THE MATCHUP

No. 4 Loyola faces its fourth ranked opponent in five games to begin the season on Saturday, as the Greyhounds travel to Philadelphia to take on No. 9 Penn at 1 p.m.

LAST TIME OUT

- For a second-straight Saturday, Loyola posted a double-digit victory at a nationallyranked opponent, as 11 different Greyhounds scored in a 22-12 win at No. 19 Penn State.
- Jr. M Sam Fiedler led the offense with four goals and three assists, while Jr. A Livy **Rosenzweig** supplied one goal, a season-high five assists and eight draw controls.
- Loyola's 22 goals were its most since April 28, 2018 against Holy Cross (23-3), and it was the most for the program against a ranked team since a 23-5 win over No. 14 Towson on April 30, 1997.
- So. M Jillian Wilson (3 G, 1 A), Jr. M Elli Kluegel (4 G) and Fr. A Emily Wills (3 G) all added hat tricks in the win. Wilson chipped in five draw controls and a team-high three caused turnovers in an all-around effort.

QUICK NOTES

- The Greyhounds are projected to top the Patriot League standings for a seventh-consecutive season since joining the conference prior to the 2014 campaign.
- Loyola went 16-5 (9-0) last spring, winning its fourth Patriot League postseason championship in six seasons and advancing to the NCAA tournament for an eighth time in the last nine years.
- **Livy Rosenzweig** became the first Greyhound to achieve first team IWLCA All-America status since 2012 last season after breaking her own school record in points (116, 46 G, 70 A) and also setting a new program mark in assists.
- Loyola led Division I in both assists per game (9.4) and shot percentage (51.3) in 2019, ranked seventh nationally in scoring margin (+6.8) and ninth in goals per game (15.9).
- Loyola holds an overall mark of 157-66 (79-12 conference) in 11+ seasons under head coach **Jen Adams**, posting winning records every year during her tenure.
- Adams has been named Patriot League Coach of the Year in five of Loyola's six seasons in the conference, including each of the last four years.
- Loyola has scored 10+ goals in 19-straight games dating back to last March.

LOOKING AHEAD

The Greyhounds return to Ridley Athletic Complex next Saturday, hosting Lehigh in their Patriot League opener at 12 p.m.

SERIES HISTORY

- Loyola leads 16-4 in a series which dates back to 1983.
- This will be the first meeting between the two sides since 2012 and only the second since 2005.
- The Greyhounds have won the last 14 meetings overall, including a 10-9 overtime victory at Ridley Athletic Complex in the opening round of the NCAA tournament on May 13, 2012. Hannah Schmitt scored the game-winner with three seconds left in OT.
- Loyola is 6-3 lifetime at Penn, winning each of the last five contests in Philadelphia.
- Penn's last win was a 6-5 home triumph on March 14, 1989.

SCOUTING PENN

- The Quakers (4-0) are coming off an 11-5 victory at Yale in their Ivy League opener on Saturday. Their other wins came against Georgetown (17-6), Johns Hopkins (15-12) and Rutgers (11-9).
- Penn, which has reached the NCAA tournament every year dating back to the 2007 season, was ranked second behind Princeton in the 2020 Ivy League preseason poll.
- Sr. A Gabby Rosenzweig, the older sister of Loyola's Livy Rosenzweig became Penn's all-time scoring leader in its win over Johns Hopkins on Feb. 22. A two-time third team IWLCA All-American, she has 242 career points (117 G, 125 A) in 58 career appearances.
- Gabby Rosenzweig and Sr. M Erin Barry (12 G, 3 A) were both named to the 2020 Tewaaraton Award Watch List.

HOUNDS RISING IN THE POLLS

- Lovola rose one spot to No. 4 in the latest IWLCA Coaches' poll released on Monday following its victory at Penn State. The No. 4 ranking is the program's highest in the coaches poll since the conclusion of the 2004 season.
- The Greyhounds are one position higher in the media polls, as they were listed No. 3 in both the Inside Lacrosse and Nike/US Lacrosse rankings.
- Loyola's 4-0 start is the program's best since beginning the 2011 season with 12-consecutive victories.

