THE MATCHUP

- Loyola women's lacrosse, which is ranked 14th in the IWLCA Coaches' poll and 18th in the ILWomen media poll, hosts Drexel in a non-conference game at 12 p.m. Sunday.
- This will be the fifth meeting all-time between the two sides, and the first since 2002. The game was added after Loyola's Saturday afternoon matchup at Navy was postponed due to restriction of movement at the Naval Academy.

LAST TIME OUT

- Kaitlyn Larsson** recorded a career-high 14 saves in goal, and the offense recovered from a slow start to send Loyola to a 9-6 home win over Georgetown on Wednesday.
- Larsson made 10 of her stops in the first half, keeping the Greyhounds in the game as they were kept off the scoreboard until 5:39 prior to the intermission. Loyola outscored the Hoyas (1-2) by a 6-2 margin in the second half after trailing 4-3 at the break.
- Sam Fiedler** supplied a pair of goals, including the game-winning tally with 12:44 remaining, and a career-best four assists.
- Emily Wills added one goal, one assist, and a career-high three caused turnovers.
- Loyola had a 12-5 advantage in draw controls, led by six from **Livy Rosenzweig** and four from **Jillian Wilson**.

MORE ON LARSSON'S PERFORMANCE



- Larsson's previous career high saves total was 12, a mark she reached twice during Loyola's 5-0 season last spring.
- Her save percentage has risen in all five starts, including a .600 mark in last Saturday's 21-4 win over American and a .700 percentage against Georgetown.
- Larsson now leads the Patriot League and is ranked 25th nationally in save percentage (.494). She is also 26th in DI in goals-against average (9.61) and she is 20th in total saves (43).
- Larsson is 11-2 overall in her career (7-1 vs. ranked opponents) with a 7.92 GAA, .545 save percentage and 171 saves.

LOOKING AHEAD

- Loyola returns to Patriot League competition, traveling to Bucknell for the first of two scheduled games this season against the Bison. Opening draw next Saturday is set for 1 p.m.

SERIES HISTORY

- Loyola leads 4-0 in a series which dates back to 1984.
- The teams met three-straight years from 1984-86, with the Greyhounds winning all three by a combined margin of 46-12.
- The most-recent meeting came on April 14, 2002, which was Loyola's last season (and Drexel's first as a member of the CAA). The Greyhounds topped Drexel by a 19-3 final in that contest.

SCOUTING DREXEL

- The Dragons are off to their first 5-0 start since 2013, outscoring opponents by a combined margin of 89-56 on the year.
- Drexel and Loyola have played two common opponents, with the Dragons topping both Georgetown (21-9) and Villanova (17-7).
- Sr. M Karson Harris (24 G, 4 A, 34 DC, 17 GB, 7 CT) was named to the initial Tewaaron Award watch list this week. She ranks second in Division I in goals scored, while Sr. A Colleen Grady (18 G, 14 A) leads the nation with 32 points entering the weekend.
- As a team, Drexel ranks third in D1 in both goals per game (17.8) and shot percentage (53.6%). The Dragons have scored at least 13 goals in every game, and they have managed 17+ goals in 4 of 5 contests.

ROSENZWEIG MILESTONE WATCH

- Livy Rosenzweig** has totaled 145 assists in 51 collegiate games, a total which is No. 2 all-time at Loyola (three back of 2015 graduate Annie Thomas) and fourth all-time in the Patriot League (32 behind Navy's Kelly Larkin).
- Rosenzweig has recorded multiple assists in four out of five games this season, and in 42 of 52 collegiate appearances overall.
- Rosenzweig is also No. 7 all-time at Loyola in points (267). She is 10 back of Marlee Paton '14 in 6th and 50 behind former teammate Hannah Powers '19 for the top spot.
- In the 2020 finale, Rosenzweig became the third Greyhound to reach 200 career draw controls. Her 217 draws are behind only sisters Taylor VanThof '19 (392) and Taryn VanThof '15 (318).

FIEDLER, ROSENZWEIG NAMED TO TEWAARATON AWARD WATCH LIST

- Seniors **Sam Fiedler** and **Livy Rosenzweig** were each included in the group of 57 initial watch list candidates announced on Thursday for the 2021 Tewaaratton Award. Both were on the 2020 watch list as well, and Rosenzweig was also a Top-25 semifinalist for the award as a sophomore in 2019.
- Fiedler leads the Greyhounds with 23 points (16 G, 7 A) and seven caused turnovers. Rosenzweig is just behind with 22 points (11 G, 11 A), and she has also won a team-high 22 draw controls.
- The Tewaaratton Award annually honors the top male and female college lacrosse player in the USA. The selection committees are made up of premier collegiate coaches and are appointed annually by the Tewaaratton Foundation.

