THE MATCHUP

- Loyola women's lacrosse, which is ranked 13th in the IWLCA Coaches' poll and 12th in the ILWomen media poll, takes on #21/#17 Navy in a Patriot League South division matchup Wednesday afternoon.
- The Greyhounds have won five-consecutive games, including a 21-3 win at Bucknell on March 20, while the Mids are coming off a 13-12 victory over Army on Saturday.

LAST TIME OUT

- Livy Rosenzweig** broke the program's all-time career record with the first of her seven assists, and **Sam Fiedler** matched a career-high with eight points (4 G, 4 A) in Loyola's dominant win over Bucknell.
- Rosenzweig now holds seven program records (career assists, single-season assists and points, single-game assists, and three freshman records: points, assists and draws).
- Jillian Wilson** (3 G, 3 A) added a career high six points, while **Regan Kilmeyer** and **D.A. Coss** each scored the first two goals of their collegiate careers and **Holly Lloyd** (3 G) recorded her second collegiate hat trick.
- Fiedler led the defensive effort as well with two ground balls and a career high four caused turnovers.
- Kaitlyn Larsson** made eight saves and recorded a season-best .727 save percentage in goal.

MORE MILESTONES IN SIGHT FOR ROSENZWEIG



- Livy Rosenzweig's** 155 assists have come in just 54 collegiate appearances. She is fourth all-time in the Patriot League, 22 behind all-time leader Kelly Larkin from Navy.
- Rosenzweig has recorded multiple assists in six out of seven games this season, and in 43 of 54 collegiate appearances overall.
- Rosenzweig is also No. 6 all-time at Loyola in points (283). She is one back of Janet Eisenhut '83 in 5th and 34 behind former teammate Hannah Powers '19 for the top spot.
- The Patriot League Preseason Offensive Player of the Year, Rosenzweig is a three-time ILWomen All-American (first team in 2020) and a two-time IWLCA All-American (first team in 2019).

LOOKING AHEAD

- Loyola returns to Ridley Athletic Complex on Saturday, hosting Lehigh in another South division matchup at 1 p.m.

SERIES HISTORY

- Loyola leads 9-3 in a series which dates back to the Greyhounds joining the Patriot League back in 2014.
- The two teams have met in each of the last five Patriot League Championship games. Loyola has won three of those five matchups, including a 21-9 victory in the 2019 final on May 7.
- The Greyhounds have won all six regular season meetings, including a 16-6 victory at Ridley on April 6, 2019.
- The other win for Navy in the series was a 19-15 triumph in the second round of the NCAA tournament on May 13, 2018.

SCOUTING NAVY

- The Mids (4-0 overall, 1-0 PL, 0-0 South) returned to action for the first time since Feb. 27 with their comeback victory over Army on Saturday. Navy scored the game's final three goals after trailing 12-10 with less than 11 minutes remaining.
- Nicole Victory provided the game-winner with 3:46 left on Saturday, and the Tewaaron Award watch list selection leads the team with 18 points (13 G, 5 A) overall on the year.
- Victory, Regan Roelofs (10 pts, 25 DC, 7 GB) and Gil Eby (4 pts, 7 DC, 5 GB) were all Preseason All-Patriot League honorees.
- Fr. GK Jo Torres was named Patriot League Goalkeeper and Rookie of the Week after making 10 saves off the bench during the second half of Saturday's victory.

PATRIOT LEAGUE DOMINANCE

- Loyola is 54-0 against Patriot League opponents in regular season play since joining the conference, defeating American and Bucknell by a combined 42-7 in their first two league games this season. That run is the longest active win streak in Division I.
- The NCAA record for consecutive conference wins is a 61-game streak by UMass in Atlantic 10 play which began in 2011 and ended on April 22, 2018.
- The Greyhounds claimed Patriot League championships in each of their first three years in the conference (2014-16), and added a fourth postseason title in 2019.

QUICK NOTES FROM BUCKNELL

- Loyola had an 18-7 edge in draw controls, with **Livy Rosenzweig** (10) and **Jillian Wilson** (5) combining for 15 of the 18 draws. Rosenzweig matched a career-high, reaching double figures for the first time since Feb. 25, 2018.
- Sydney Foster** scored her first two goals of the season late in the first half.
- Loyola has now outscored opponents by an 86-31 margin during its current five-game winning run.
- The Greyhounds have held Patriot League opponents to single digit scoring in 12 of 13 games (regular and postseason) dating back to the start of 2019.
- Eleven different players scored a goal in the victory.

