THE MATCHUP

- Loyola women's lacrosse, which is ranked 10th in the IWLCA Coaches' and 12th in the ILWomen media poll, hosts Furman at Ridley Athletic Complex on Sunday afternoon.
- The game was added to Loyola's schedule after its original contest vs. Navy on Saturday was cancelled due to Patriot League division requirements for the Mids.

LAST TIME OUT

- Livy Rosenzweig** became the third in team history to reach 300 career points, **Emily Wills** notched a season-high six points and **Liz Scott** recorded her first collegiate hat trick on her Senior Day as Loyola posted a dominant 20-3 victory over Bucknell last Friday.
- The Greyhounds won their eighth in a row and completed a season sweep of the Bison.
- Sam Fiedler** and **Jillian Wilson** both scored twice in a 7-0 Loyola run to begin the contest. Wilson finished with four points (2 G, 2 A) and four draw controls in the win.
- Kaitlyn Larsson** added eight saves with a season-best .889 save percentage, allowing just one goal while playing the first 39:30 of the contest.
- Scott, **Emily Beier**, **Cat Crowley**, **Caitlyn Gunn**, **Holly Lloyd** and **Meaghan Quinn** were each recognized in a pregame ceremony on their Senior Day, with Crowley making her first collegiate start on the backline.

ROSENZWEIG NAMED TOP-25 SEMIFINALIST FOR TEWAARATON AWARD

- For the second time in her Loyola career, **Livy Rosenzweig** was announced on Thursday as a Top-25 semifinalist for the women's lacrosse Tewaaraton Award.
- The Tewaaraton Award annually honors the top male and female college lacrosse player in the United States. Rosenzweig leads the Greyhounds with 56 points (23 G, 33 A), and she has totaled 5+ points in every contest during Loyola's winning streak.
- Now at 301 career points, she is 17 away from surpassing former teammate Hannah Powers for Loyola's all-time record. Her 167 career assists are also a team record, and she is only 11 assists away from becoming the Patriot League's all-time leader.
- In addition to her offensive prowess, Rosenzweig ranks third in team history with 256 career draw controls. She has won a team-high 55 draws this season.

- Loyola will host the Patriot League Final Four on Thursday, May 6 and Saturday, May 8 at Ridley Athletic Complex.

SERIES HISTORY

- This will be the first meeting between the two sides. Furman's program is in its seventh season of existence, with the Paladins beginning play in 2015.
- This will also be Loyola's first matchup against a member of the Southern Conference, which is comprised of Furman, Coastal Carolina, Delaware State, Mercer and Wofford.

SCOUTING FURMAN

- The Paladins (11-3) take an eight-game winning streak into today's matchup following a 20-4 win at Delaware State on Saturday morning. They have scored an average of 17.6 goals per game during that run, and are ranked 13th overall nationally in scoring offense entering the weekend.
- Furman's last loss was a 13-9 setback on March 20 to an Elon squad currently receiving votes in the IWLCAs and ILWomens polls.
- Sr. A Hannah Demis leads the team with 67 points (21 G, 46 A) and she is ranked third in Division I in assists per game (3.29).
- Furman went 3-4 during the shortened 2020 season, including two matchups against Patriot League opponents. The Paladins fell 10-6 to Lehigh and topped Bucknell by a 19-14 final.

HOMECOMING

- Rachel Shuck Whitten, the only head coach in Furman's women's lacrosse history, makes her return to Baltimore after a standout four year playing career at Loyola in the early 2000's.
- A two-time All-American at Loyola, Whitten helped the Greyhounds advance to three straight NCAA tournaments from 2002-04, including an appearance in the 2003 Final Four.
- She remains ranked fourth all-time at Loyola in career assists (120) after graduating as the program's record holder.
- Whitten was a Tewaaraton Award nominee in each of her final two seasons with the Greyhounds.
- Whitten has guided Furman to an overall record of 67-47 in her first six-plus seasons as head coach, leading the Paladins to the 2018 and 2019 Southern Conference championship games.