QUICK NOTES FROM GEORGETOWN

- Loyola earned a victory after trailing at halftime for the first time since March 7, 2018 against Towson, when the Greyhounds were down 11-5 before prevailing 14-13 in triple overtime.
- Kaitlyn Larsson's** 14 saves were Loyola's most since Kady Glynn had 15 in a 12-6 win over Towson on March 6, 2019.
- The Greyhounds were a perfect 18 for 18 in clearing attempts, raising their season clear percentage up to 87.0 percent.
- Emily Beier** provided one of Loyola's three goals in the first half. She has now scored in three-consecutive games.
- Sydney Foster** picked up her first point of the season, as she set up a goal from **Anna Ruby** which tied the score at 5-5 midway through the second half.

DEFENSE STEPPING UP

- Loyola's defense has held opponents to single digit scoring totals in each of the past three victories, with the Greyhounds allowing a total of 16 goals during that stretch.
- Loyola has been particularly stingy in the second half, surrendering only four goals combined after the intermission in its three wins.
- The Greyhounds are now ranked 24th nationally in goals-against average (9.40) on the year.

MORE THAN JUST GOALS FOR FIEDLER

- Sam Fiedler** has totaled a team-high 43 points (32 G, 11 A) over Loyola's last eight games dating back to last season.
- Her four assists on Wednesday were one above her previous career high of three, which she had reached two separate occasions.
- Fiedler also leads the team with seven caused turnovers. She set a new career best with three CT's in last Saturday's win over American.
- Fiedler has 118 goals in 52 games at Loyola, and she has scored at least one goal in 43-straight contests.

BACK ON TRACK AT RIDLEY

- After Loyola saw a 12-game home winning streak with its season-opening defeat to Syracuse, the Greyhounds returned to their winning ways at Ridley Athletic Complex with victories over American and Georgetown.
- Loyola is now 76-23 all-time at Ridley since the facility opened in 2010.
- The Greyhounds have a 23-4 record at home dating back to the start of the 2018 season.

PRESEASON ACCOLADES

- Loyola topped the Patriot League preseason poll for an eighth-consecutive season, with the Greyhounds receiving 162 points and all 18 available first-place votes.
- Livy Rosenzweig** was named Patriot League Preseason Offensive Player of the Year for a second time (previously in 2019), while **Katie Detwiler** earned Preseason Defensive Player of the Year accolades.
- Rosenzweig, Detwiler, **Sam Fiedler**, **Elli Kluegel** and **Jillian Wilson** were all Preseason All-Patriot League selections.
- Rosenzweig and Detwiler were two of US Lacrosse's 13 First Team Preseason All-Americans announced in December.
- Rosenzweig, Detwiler and **Kaitlyn Larsson** were all ILWomen Second Team Preseason All-Americans. Fiedler and **Shay Clevenger** landed on the third team, while Wilson received honorable mention recognition.

- 12:** Weekly Patriot League awards, led by Detwiler (3x Defender of the Week), Larsson (2x Goalkeeper of the Week), **Emily Wills** (2x Rookie, 1x Attacker of the Week) and **Jillian Wilson** (2x Midfielder of the Week).

CONDENSED SCHEDULE INCLUDES EIGHT GAMES AT RIDLEY

- In response to the continuing COVID-19 pandemic, Loyola and the Patriot League have instituted several changes to the 2021 lacrosse schedule.
- Consistent with the prioritization of health and safety, the 13-game schedule features reductions in travel and overnight stays. Loyola has six non-conference opponents currently on the schedule, with four taking place at Ridley Athletic Complex and the other two short trips to Towson and Villanova.
- The Patriot League is split into two five-team divisions, with Loyola grouped in the South with American, Bucknell, Lehigh and Navy.
- The top two teams in each division advance to the PL tournament, with semi-final games set for May 6 and the championship scheduled for May 8.

HIGH-POWERED OFFENSE LAST SPRING

- Loyola's 17.6 goals per game during the shortened 2020 season ranked sixth in all of Division I. The Greyhounds scored at least 14 goals in all five victories, and outscored opponents by an overall margin of 88-50.
- Loyola was also ranked in the top 10 nationally in assists (8.8) and draw controls (16.6) per game.
- The Greyhounds made the most of their scoring attempts, with **Emily Wills** (5th, .706) and **Jillian Wilson** (12th, .654) among the nation's leaders in shot percentage. **Sam Fiedler**, who led DI with a .671 shot percentage in 2019, was not far behind at .576 last spring.

