THE MATCHUP

- Loyola women's lacrosse, which is ranked 14th in the IWLCA Coaches' poll and 18th in the ILWomen media poll welcomes Georgetown to Ridley Athletic Complex.
- Aside from last year's meeting, which was cancelled due to COVID-19, the two teams have faced off in every season dating back to 2006.

LAST TIME OUT

- Livy Rosenzweig** recorded six of her game-high seven points in the first half, as Loyola raced out to a 15-3 advantage at the intermission before ultimately securing a 21-4 home victory over American in the Patriot League opener for both sides on Saturday.
- Eleven different players scored for the Greyhounds, whose 15 goals were the program's most in a half since they also had 15 in a win over Lafayette back on April 22, 2017.
- Sam Fiedler** (3 G, 1 A) supplied four points, and she also led the way with three ground balls and a career-high three caused turnovers.
- Emily Wills** scored a season-high three goals, **Katie Detwiler** had a career-best seven draw controls and **Holly Lloyd** added her second-straight three-assist game.
- Loyola led 17-13 in ground balls, 32-14 in shots and 19-8 in draw controls.

2-0 WEEK LEADS TO FOUR PATRIOT LEAGUE AWARDS



- Livy Rosenzweig** (Attacker), **Sam Fiedler** (Midfielder), **Katie Detwiler** (Defender) and **Kaitlyn Larsson** (Goalkeeper) all received Patriot League weekly awards on Monday after a 2-0 week in which the Greyhounds outscored their opponents 39-10.
- Rosenzweig had a team-high 16 points (10 G, 6 A) in the two wins. At 144 career assists, she is just four away from matching Annie Thomas '15 for the program record.
- Detwiler led a defensive unit which allowed only 10 goals last week. Matched up against American's Emma Vinall on Saturday, an ILWomen honorable mention Pre-season All-American and the NCAA leader in goals scored last season, she limited Vinall to one point (0 G, 1 A) to snap a 17-game goal scoring streak.
- Larsson finished the week with 14 saves, a 5.22 goals-against average and a .583 save percentage. Her .600 save percentage vs. American was a new season-high.
- Fiedler totaled 11 points (8 G, 3 A) in the victories and has a team-high 14 G through four games.

LOOKING AHEAD

- Loyola is scheduled to resume Patriot League play with a 12 p.m. matchup at Navy on Saturday.

SERIES HISTORY

- Loyola leads 12-9 in a series which dates back to 1977.
- The Greyhounds have won six-straight in the series, including a 13-10 victory in the most-recent meeting on March 20, 2019.
- Each of the last 13 games between the two sides have been decided by four goals or fewer.
- Georgetown's last victory in the series was a 16-14 triumph in the 2013 Big East championship game.

SCOUTING GEORGETOWN

- The Hoyas have split their first two games this season, falling 21-9 to Drexel in their opener on Feb. 27 and earning a 14-8 win at Delaware last Friday.
- Georgetown was projected to finish second out of six schools in the 2021 Big East preseason poll.
- Gr. M Natalia Lynch, one of four Preseason All-Big East selections, has 218 career draw controls. She is six away from becoming the program's all-time leader in that category.
- Georgetown won its first Big East title since 2010 during the last full season in 2019, ultimately advancing to the second round of the NCAA tournament before falling 14-8 to Syracuse.

ROSENZWEIG MILESTONE WATCH

- Livy Rosenzweig** has totaled 144 assists in 51 collegiate games, a total which is No. 2 all-time at Loyola (four back of 2015 graduate Annie Thomas) and fourth all-time in the Patriot League (33 behind Navy's Kelly Larkin).
- Rosenzweig has recorded multiple assists in all four games this season, and in 42 of 51 collegiate appearances overall.
- Rosenzweig is also No. 7 all-time at Loyola in points (265). She is 12 back of Marlee Paton '14 in 6th and 52 behind former teammate Hannah Powers '19 for the top spot.
- In the 2020 finale, Rosenzweig became the third Greyhound to reach 200 career draw controls. Her 217 draws are behind only sisters Taylor VanThof '19 (392) and Taryn VanThof '15 (318).

OFFENSE RISING UP NATIONAL RANKINGS

- After scoring 39 goals in victories over Villanova and American last week, Loyola now ranks third in Division I in shot percentage (53.1) and fifth in assists per game (8.25).
- The Greyhounds led the country in both categories back in 2019, finishing with a shot percentage of 51.3 and averaging 9.38 assists per game.
- Sam Fiedler**, the DI leader in shot percentage (67.1) in 2019, is currently 19th nationally this winter at 66.7 percent.
- Livy Rosenzweig was third in DI in total assists (70) in 2019, and her 10 assists this season are currently tied for 11th in the country.