QUICK NOTES FROM BUCKNELL

- Eleven different Loyola players scored in Friday's 20-3 victory, with sophomore **Meg Hillman** (2 G) recording her first-career multi-goal game.
- **Elli Kluegel** matched a career-high with three caused turnovers.
- Loyola had a 16-8 edge in draw controls, led by **Livy Rosenzweig** (6), **Katie Detwiler** (5) and **Jillian Wilson** (4)
- **Regan Kilmeyer** led the Greyhounds with a career-best two ground balls.
- Loyola has now outscored opponents by a combined margin of 135-51 during its current eight-game winning streak.
- Loyola is now 17-1 in its last 18 games at Ridley Athletic Complex dating back to the start of the 2019 season.

WEEKLY AWARD FOR LARSSON

- **Kaitlyn Larsson** received her second Patriot League Goalkeeper of the Week award on Monday following her eight-save, .889 save percentage performance against Bucknell.
- Larsson, who has now earned four weekly awards in her Loyola career, limited a Bucknell offense which had scored 30 goals combined in Patriot League victories over American and Colgate in its previous two games
- An ILWomen Second Team Preseason All-American this spring, Larsson now leads the conference and ranks eighth nationally in both goals-against average (8.34) and save percentage (.507)

SEASON-BEST OUTING FROM WILLS

- **Emily Wills** set season-highs in both goals (4) and points (6) during Friday's victory over Bucknell. The four goals were also a new career best for the sophomore attacker.
- Wills, who added hat tricks in consecutive wins over Navy and Lehigh, now ranks fourth overall on the team this season with 23 points (16 G, 7 A).
- A three-time Patriot League weekly award winner during the shortened 2020 season (2x Rookie of the Week, 1x Attacker of the Week), Wills has recorded at least one point in 14 of her 15 collegiate appearances. She had a career-high eight points (3 G, 5 A) in a 19-15 win at No. 9 Penn in the 2020 finale.

MORE ON ROSENZWEIG

- **Livy Rosenzweig** was previously a Tewaaraton Award semifinalist in 2019, when she earned first team IWLCA All-America accolades after setting single-season program records in points (116) and assists (70).
- The Preseason Patriot League Offensive Player of the Year and a US Lacrosse Preseason First Team All-American, Rosenzweig is currently ranked second nationally in assists per game (3.30), and she is eighth in points per game (5.60).
- She has recorded at least one point in 49-consecutive games, she has multiple assists in 47 of 57 career appearances and she has 10 career 8+ point games.

WILSON CONTRIBUTING ACROSS THE FIELD

- **Jillian Wilson** has filled the stat sheet during Loyola's winning run, as she has 28 points (14 G, 14 A), 42 DC, 12 GB and 7 CT in the last eight games.
- Wilson has won at least four draw controls in all eight victories, including a season-high nine draw controls during Loyola's win over No. 24 Drexel.
- Offensively, the 2021 ILWomen Honorable Mention Preseason All-America selection had a career-high six points (3 G, 3 A) in Loyola's victory at Bucknell.

Players' individual phone numbers will not be given to the media at any time. Game day interviews will not be granted until the postgame press conference opportunity. Please give a minimum of 24 hours notice for all requests.

PATRIOT LEAGUE DOMINANCE

- Loyola is 57-0 against Patriot League opponents in regular season play since joining the conference. That run is the longest active win streak in Division I.
- The Greyhounds have outscored Patriot League opposition by a combined 91-27 during their five victories this spring.
- The NCAA record for consecutive conference wins is a 61-game streak by UMass in Atlantic 10 play which began in 2011 and ended on April 22, 2018.
- The Greyhounds claimed Patriot League championships in each of their first three years in the conference (2014-16), and added a fourth postseason title in 2019.

DETWILER ADDED TO TEWAARATON AWARD WATCH LIST

- Jr. D **Katie Detwiler** recently became the third Greyhound added to this year's Tewaaron Award watch list, and she earned her third Patriot League Defensive Player of the Week award of 2021 on April 5.
- Detwiler, the PL Preseason Defensive Player of the Year, has been matched up against three Tewaaron watch list candidates during Loyola's eight-game winning streak, shutting down Drexel's Karson Harris (1 G, 1 A, 3 TO), Navy's Nicole Victory (0 G, 2 A, 3 TO) and Lehigh's Sondra Dickey (3 G, 0 A).
- Detwiler has now received seven weekly Patriot League awards in her career, and she also ranks third on the team in draw controls (29) this season.