FIEDLER CONTINUES OFFENSIVE SURGE

- **Sam Fiedler** has totaled a team-high 15 points (11 G, 4 A) in Loyola's last two victories. She is up to 97 career goals, leaving her three away from becoming the 31st player in program history to reach 100 in her collegiate career
- Fiedler was selected as the US Lacrosse Player of the Week on Feb. 24 after setting career-highs in both goals (7) and points (8) during Loyola's 17-6 victory at No. 4 Florida.
- A 2020 Tewaaraton Watch List honoree, Fiedler was a second team IWLCA All-Region and first team All-Patriot League selection last spring after leading the nation with a .671 shot percentage. She has recorded at least one point in 39-straight games, and she has at least one goal in 37 straight.

ROSENZWEIG MOVING UP PROGRAM RECORD BOOK

- **Livy Rosenzweig** moved up to No. 2 all-time at Loyola in assists following her five helpers at Penn State on Saturday. Her 132 career assists are also the fifthmost in Patriot League history.
- Rosenzweig is 17 assists away from surpassing Annie Thomas' school-record
 of 148. She is also five draw controls away from becoming the third Greyhound in team history to reach 200 in her collegiate career.
- Rosenzweig has recorded points in 45 of 46 appearances, including each of the last 38 contests. She is third in DI at 3.75 assists per game this season.

LARSSON AMONG NATIONAL LEADERS IN GOAL

- Jr. GK Kaitlyn Larsson contributed eight saves in Saturday's win at Penn State, including seven in the opening half. She is now 7-0 in her collegiate career, with six of her wins coming against nationally-ranked opponents.
- Larsson ranks eighth in DI in save percentage (.554) and she is 12th nationally in goals-against average (8.44). She has 41 saves through four games, including a season-high of 12 in Loyola's 16-7 win over Johns Hopkins on Feb. 15.

TAKING CARE OF THE BALL

- The Greyhounds rank ninth in the nation in turnovers per game, averaging 12.25 giveaways through the season's first four contests. They have committed just 17 turnovers in their last two victories.
- Loyola had seven turnovers in its 17-6 win at then-No. 4 Florida on Feb. 22, which was tied for the program's second-fewest in a game dating back to the start of the 2016 season.
- Loyola's fewest turnovers in a contest during that span was six, a mark established in last year's Patriot League final during a 21-9 victory over Navy.

PATRIOT LEAGUE WEEKLY AWARD WINNERS

- So. D Katie Detwiler received her third-straight Patriot League Defender of the Week award on Monday, while Jillian Wilson took home Midfielder of the Week accolades for the first time.
- Detwiler has recorded a career-high six draw controls in back-to-back games, and she is frequently matched up against team's top scoring threats on defense. She limited Penn State's leading scorer Maria Auth to a pair of goals in the first 55 minutes before Loyola brought in its reserves.
- Wilson has recorded multiple goals in every game this year, and she has
 caused three turnovers in back-to-back games. Her defensive matchup on
 Saturday, Penn State's No. 3 scorer Quinn Nicolai, was held to no goals on just
 two shots.
- Wilson (13 G, 2 A) ranks third on the team with 15 points on the year.

- Sr. A Holly Lloyd (2 G, 1 A), Fr. A Sydney Foster (1 G, 1 A) and Jr. A Emily Beier (1 G, 1 A) each had their top offensive outputs of the season.
- Jr. M Bridget Ballard extended her goal-scoring streak to four games, and she
 matched Elli Kluegel for the team lead with three ground balls.
- Fr. M **Anna Ruby** scored her first collegiate goal on a free position strike with 5:56 remaining in regulation.

- Loyola set new season highs in shots (37), ground balls (22), caused turnovers (13) and draw controls (20).

STRONG START FOR WILLS

- **Emily Wills** has totaled 13 points (9 G, 4 A) while earning starts in each of her first four collegiate contests.
- Wills was chosen as the Patriot League's Rookie of the Week on Feb. 17 after supplying three goals and a pair of assists in her debut against No. 24 Johns Hopkins.
- Wills earned USLacrosse All-America status in each of her final two seasons at The Agnes Irwin School. She was part of two PAISAA championship-winning teams (2017, 2018).