MORE ROSENZWEIG NOTES

- Livy Rosenzweig** became the first Greyhound to earn IWLCAs first team All-America accolades since 2012 following a 2019 season in which she broke program records in both points (116) and assists (70).
- She ranked third in Division I in assists, and she was fourth nationally in points that season. She also helped Loyola lead DI as a team in both total assists (197) and assists per game (9.38).
- Rosenzweig has totaled 5+ points in 32 of 52 collegiate games, including 4 of 5 contests in 2020. She has recorded multiple points in 51 of 52 appearances.

KLUEGEL EXCELS ON, OFF THE FIELD

- Senior **Elli Kluegel** was named to the Preseason All-Patriot League Team for a second-consecutive season on Feb. 4. Her 15 goals ranked third on the team in 2020, and she now has 86 goals in 52 career appearances.
- Off the field, Kluegel continues to maintain a perfect 4.0 GPA while majoring in biology. A two-time COSIDA Academic All-District honoree, she was also an Academic All-Patriot League selection in 2019.

WILLS HOPES TO BUILD ON STRONG FRESHMEN CAMPAIGN

- **Emily Wills** burst onto the scene during her debut collegiate season last spring, totaling 21 points (12 G, 9 A) while leading the Patriot League and ranking fifth nationally in shot percentage (.706).
- Wills was named PL Rookie of the Week after collecting five points (3 G, 2 A) in her debut vs. Johns Hopkins.
- She would add both PL Attacker and Rookie of the Week honors after managing a season-high eight points (3 G, 5 A) in the finale at Penn.

LARSSON RETURNS BETWEEN THE PIPES

- **Kaitlyn Larsson** made the most of her first five collegiate starts in goal last season, as she finished a perfect 5-0 with 53 saves, a .525 save percentage (9th in Division I) and a 9.78 goals-against average.
- Larsson made double-digit saves in four of Loyola's victories, matching a career-high with 12 in wins over Johns Hopkins (2/15) and Penn (3/7).

DETWILER, ROSENZWEIG INVITED TO U.S. NATIONAL TEAM TRYOUTS

- **Katie Detwiler** and **Livy Rosenzweig** were two of 50 candidates across the country invited to compete for spots on the U.S. National Team at the 2022 World Championships.
- The tryouts, originally scheduled for December 2020, will now take place later in 2021, with the World Championships scheduled for June 29-July 9, 2022 in Towson, Md.
- Detwiler was previously part of the U.S. U19 training team in 2019. She was one of just three sophomores in the nation named to the Tewaaron Award Watch List last season.

FIFTH YEAR RETURNEES

- Two Loyola players are taking advantage of the extra year of eligibility granted by the NCAA following the shortened 2020 season, as **Holly Lloyd** and **Meaghan Quinn** both return for the Greyhounds this spring.
- Lloyd started all five games on attack for the Greyhounds last season, while Quinn was a key contributor on the backline, earning her first three collegiate starts to conclude the year.
- **Caitlyn Gunn**, who was already set to return this season after taking a medical redshirt in 2018, is also back as a graduate student after totaling three goals and two assists in a reserve attack role last spring.

STRONG DEBUT FOR CLEVINGER

- **Shay Clevenger** joined Loyola as a transfer in 2020 after spending her freshman season at Louisville, and the Woodstock, Md., native quickly made herself at home with the Greyhounds.
- Clevenger led the Patriot League and ranked 22nd nationally with 3.2 ground balls per game. She had 16 ground balls overall and was also tied for the team lead with seven caused turnovers.
- Clevenger was honored as PL Defender of the Week after picking up a career-high six ground balls and causing two turnovers in the season finale at Penn.

SMART HOUNDS

- Loyola has a cumulative team GPA of 3.63, including an impressive 3.76 average during the 2020 fall semester. That semester total was the highest among Loyola's 10 women's programs.
- **Emily Beier**, **Catie Corolla**, **Caitlyn Gunn**, **Meg Hillman** and **Elli Kluegel** all recorded perfect 4.0 GPA's, while **D.A. Coss** (3.93), **Sam Fiedler** (3.93), **Regan Kilmeyer** (3.93), **Anna Ruby** (3.92), **Izzy Sedwick** (3.94) and **Jillian Wilson** (3.93) were all above a 3.9.
- Kluegel and Corolla both have cumulative 4.0 GPA's; Kluegel is the lone senior Loyola student-athlete to maintain a cumulative 4.0 average.