KLUEGEL APPROACHING CENTURY MARK

- Elli Kluegel** (1 G, 1 A) extended her goal-scoring streak to eight games vs. Bucknell, and she is now up to 95 goals for her collegiate career, leaving her five away from becoming the 32nd Greyhound to reach 100.

- Senior **Elli Kluegel** was named to the Preseason All-Patriot League Team for a second-consecutive season on Feb. 4.
- Off the field, Kluegel continues to maintain a perfect 4.0 GPA while majoring in biology. A two-time COSIDA Academic All-District honoree, she was also an Academic All-Patriot League selection in 2019.

HIGH-POWERED OFFENSE LAST SPRING

- Loyola's 17.6 goals per game during the shortened 2020 season ranked sixth in all of Division I. The Greyhounds scored at least 14 goals in all five victories, and outscored opponents by an overall margin of 88-50.
- Loyola was also ranked in the top 10 nationally in assists (8.8) and draw controls (16.6) per game.
- The Greyhounds made the most of their scoring attempts, with **Emily Wills** (5th, .706) and **Jillian Wilson** (12th, .654) among the nation's leaders in shot percentage. **Sam Fiedler**, who led DI with a .671 shot percentage in 2019, was not far behind at .576 last spring.

DETWILER, ROSENZWEIG INVITED TO U.S. NATIONAL TEAM TRYOUTS

- Katie Detwiler** and **Livy Rosenzweig** were two of 50 candidates across the country invited to compete for spots on the U.S. National Team at the 2022 World Championships. The tryouts, originally scheduled for December 2020, will now take place later in 2021, with the World Championships scheduled for June 29-July 9, 2022 in Towson, Md.
- Detwiler was previously part of the U.S. U19 training team in 2019. She was one of just three sophomores in the nation named to the Tewaaraton Award Watch List last season.

FIFTH YEAR RETURNEES

- Two Loyola players are taking advantage of the extra year of eligibility granted by the NCAA following the shortened 2020 season, as **Holly Lloyd** and **Meaghan Quinn** both return for the Greyhounds this spring.
- Lloyd started all five games on attack for the Greyhounds last season, while Quinn was a key contributor on the backline, earning her first three collegiate starts to conclude the year.
- Caitlyn Gunn**, who was already set to return this season after taking a medical redshirt in 2018, is also back as a graduate student after totaling three goals and two assists in a reserve attack role last spring.

STRONG DEBUT FOR CLEVINGER

- Shay Clevenger** joined Loyola as a transfer in 2020 after spending her freshman season at Louisville, and the Woodstock, Md., native quickly made herself at home with the Greyhounds.
- Clevenger led the Patriot League and ranked 22nd nationally with 3.2 ground balls per game. She had 16 ground balls overall and was also tied for the team lead with seven caused turnovers.
- Clevenger was honored as PL Defender of the Week after picking up a career-high six ground balls and causing two turnovers in the season finale at Penn.

SMART HOUNDS

- Loyola has a cumulative team GPA of 3.63, including an impressive 3.76 average during the 2020 fall semester. That semester total was the highest among Loyola's 10 women's programs.
- Emily Beier**, **Catie Corolla**, **Caitlyn Gunn**, **Meg Hillman** and **Elli Kluegel** all recorded perfect 4.0 GPA's, while **D.A. Coss** (3.93), **Sam Fiedler** (3.93), **Regan Kiemeyer** (3.93), **Anna Ruby** (3.92), **Izzy Sedwick** (3.94) and **Jillian Wilson** (3.93) were all above a 3.9.
- Kluegel and Corolla both have cumulative 4.0 GPA's; Kluegel is the lone senior Loyola student-athlete to maintain a cumulative 4.0 average.

HEAD COACH JEN ADAMS

Innovative. Difference-Maker. Creative. Stellar. Spectacular: All words used to describe Jen Adams throughout her illustrious playing career on the collegiate and international levels. Those same adjectives hold true for her coaching and leadership styles as she enters her 13th season at the helm of the Loyola women's lacrosse program in 2021.