QUINN EARNS SECOND PATRIOT LEAGUE WEEKLY AWARD

- Meaghan Quinn** was chosen as the Patriot League's Defensive Player of the Week for a second time this season after totaling two caused turnovers and one ground ball at Bucknell.
- After missing the previous three games, Quinn was matched up against Bucknell's Katie Wendell in her return to the lineup. She held Wendell, who had 11 points in the Bison's first two games, to no points on just one shot.
- Quinn has caused multiple turnovers in 3 of 4 appearances this spring, and she leads the team in both GB (2.0) and CT (1.75) per game.

LARSSON RISING UP GOALTENDING RANKINGS

- Kaitlyn Larsson** has put up impressive numbers in goal recently, posting a 5-0 record with 43 saves, a 6.31 GAA and a .581 save percentage during Loyola's current winning streak.
- She has held opponents to single digit scoring in 4 of 5 victories, posting a career-high 14 saves during a 9-6 win over Georgetown on March 6.
- For the season as a whole, Larsson is 14th nationally (3rd in the PL) with an 8.97 GAA, and she is 17th nationally (1st in the PL) with a .496 save pct.
- Larsson is 13-2 overall in her career (8-1 vs. ranked opponents) with an 7.88 GAA, .541 save percentage and 186 saves.

NATIONAL RANKINGS UPDATE

- After having a bye week in its Patriot League schedule, Loyola maintained its No. 13 ranking in the IWLCA Coaches' poll, while the Greyhounds rose one spot to No. 12 in the ILWomen media rankings.
- Loyola has been ranked as high as No. 4 in the IWLCA and No. 5 in the ILWomen polls this season. The Greyhounds were No. 3 in all national polls at the conclusion of the 2020 season.

KLUEGEL APPROACHING CENTURY MARK

- Elli Kluegel** opened the scoring in Loyola's win at Bucknell, and she is now up to 91 goals for her collegiate career, leaving her nine away from becoming the 32nd Greyhound to reach 100.
- Kluegel has totaled 11 goals during Loyola's current five-game win streak, and she continues to lead the Greyhounds with 16 ground balls on the year.
- Kluegel recorded her second career five-point game during Loyola's 17-12 win over No. 24 Drexel on March 14, matching a five-goal performance which she first achieved during the 2019 NCAA tournament vs. Richmond.

DETWILER CONTINUES TO PERFORM DEFENSIVELY

- **Katie Detwiler** supplied three draw controls in Loyola's win at Bucknell, and she held the Bison's leading goal scorer (defending PL Midfielder of the Week Julia Bradbury) without a single shot on the afternoon.
- Detwiler earned her second Patriot League Defender of the Week of 2021 (sixth overall) on March 15 after a pair of shutdown performances on Georgetown's Michaela Bruno (0 pts, snapping 23-game streak) and Tewaaron Award watch list candidate Karson Harris from Drexel (1 G on 3 shots).
- The 2021 Patriot League Preseason Defensive Player of the Year and a 2020 Tewaaron Award watch list honoree, Detwiler has started all 33 games in her collegiate career, totaling 41 draws, 40 ground balls and 21 caused turnovers.

FIEDLER, ROSENZWEIG NAMED TO TEWAARATON AWARD WATCH LIST

- Seniors **Sam Fiedler** and **Livy Rosenzweig** were each included in the group of 57 initial watch list candidates announced on March 11 for the 2021 Tewaaron Award. Both were on the 2020 watch list as well, and Rosenzweig was also a Top-25 semifinalist for the award as a sophomore in 2019.
- Rosenzweig leads the Greyhounds with 38 points (17 G, 21 A) and 39 draw controls. Fiedler is just behind with 37 points (25 G, 12 A), and she also leads the team with 11 caused turnovers.