ANOTHER RANKED OPPONENT DOWN

- Loyola's win at Penn State was its third victory over a nationally-ranked team in four games to begin 2020.
- Loyola has posted 48 victories over nationally-ranked opposition in 11-plus seasons under head coach **Jen Adams**. The Greyhounds' win at then-No. 4 Florida was the fifth victory against a top-five team during Adams' tenure.

TWO GREYHOUNDS NAMED TO 2020 TEWAARATON WATCH LIST

- Livy Rosenzweig and Sam Fiedler were selected to the 2020 Tewaaraton Award Watch List on Feb. 13.
- A total of 50 players across the NCAA were chosen as early-season candidates for college lacrosse's top honor.
- Rosenzweig was one of 25 semifinalists for the award during her sophomore season last spring. She has recorded 5+ points in 12-straight games dating back to April 13, 2019.

PRESEASON INDIVIDUAL ACCOLADES

- **Livy Rosenzweig** was named a second team Preseason All-American by Inside Lacrosse back in January, joining Navy's Kelly Larkin as the Ione Patriot League honorees.
- One of two Loyola players male of female to reach 100 points in a season, Rosenzweig has accomplished the feat in each of her first two collegiate seasons. She recorded multiple points in every game last spring and tallied 8+ points on six occasions.
- Rosenzweig was joined by Sam Fiedler, Jr. M Elli Kluegel and So. D Katie Detwiler on the Preseason All-Patriot League team.
- Loyola's four selections were tied with Army for the most on the conference's 16-member Preseason All-League squad. Detwiler was the lone defender recognized.

PATRIOT LEAGUE DOMINANCE

- Loyola is 52-0 against Patriot League opponents in regular season play since joining the conference. That run is the longest active win streak in Division I.
- The NCAA record for consecutive conference wins is a 61-game streak by UMass in Atlantic 10 play which began in 2011 and ended on April 22, 2018.
- The Greyhounds claimed Patriot League championships in each of their first three years in the conference (2014-16), and added a fourth postseason title last spring.
- In its 11 games against conference foes last season (regular and postseason), Loyola outscored its opponent by a 207-78 margin. Seven of 11 victories were by double digits, with the closest margin a 13-6 win over Lehigh on March 23.

- Loyola is 74-22 overall at home since its first contest at Ridley on March 16, 2010.

ELEVEN NEWCOMERS JOIN PROGRAM FOR 2020

- The Greyhounds have 11 new faces on this year's roster, with sophomore transfer **Shay Clevenger** and 10 freshmen joining the program this spring.
- Clevenger spent the 2019 season at Louisville, starting all 18 games as a defender for the Cardinals. She tied for the team lead and ranked seventh overall in the ACC with 37 ground balls.
- Loyola's 10-member freshmen class includes four midfielders, three attackers, two defenders and one goalkeeper.
- Twins Logan and Riley Olmstead are the younger sisters of Loyola men's lacrosse junior attacker Aidan Olmstead.

2020 CAPTAINS

- Katie Detwiler, Elli Kluegel, Holly Lloyd and Livy Rosenzweig will serve as Loyola's team captains for the 2020 season.

- Katrina Geiger '18, Hannah Powers '19 and Taylor VanThof '19 suited up for the Philadelphia Fire, Molly Hulseman '15 and Molly Wolf '16 played on the Upstate Pride, and Taryn VanThof '15 and Bailey Mathis '17 were on the New England Command.
- Loyola head coach **Jen Adams** serves as the league's commissioner.

- Loyola has a cumulative team GPA of 3.48, including an impressive 3.64 average during the 2019 fall semester.

HEAD COACH JEN ADAMS

Innovative. Difference-Maker. Creative. Stellar. Spectacular: All words used to describe Jen Adams throughout her illustrious playing career on the collegiate and international levels. Those same adjectives hold true for her coaching and leadership styles as she enters her 12th season at the helm of the Loyola women's lacrosse program in 2020.