AT LOYOLA

Entering the 2021 season, Adams has a career record of 158-66 in 12 years. During the 2020 campaign, which was shortened due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Greyhounds were a perfect 5-0 on the year, defeating four ranked opponents and earning their highest end-of-year national ranking (No. 3) in the IWLCA Coaches' poll since 2003.

Since coming to Loyola, Adams has directed a resurgence of the program back to national prominence. Her 2011 squad won its first of two-straight BIG EAST Championships, returned to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2004 and tied a school record for wins in a season, posting a 17-3 record.

In conference play, Adams' squads have dominated. In the last seven completed seasons, her teams have posted an overall record of 58-2 in regular-season conference contests, including an unblemished 52-0 mark in Patriot League play for six-straight undefeated Patriot League Regular Season titles - the longest active win streak in the NCAA. Her Greyhounds have also claimed six league tournament titles - back-to-back BIG EAST Championships (2011, 2012) and four Patriot League titles (2014, 2015, 2016, 2019). The BIG EAST title in 2011 was the first for the program, while 2014 win was the school's first-ever Patriot League Championship, a League it joined for the 2013-14 school year.

Nationally, nine of Adams' squads have began the season ranked in the top-15 of the IWLCA Preseason Coaches Poll, while Loyola's stretch of four-straight years ranked in the preseason top-10 made the Greyhounds one of just seven programs in the NCAA to be ranked among the nation's top-10 teams from 2012-15.

As a member of the BIG EAST Conference, Adams picked up co-BIG EAST Coach of the Year honors in 2011 and led the Greyhounds to back-to-back BIG EAST Tournament titles, a 27-12 record in conference games and a 4-2 mark in tournament action.

Adams didn't miss a beat in transitioning to the Patriot League in 2014. Tabbed as the League's preseason favorite each of her first eight years, Adams has been named the League's Coach of the Year five times (2014, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019) and brought 14 major awards to the Greyhounds,

BEFORE LOYOLA

Prior to coming to Loyola, Adams served as the associate head coach under Cathy Reese at the University of Maryland during the 2007 and 2008 seasons. She was also an assistant to Reese at the University of Denver from 2004-06.

COACHING INTERNATIONALLY

Adams took a break from the college game during the summer of 2012 and 2015 and assisted her sister, Trish, at the Under-19 World Championships. The Adams duo led the U-19 Australian National Team to a silver medal in 2012 and to the semifinals in 2015. She served as the Australian's U-19 Co-Head Coach with former Greyhound Stacey (Morlang) Sullivan at the 2019 World Championships.

AS A PLAYER

Adams is regarded as the finest female lacrosse player of all time. Putting together arguably the greatest collegiate women's lacrosse career in the sport's history, Adams led Maryland to four-straight national titles from 1998-2001, including a 21-0 record in 1999 and a 23-0 mark in 2001. She racked up honors like she scored goals and recorded assists, and was named to the NCAA Division I Women's Lacrosse 25th Anniversary Team in April 2007.

The Brighton, South Australia native, was a three-time national player of the year and was the first recipient of the Tewaaraton Trophy in 2001. She set every scoring record for the Terrapins - season and career - finishing her storied career with 267 goals, 178 assists and 445 total points. Her marks for total points stands today as an NCAA record and her goals

total is still a record at Maryland.

In addition to her career marks, Adams had single-season performances that also rank amongst the best in Maryland and NCAA history. During her Tewaaraton-winning senior season, Adams led the nation with 88 goals, 60 assists and 148 total points, setting school single-season marks in the process. Those season totals only added her name one rung higher, as she had set school records with 81 goals, 55 assists and 136 total points the previous season.

Adams' efforts were not limited just to the lacrosse field. In addition to her three All-America honors as a player, Adams earned the 2000 and 2001 Honda/Broderick Award for women's lacrosse excellence in the classroom and on the field. She also garnered CoSIDA Academic All-America First Team honors as a senior, was named the National Attacker of the Year in 1999, 2000 and 2001 and the Atlantic Coast Conference Female Athlete of the Year in 2000 and 2001.
