2020 Tewaaraton Award Watch List last Thursday.
- A total of 50 players across the NCAA were chosen as early-season candidates for college lacrosse's top honor.
- Rosenzweig was one of 25 semifinalists for the award during her sophomore season last spring.
- Rosenzweig's sister Gabby, a senior attacker at Penn, was also included on this year's Watch List. The siblings will square off when Loyola travels to Penn on March 7

PRESEASON INDIVIDUAL ACCOLADES

- **Livy Rosenzweig** was named a second team Preseason All-American by Inside Lacrosse back in January, joining Navy's Kelly Larkin as the lone Patriot League honorees.
- One of two Loyola players male of female to reach 100 points in a season, Rosenzweig has accomplished the feat in each of her first two collegiate seasons. She recorded multiple points in every game last spring and tallied 8+ points on six occasions.
- Rosenzweig was joined by Sam Fiedler, Jr. M Elli Kluegel and So. D Katie Detwiler on the Preseason All-Patriot League team.
- Loyola's four selections were tied with Army for the most on the conference's 16-member Preseason All-League squad. Detwiler was the lone defender recognized.

FIEDLER LOOKS TO BUILD ON BREAKOUT YEAR

- **Sam Fiedler** earned first team All-Patriot League and second team IWLCA All-Region accolades following a sophomore season in which she totaled 79 points (53 G, 26 A) while leading DI with a .671 shot percentage.
- Fiedler also led the Patriot League in ground balls (51) and ranked tied for fourth in the conference in goals. She contributed 10 hat tricks, nine multiple assist games and 13 games with 4+ points.
- With her two points (1 G, 1 A) against Towson, Fiedler continued her longest current active team streaks in games with at least one point (37) and games with at least one goal (35).
- At 86 career goals, Fiedler is 14 away from becoming the 31st player in program history to reach 100 in her collegiate career.

PATRIOT LEAGUE DOMINANCE

- Loyola is 52-0 against Patriot League opponents in regular season play since joining the conference. That run is the longest active win streak in Division I.
- The NCAA record for consecutive conference wins is a 61-game streak by UMass in Atlantic 10 play which began in 2011 and ended on April 22, 2018.
- The Greyhounds claimed Patriot League championships in each of their first three years in the conference (2014-16), and added a fourth postseason title last spring.
- In its 11 games against conference foes last season (regular and postseason), Loyola outscored its opponent by a 207-78 margin. Seven of 11 victories were by double digits, with the closest margin a 13-6 win over Lehigh on March 23.

ELEVEN NEWCOMERS JOIN PROGRAM FOR 2020

- The Greyhounds have 11 new faces on this year's roster, with sophomore transfer **Shay Clevenger** and 10 freshmen joining the program this spring.
- Clevenger spent the 2019 season at Louisville, starting all 18 games as a defender for the Cardinals. She tied for the team lead and ranked seventh overall in the ACC with 37 ground balls.
- Loyola's 10-member freshmen class includes four midfielders, three attackers, two defenders and one goalkeeper.
- Twins Logan and Riley Olmstead are the younger sisters of Loyola men's lacrosse junior attacker Aidan Olmstead.

2020 CAPTAINS

- Katie Detwiler, Elli Kluegel, Sr. A Holly Lloyd and Livy Rosenzweig will serve as Loyola's team captains for the 2020 season.
- The group is comprised of one senior (Lloyd), two juniors (Kluegel, Rosenzweig) and one sophomore (Detwiler).

- Hannah Powers, a 2019 third team IWLCA All-American, concluded her career as Loyola's all-time leader with 317 points (187 G, 130 A). She ranks fourth alltime in the Patriot League in points and fifth in assists.
- Taylor VanThof, a 2019 second team IWLCA All-American and the PL Midfielder of the Year, graduated as the program's career (392), single season (146) and single game (21) record holder for draw controls, as she became the first player in program history to win at least 100 draws in three different seasons.
- Lindsay Ehrhardt, a 2019 second team IWLCA All-American and the PL Defensive Player of the Year, ranked seventh in Division I with 45 caused turnovers.
- Kady Glynn was the 2019 PL Goalkeeper of the Year and a two-time first team All-Patriot League selection, while Kristen Yanchoris was the 2019 PL Female Scholar-Athlete of the Year and a four-time All-Patriot League honoree.
- Other departed seniors include Emily Cooper (40 G, 3 A in 2019), Katie Korvin (20 GS on defense) and Amanda Ingnacio (18 GP, 14 G).

2019 STARTERS KLUEGEL, DETWILER, BEIER ALL BACK THIS SPRING

- Elli Kluegel, Katie Detwiler and Jr. A Emily Beier join Livy Rosenzweig and Sam Fiedler as returning starters from last year's squad.
- A two-year starter, Kluegel has totaled 68 goals and eight assists in her first two-plus seasons at Loyola. She ranked fifth on the team with 35 goals in 2019.
- Kluegel was also a CoSIDA Academic All-District and Academic All-Patriot League performer. A biology major, she holds a perfect 4.0 GPA through her first five semesters on campus.
- Detwiler was the lone freshman to start all 21 games last season, earning second team All-Patriot League status while totaling 24 ground balls and 12 caused turnovers.
- Beier registered 16 points (7 G, 9 A) while starting 20 of 21 contests in 2019.