2021 CAPTAINS

- **Katie Detwiler**, **Elli Kluegel**, **Holly Lloyd** and **Livy Rosenzweig** will serve as Loyola's team captains for the 2021 season.
- The group is comprised of one graduate student (Lloyd), two seniors (Kluegel, Rosenzweig) and one junior (Detwiler). All four were previously captains for the shortened 2020 campaign.

HEAD COACH JEN ADAMS

Innovative. Difference-Maker. Creative. Stellar. Spectacular: All words used to describe Jen Adams throughout her illustrious playing career on the collegiate and international levels. Those same adjectives hold true for her coaching and leadership styles as she enters her 13th season at the helm of the Loyola women's lacrosse program in 2021.

AT LOYOLA

Entering the 2021 season, Adams has a career record of 158-66 in 12 years. During the 2020 campaign, which was shortened due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Greyhounds were a perfect 5-0 on the year, defeating four ranked opponents and earning their highest end-of-year national ranking (No. 3) in the IWLCA Coaches' poll since 2003.

Since coming to Loyola, Adams has directed a resurgence of the program back to national prominence. Her 2011 squad won its first of two-straight BIG EAST Championships, returned to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2004 and tied a school record for wins in a season, posting a 17-3 record.

In conference play, Adams' squads have dominated. In the last seven completed seasons, her teams have posted an overall record of 58-2 in regular-season conference contests, including an unblemished 52-0 mark in Patriot League play for six-straight undefeated Patriot League Regular Season titles - the longest active win streak in the NCAA. Her Greyhounds have also claimed six league tournament titles - back-to-back BIG EAST Championships (2011, 2012) and four Patriot League titles (2014, 2015, 2016, 2019). The BIG EAST title in 2011 was the first for the program, while 2014 win was the school's first-ever Patriot League Championship, a League it joined for the 2013-14 school year.

Nationally, nine of Adams' squads have began the season ranked in the top-15 of the IWLCA Preseason Coaches Poll, while Loyola's stretch of four-straight years ranked in the preseason top-10 made the Greyhounds one of just seven programs in the NCAA to be ranked among the nation's top-10 teams from 2012-15.

As a member of the BIG EAST Conference, Adams picked up co-BIG EAST Coach of the Year honors in 2011 and led the Greyhounds to back-to-back BIG EAST Tournament titles, a 27-12 record in conference games and a 4-2 mark in tournament action.

Adams didn't miss a beat in transitioning to the Patriot League in 2014. Tabbed as the League's preseason favorite each of her first eight years, Adams has been named the League's Coach of the Year five times (2014, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019) and brought 14 major awards to the Greyhounds,

BEFORE LOYOLA

Prior to coming to Loyola, Adams served as the associate head coach under Cathy Reese at the University of Maryland during the 2007 and 2008 seasons. She was also an assistant to Reese at the University of Denver from 2004-06.

COACHING INTERNATIONALLY

Adams took a break from the college game during the summer of 2012 and 2015 and assisted her sister, Trish, at the Under-19 World Championships. The Adams duo led the U-19 Australian National Team to a silver medal in 2012 and to the semifinals in 2015. She served as the Australian's U-19 Co-Head Coach with former Greyhound Stacey (Morlang) Sullivan at the 2019 World Championships.

AS A PLAYER

Adams is regarded as the finest female lacrosse player of all time. Putting together arguably the greatest collegiate women's lacrosse career in the sport's history, Adams led Maryland to four-straight national titles from 1998-2001, including a 21-0 record in 1999 and a 23-0 mark in 2001. She racked up honors like she scored goals and recorded assists, and was named to the NCAA Division I Women's Lacrosse 25th Anniversary Team in April 2007.

The Brighton, South Australia native, was a three-time national player of the year and was the first recipient of the Tewaaraton Trophy in 2001. She set every scoring record for the Terrapins - season and career - finishing her storied career with 267 goals, 178 assists and 445 total points. Her marks for total points stands today as an NCAA record and her goals

total is still a record at Maryland.

In addition to her career marks, Adams had single-season performances that also rank amongst the best in Maryland and NCAA history. During her Tewaaraton-winning senior season, Adams led the nation with 88 goals, 60 assists and 148 total points, setting school single-season marks in the process. Those season totals only added her name one rung higher, as she had set school records with 81 goals, 55 assists and 136 total points the previous season.

Adams' efforts were not limited just to the lacrosse field. In addition to her three All-America honors as a player, Adams earned the 2000 and 2001 Honda/Broderick Award for women's lacrosse excellence in the classroom and on the field. She also garnered CoSIDA Academic All-America First Team honors as a senior, was named the National Attacker of the Year in 1999, 2000 and 2001 and the Atlantic Coast Conference Female Athlete of the Year in 2000 and 2001.