QUICK NOTES FROM AMERICAN

- Rosenzweig (4 G, 3 A) recorded her 13th career 7+ point game.
- Alanna Wray** (2 G), **Sydni Black** and **Meg Hillman** all scored their first collegiate goals.
- Loyola's 21 goals were a season-high and the most since a 22-12 victory at #19 Penn State on Feb. 29 last season.
- Jillian Wilson** added two goals, one assist and four draw controls. She totaled 4 G, 4 A, and 8 DC in Loyola's two victories last week.
- The Greyhounds improved to 22-0 all-time vs. American and 53-0 all-time in the regular season against Patriot League opponents.
- Making her second collegiate appearance, **D.A. Coss** picked up her first two collegiate ground balls.
- Freshmen **Caitlin McGuirk**, **Camryn Chew**, **Izzy Sedwick**, **Sarah Engle**, **Blake Cunneen** and **Izzy D'Antonio** all made their collegiate debuts.

KLUEGEL FILLS UP THE STAT SHEET

- Elli Kluegel** was involved on both sides of the field last week, totaling six points (4 G, 2 A), six ground balls and four caused turnovers for the Greyhounds.
- Kluegel leads the team with 11 ground balls overall on the year, she is tied for second in caused turnovers (5) and she is fifth in points (7)

GOALS KEEP COMING FOR FIEDLER

- Sam Fiedler** has now scored 3+ goals in seven-consecutive games dating back to last season. Fiedler has totaled a team-high 37 points (30 G, 7 A) during that stretch.
- Fiedler's Patriot League Midfielder of the Week award was the second in her Loyola career. She has 116 goals in 51 games at Loyola, and she has scored at least one goal in 42-straight contests.
- Fiedler also now leads the team in caused turnovers (6) after forcing three American giveaways on Saturday.

BACK ON TRACK AT RIDLEY

- After Loyola saw a 12-game home winning streak with its season-opening defeat to Syracuse, the Greyhounds returned to their winning ways at Ridley Athletic Complex on Saturday.
- Loyola is now 75-23 all-time at Ridley since the facility opened in 2010.
- The Greyhounds have a 22-4 record at home dating back to the start of the 2018 season.

PRESEASON ACCOLADES

- Loyola topped the Patriot League preseason poll for an eighth-consecutive season, with the Greyhounds receiving 162 points and all 18 available first-place votes.
- Livy Rosenzweig** was named Patriot League Preseason Offensive Player of the Year for a second time (previously in 2019), while **Katie Detwiler** earned Preseason Defensive Player of the Year accolades.
- Rosenzweig, Detwiler, **Sam Fiedler**, **Elli Kluegel** and **Jillian Wilson** were all Preseason All-Patriot League selections.
- Rosenzweig and Detwiler were two of US Lacrosse's 13 First Team Preseason All-Americans announced in December.
- Rosenzweig, Detwiler and **Kaitlyn Larsson** were all ILWomen Second Team Preseason All-Americans. Fiedler and **Shay Clevenger** landed on the third team, while Wilson received honorable mention recognition.

CONDENSED SCHEDULE INCLUDES SEVEN GAMES AT RIDLEY

- In response to the continuing COVID-19 pandemic, Loyola and the Patriot League have instituted several changes to the 2021 lacrosse schedule.
- Consistent with the prioritization of health and safety, the 12-game schedule features reductions in travel and overnight stays. Loyola has five non-conference opponents currently on the schedule, with three taking place at Ridley Athletic Complex and the other two short trips to Towson and Villanova.
- The Patriot League is split into two five-team divisions, with Loyola grouped in the South with American, Bucknell, Lehigh and Navy.
- The top two teams in each division advance to the PL tournament, with semi-final games set for May 6 and the championship scheduled for May 8.

HIGH-POWERED OFFENSE LAST SPRING

- Loyola's 17.6 goals per game during the shortened 2020 season ranked sixth in all of Division I. The Greyhounds scored at least 14 goals in all five victories, and outscored opponents by an overall margin of 88-50.
- Loyola was also ranked in the top 10 nationally in assists (8.8) and draw controls (16.6) per game.
- The Greyhounds made the most of their scoring attempts, with **Emily Wills** (5th, .706) and **Jillian Wilson** (12th, .654) among the nation's leaders in shot percentage. **Sam Fiedler**, who led DI with a .671 shot percentage in 2019, was not far behind at .576 last spring.