AT LOYOLA

Since coming to Loyola, Jen Adams has directed a resurgence of the program back to national prominence. Inheriting a squad that posted a 6-10 record in 2008, Adams turned that into an 11-6 mark in 2009 and an 11-7 record in 2010. Her 2011 squad won its first of two-straight BIG EAST Championships, returned to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2004 and tied a school record for wins in a season, posting a 17-3 record. Since joining the Patriot League prior to the 2014 season, Adams' Greyhounds have added four more conference titles in the past six years.

Entering the 2020 season, Adams has a career record of 153-66 in 11 years. The three-time IWLCA Mid-Atlantic Region Coach of the Year has led Loyola to eight NCAA tournaments in the last nine years, advancing to the Quarterfinals in 2011, 2012 and 2015.

In conference play, Adams' squads have dominated. In the last seven seasons, her teams have posted an overall record of 58-2 in regular-season conference contests, including an unblemished 52-0 mark in Patriot League play - the longest active win streak in the NCAA. Her Greyhounds have also claimed six league tournament titles - back-to-back BIG EAST Championships (2011, 2012) and four Patriot League titles (2014, 2015, 2016, 2019).

Nationally, nine of Adams' squads have began the season ranked in the top-15 of the IWLCA Preseason Coaches Poll. She's also brought 23 All-America honors to the Greyhounds, including churning out 13 All-Americans and producing three of the program's eight three-time All-Americans: Marlee Paton '14, Taryn VanThof '15 and Maddy Lesher '16.

As a member of the BIG EAST Conference, Adams picked up co-BIG EAST Coach of the Year honors in 2011 and led the Greyhounds to back-to-back BIG EAST Tournament titles, a 27-12 record in conference games and a 4-2 mark in tournament action.

Adams didn't miss a beat in transitioning to the Patriot League in 2014. Tabbed as the

League's preseason favorite each of her first seven years, Adams has been named the League's Coach of the Year five times (2014, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019) and brought 14 major awards to the Greyhounds.

BEFORE LOYOLA

Prior to coming to Loyola, Adams served as the associate head coach under Cathy Reese at the University of Maryland during the 2007 and 2008 seasons. She was also an assistant to Reese at the University of Denver from 2004-06.

At Maryland, Adams rejuvenated the Terrapins offense to play in her up-tempo attacking style. In her first season as associate head coach, Maryland scored 287 goals, the most it had recorded in a season since 2001, Adams' senior year.

COACHING INTERNATIONALLY

Adams took a break from the college game during the summer of 2012 and 2015 and assisted her sister, Trish, at the Under-19 World Championships. The Adams duo led the U-19 Australian National Team to a silver medal in 2012 and to the semifinals in 2015. She served as the Australian's U-19 Co-Head Coach with former Greyhound Stacey (Morlang) Sullivan at the 2019 World Championships.

AS A PLAYER

Adams is regarded as the finest female lacrosse player of all time. Putting together arguably the greatest collegiate women's lacrosse career in the sport's history, Adams led Maryland to four-straight national titles from 1998-2001, including a 21-0 record in 1999 and a 23-0 mark in 2001. She racked up honors like she scored goals and recorded assists, and was named to the NCAA Division I Women's Lacrosse 25th Anniversary Team in April 2007.

The Brighton, South Australia native, was a three-time national player of the year and was the first recipient of the Tewaaraton Trophy in 2001. She set every scoring record for the Terrapins - season and career - finishing her

storied career with 267 goals, 178 assists and 445 total points. Her marks for total points stands today as an NCAA record and her goals total is still a record at Maryland.

In addition to her career marks, Adams had single-season performances that also rank amongst the best in Maryland and NCAA history. During her Tewaaraton-winning senior season, Adams led the nation with 88 goals, 60 assists and 148 total points, setting school single-season marks in the process. Those season totals only added her name one rung higher, as she had set school records with 81 goals, 55 assists and 136 total points the previous season.

Adams' efforts were not limited just to the lacrosse field. In addition to her three All-America honors as a player, Adams earned the 2000 and 2001 Honda/Broderick Award for women's lacrosse excellence in the classroom and on the field. She also garnered CoSIDA Academic All-America First Team honors as a senior, was named the National Attacker of the Year in 1999, 2000 and 2001 and the Atlantic Coast Conference Female Athlete of the Year in 2000 and 2001.