PRO HOUNDS

- The Women's Professional Lacrosse League wrapped up its second season last summer, with eight former Greyhounds and current assistant coach **Dana Dobbie** all competing at the highest level.
- Dobbie, a team captain for the WPLL champion Baltimore Brave, topped Lindsay Ehrhardt '19 and the New York Fight in the 2019 title game.
- Katrina Geiger '18, Hannah Powers '19 and Taylor VanThof '19 suited up for the Philadelphia Fire, Molly Hulseman '15 and Molly Wolf '16 played on the Upstate Pride, and Taryn VanThof '15 and Bailey Mathis '17 were on the New England Command.
- Loyola head coach **Jen Adams** serves as the league's commissioner.

SMART HOUNDS

- Loyola has a cumulative team GPA of 3.48, including an impressive 3.64 average during the 2019 fall semester.
- Elli Kluegel, Jr. M Bridget Ballard, Fr. M Catie Corolla and Fr. M Logan Olmstead all recorded 4.0 GPA's last semester.

HEAD COACH JEN ADAMS

Innovative. Difference-Maker. Creative. Stellar. Spectacular: All words used to describe Jen Adams throughout her illustrious playing career on the collegiate and international levels. Those same adjectives hold true for her coaching and leadership styles as she enters her 12th season at the helm of the Loyola women's lacrosse program in 2020.

AT LOYOLA

Since coming to Loyola, Jen Adams has directed a resurgence of the program back to national prominence. Inheriting a squad that posted a 6-10 record in 2008, Adams turned that into an 11-6 mark in 2009 and an 11-7 record in 2010. Her 2011 squad won its first of two-straight BIG EAST Championships, returned to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2004 and tied a school record for wins in a season, posting a 17-3 record. Since joining the Patriot League prior to the 2014 season, Adams' Greyhounds have added four more conference titles in the past six years.

Entering the 2020 season, Adams has a career record of 153-66 in 11 years. The three-time IWLCA Mid-Atlantic Region Coach of the Year has led Loyola to eight NCAA tournaments in the last nine years, advancing to the Quarterfinals in 2011, 2012 and 2015.

In conference play, Adams' squads have dominated. In the last seven seasons, her teams have posted an overall record of 58-2 in regular-season conference contests, including an unblemished 52-0 mark in Patriot League play - the longest active win streak in the NCAA. Her Greyhounds have also claimed six league tournament titles - back-to-back BIG EAST Championships (2011, 2012) and four Patriot League titles (2014, 2015, 2016, 2019).

Nationally, nine of Adams' squads have began the season ranked in the top-15 of the IWLCA Preseason Coaches Poll. She's also brought 23 All-America honors to the Greyhounds, including churning out 13 All-Americans and producing three of the program's eight three-time All-Americans: Marlee Paton '14, Taryn VanThof '15 and Maddy Lesher '16.

As a member of the BIG EAST Conference, Adams picked up co-BIG EAST Coach of the Year honors in 2011 and led the Greyhounds to back-to-back BIG EAST Tournament titles, a 27-12 record in conference games and a 4-2 mark in tournament action.

Adams didn't miss a beat in transitioning to the Patriot League in 2014. Tabbed as the

League's preseason favorite each of her first seven years, Adams has been named the League's Coach of the Year five times (2014, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019) and brought 14 major awards to the Greyhounds.

BEFORE LOYOLA

Prior to coming to Loyola, Adams served as the associate head coach under Cathy Reese at the University of Maryland during the 2007 and 2008 seasons. She was also an assistant to Reese at the University of Denver from 2004-06.

At Maryland, Adams rejuvenated the Terrapins offense to play in her up-tempo attacking style. In her first season as associate head coach, Maryland scored 287 goals, the most it had recorded in a season since 2001, Adams' senior year.

COACHING INTERNATIONALLY

Adams took a break from the college game during the summer of 2012 and 2015 and assisted her sister, Trish, at the Under-19 World Championships. The Adams duo led the U-19 Australian National Team to a silver medal in 2012 and to the semifinals in 2015. She served as the Australian's U-19 Co-Head Coach with former Greyhound Stacey (Morlang) Sullivan at the 2019 World Championships.

AS A PLAYER

Adams is regarded as the finest female lacrosse player of all time. Putting together arguably the greatest collegiate women's lacrosse career in the sport's history, Adams led Maryland to four-straight national titles from 1998-2001, including a 21-0 record in 1999 and a 23-0 mark in 2001. She racked up honors like she scored goals and recorded assists, and was named to the NCAA Division I Women's Lacrosse 25th Anniversary Team in April 2007.

The Brighton, South Australia native, was a three-time national player of the year and was the first recipient of the Tewaaraton Trophy in 2001. She set every scoring record for the Terrapins - season and career - finishing her

storied career with 267 goals, 178 assists and 445 total points. Her marks for total points stands today as an NCAA record and her goals total is still a record at Maryland.

In addition to her career marks, Adams had single-season performances that also rank amongst the best in Maryland and NCAA history. During her Tewaaraton-winning senior season, Adams led the nation with 88 goals, 60 assists and 148 total points, setting school single-season marks in the process. Those season totals only added her name one rung higher, as she had set school records with 81 goals, 55 assists and 136 total points the previous season.

Adams' efforts were not limited just to the lacrosse field. In addition to her three All-America honors as a player, Adams earned the 2000 and 2001 Honda/Broderick Award for women's lacrosse excellence in the classroom and on the field. She also garnered CoSIDA Academic All-America First Team honors as a senior, was named the National Attacker of the Year in 1999, 2000 and 2001 and the Atlantic Coast Conference Female Athlete of the Year in 2000 and 2001.