MORE ROSENZWEIG NOTES

- Livy Rosenzweig** became the first Greyhound to earn IWLCA first team All-America accolades since 2012 following a 2019 season in which she broke program records in both points (116) and assists (70).
- She ranked third in Division I in assists, and she was fourth nationally in points that season. She also helped Loyola lead DI as a team in both total assists (197) and assists per game (9.38).
- Rosenzweig has totaled 5+ points in 31 of 50 collegiate games, including 4 of 5 contests in 2020. She has recorded multiple points in 49 of 50 appearances.

KLUEGEL EXCELS ON, OFF THE FIELD

- Senior **Elli Kluegel** was named to the Preseason All-Patriot League Team for a second-consecutive season on Feb. 4. Her 15 goals ranked third on the team in 2020, and she now has 82 goals in 50 career appearances.
- Off the field, Kluegel continues to maintain a perfect 4.0 GPA while majoring in biology. A two-time COSIDA Academic All-District honoree, she was also an Academic All-Patriot League selection in 2019.

WILLS HOPES TO BUILD ON STRONG FRESHMEN CAMPAIGN

- **Emily Wills** burst onto the scene during her debut collegiate season last spring, totaling 21 points (12 G, 9 A) while leading the Patriot League and ranking fifth nationally in shot percentage (.706).
- Wills was named PL Rookie of the Week after collecting five points (3 G, 2 A) in her debut vs. Johns Hopkins.
- She would add both PL Attacker and Rookie of the Week honors after managing a season-high eight points (3 G, 5 A) in the finale at Penn.

LARSSON RETURNS BETWEEN THE PIPES

- **Kaitlyn Larsson** made the most of her first five collegiate starts in goal last season, as she finished a perfect 5-0 with 53 saves, a .525 save percentage (9th in Division I) and a 9.78 goals-against average.
- Larsson made double-digit saves in four of Loyola's victories, matching a career-high with 12 in wins over Johns Hopkins (2/15) and Penn (3/7).

DETWILER, ROSENZWEIG INVITED TO U.S. NATIONAL TEAM TRYOUTS

- **Katie Detwiler** and **Livy Rosenzweig** were two of 50 candidates across the country invited to compete for spots on the U.S. National Team at the 2022 World Championships.
- The tryouts, originally scheduled for December 2020, will now take place later in 2021, with the World Championships scheduled for June 29-July 9, 2022 in Towson, Md.
- Detwiler was previously part of the U.S. U19 training team in 2019. She was one of just three sophomores in the nation named to the Tewaaron Award Watch List last season.

FIFTH YEAR RETURNEES

- Two Loyola players are taking advantage of the extra year of eligibility granted by the NCAA following the shortened 2020 season, as **Holly Lloyd** and **Meaghan Quinn** both return for the Greyhounds this spring.
- Lloyd started all five games on attack for the Greyhounds last season, while Quinn was a key contributor on the backline, earning her first three collegiate starts to conclude the year.
- **Caitlyn Gunn**, who was already set to return this season after taking a medical redshirt in 2018, is also back as a graduate student after totaling three goals and two assists in a reserve attack role last spring.

STRONG DEBUT FOR CLEVINGER

- **Shay Clevenger** joined Loyola as a transfer in 2020 after spending her freshman season at Louisville, and the Woodstock, Md., native quickly made herself at home with the Greyhounds.
- Clevenger led the Patriot League and ranked 22nd nationally with 3.2 ground balls per game. She had 16 ground balls overall and was also tied for the team lead with seven caused turnovers.
- Clevenger was honored as PL Defender of the Week after picking up a career-high six ground balls and causing two turnovers in the season finale at Penn.

SMART HOUNDS

- Loyola has a cumulative team GPA of 3.63, including an impressive 3.76 average during the 2020 fall semester. That semester total was the highest among Loyola's 10 women's programs.
- **Emily Beier**, **Catie Corolla**, **Caitlyn Gunn**, **Meg Hillman** and **Elli Kluegel** all recorded perfect 4.0 GPA's, while **D.A. Coss** (3.93), **Sam Fiedler** (3.93), **Regan Kilmeyer** (3.93), **Anna Ruby** (3.92), **Izzy Sedwick** (3.94) and **Jillian Wilson** (3.93) were all above a 3.9.
- Kluegel and Corolla both have cumulative 4.0 GPA's; Kluegel is the lone senior Loyola student-athlete to maintain a cumulative 4.0 average.

2021 CAPTAINS

- **Katie Detwiler**, **Elli Kluegel**, **Holly Lloyd** and **Livy Rosenzweig** will serve as Loyola's team captains for the 2021 season.
- The group is comprised of one graduate student (Lloyd), two seniors (Kluegel, Rosenzweig) and one junior (Detwiler). All four were previously captains for the shortened 2020 campaign.

HEAD COACH JEN ADAMS

Innovative. Difference-Maker. Creative. Stellar. Spectacular: All words used to describe Jen Adams throughout her illustrious playing career on the collegiate and international levels. Those same adjectives hold true for her coaching and leadership styles as she enters her 13th season at the helm of the Loyola women's lacrosse program in 2021.

AT LOYOLA

Entering the 2021 season, Adams has a career record of 158-66 in 12 years. During the 2020 campaign, which was shortened due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Greyhounds were a perfect 5-0 on the year, defeating four ranked opponents and earning their highest end-of-year national ranking (No. 3) in the IWLCA Coaches' poll since 2003.

Since coming to Loyola, Adams has directed a resurgence of the program back to national prominence. Her 2011 squad won its first of two-straight BIG EAST Championships, returned to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2004 and tied a school record for wins in a season, posting a 17-3 record.

In conference play, Adams' squads have dominated. In the last seven completed seasons, her teams have posted an overall record of 58-2 in regular-season conference contests, including an unblemished 52-0 mark in Patriot League play for six-straight undefeated Patriot League Regular Season titles - the longest active win streak in the NCAA. Her Greyhounds have also claimed six league tournament titles - back-to-back BIG EAST Championships (2011, 2012) and four Patriot League titles (2014, 2015, 2016, 2019). The BIG EAST title in 2011 was the first for the program, while 2014 win was the school's first-ever Patriot League Championship, a League it joined for the 2013-14 school year.

Nationally, nine of Adams' squads have began the season ranked in the top-15 of the IWLCA Preseason Coaches Poll, while Loyola's stretch of four-straight years ranked in the preseason top-10 made the Greyhounds one of just seven programs in the NCAA to be ranked among the nation's top-10 teams from 2012-15.

As a member of the BIG EAST Conference, Adams picked up co-BIG EAST Coach of the Year honors in 2011 and led the Greyhounds to back-to-back BIG EAST Tournament titles, a 27-12 record in conference games and a 4-2 mark in tournament action.

Adams didn't miss a beat in transitioning to the Patriot League in 2014. Tabbed as the League's preseason favorite each of her first eight years, Adams has been named the League's Coach of the Year five times (2014, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019) and brought 14 major awards to the Greyhounds,

BEFORE LOYOLA

Prior to coming to Loyola, Adams served as the associate head coach under Cathy Reese at the University of Maryland during the 2007 and 2008 seasons. She was also an assistant to Reese at the University of Denver from 2004-06.

COACHING INTERNATIONALLY

Adams took a break from the college game during the summer of 2012 and 2015 and assisted her sister, Trish, at the Under-19 World Championships. The Adams duo led the U-19 Australian National Team to a silver medal in 2012 and to the semifinals in 2015. She served as the Australian's U-19 Co-Head Coach with former Greyhound Stacey (Morlang) Sullivan at the 2019 World Championships.

AS A PLAYER

Adams is regarded as the finest female lacrosse player of all time. Putting together arguably the greatest collegiate women's lacrosse career in the sport's history, Adams led Maryland to four-straight national titles from 1998-2001, including a 21-0 record in 1999 and a 23-0 mark in 2001. She racked up honors like she scored goals and recorded assists, and was named to the NCAA Division I Women's Lacrosse 25th Anniversary Team in April 2007.

The Brighton, South Australia native, was a three-time national player of the year and was the first recipient of the Tewaaraton Trophy in 2001. She set every scoring record for the Terrapins - season and career - finishing her storied career with 267 goals, 178 assists and 445 total points. Her marks for total points stands today as an NCAA record and her goals

total is still a record at Maryland.

In addition to her career marks, Adams had single-season performances that also rank amongst the best in Maryland and NCAA history. During her Tewaaraton-winning senior season, Adams led the nation with 88 goals, 60 assists and 148 total points, setting school single-season marks in the process. Those season totals only added her name one rung higher, as she had set school records with 81 goals, 55 assists and 136 total points the previous season.

Adams' efforts were not limited just to the lacrosse field. In addition to her three All-America honors as a player, Adams earned the 2000 and 2001 Honda/Broderick Award for women's lacrosse excellence in the classroom and on the field. She also garnered CoSIDA Academic All-America First Team honors as a senior, was named the National Attacker of the Year in 1999, 2000 and 2001 and the Atlantic Coast Conference Female Athlete of the Year in 2000 and 2001.