PRESEASON ACCOLADES

- Loyola topped the Patriot League preseason poll for an eighth-consecutive season, with the Greyhounds receiving 162 points and all 18 available first-place votes.
- **Livy Rosenzweig** was named Patriot League Preseason Offensive Player of the Year for a second time (previously in 2019), while **Katie Detwiler** earned Preseason Defensive Player of the Year accolades.
- Rosenzweig, Detwiler, **Sam Fiedler**, **Elli Kluegel** and **Jillian Wilson** were all Preseason All-Patriot League selections.
- Rosenzweig and Detwiler were two of US Lacrosse's 13 First Team Preseason All-Americans announced in December.
- Rosenzweig, Detwiler and **Kaitlyn Larsson** were all ILWomen Second Team Preseason All-Americans. Fiedler and **Shay Clevenger** landed on the third team, while Wilson received honorable mention recognition.

- Rosenzweig has totaled 5+ points in 34 of 54 collegiate games, and she has recorded multiple points in 53 of 54 appearances.

KLUEGEL EXCELS ON, OFF THE FIELD

- Senior **Elli Kluegel** was named to the Preseason All-Patriot League Team for a second-consecutive season on Feb. 4. Her 15 goals ranked third on the team in 2020, and she now has 91 goals in 54 career appearances.
- Off the field, Kluegel continues to maintain a perfect 4.0 GPA while majoring in biology. A two-time COSIDA Academic All-District honoree, she was also an Academic All-Patriot League selection in 2019.

HIGH-POWERED OFFENSE LAST SPRING

- Loyola's 17.6 goals per game during the shortened 2020 season ranked sixth in all of Division I. The Greyhounds scored at least 14 goals in all five victories, and outscored opponents by an overall margin of 88-50.
- Loyola was also ranked in the top 10 nationally in assists (8.8) and draw controls (16.6) per game.
- The Greyhounds made the most of their scoring attempts, with **Emily Wills** (5th, .706) and **Jillian Wilson** (12th, .654) among the nation's leaders in shot percentage. **Sam Fiedler**, who led DI with a .671 shot percentage in 2019, was not far behind at .576 last spring.

LARSSON RETURNS BETWEEN THE PIPES

- Kaitlyn Larsson** made the most of her first five collegiate starts in goal last season, as she finished a perfect 5-0 with 53 saves, a .525 save percentage (9th in Division I) and a 9.78 goals-against average.
- Larsson made double-digit saves in four of Loyola's victories, matching a career-high with 12 in wins over Johns Hopkins (2/15) and Penn (3/7).

DETWILER, ROSENZWEIG INVITED TO U.S. NATIONAL TEAM TRYOUTS

- Katie Detwiler** and **Livy Rosenzweig** were two of 50 candidates across the country invited to compete for spots on the U.S. National Team at the 2022 World Championships. The tryouts, originally scheduled for December 2020, will now take place later in 2021, with the World Championships scheduled for June 29-July 9, 2022 in Towson, Md.
- Detwiler was previously part of the U.S. U19 training team in 2019. She was one of just three sophomores in the nation named to the Tewaaraton Award Watch List last season.

FIFTH YEAR RETURNEES

- Two Loyola players are taking advantage of the extra year of eligibility granted by the NCAA following the shortened 2020 season, as **Holly Lloyd** and **Meaghan Quinn** both return for the Greyhounds this spring.
- Lloyd started all five games on attack for the Greyhounds last season, while Quinn was a key contributor on the backline, earning her first three collegiate starts to conclude the year.
- Caitlyn Gunn**, who was already set to return this season after taking a medical redshirt in 2018, is also back as a graduate student after totaling three goals and two assists in a reserve attack role last spring.

STRONG DEBUT FOR CLEVINGER

- Shay Clevenger** joined Loyola as a transfer in 2020 after spending her freshman season at Louisville, and the Woodstock, Md., native quickly made herself at home with the Greyhounds.
- Clevenger led the Patriot League and ranked 22nd nationally with 3.2 ground balls per game. She had 16 ground balls overall and was also tied for the team lead with seven caused turnovers.
- Clevenger was honored as PL Defender of the Week after picking up a career-high six ground balls and causing two turnovers in the season finale at Penn.

SMART HOUNDS

- Loyola has a cumulative team GPA of 3.63, including an impressive 3.76 average during the 2020 fall semester. That semester total was the highest among Loyola's 10 women's programs.
- Emily Beier**, **Catie Corolla**, **Caitlyn Gunn**, **Meg Hillman** and **Elli Kluegel** all recorded perfect 4.0 GPA's, while **D.A. Coss** (3.93), **Sam Fiedler** (3.93), **Regan Kilmeyer** (3.93), **Anna Ruby** (3.92), **Izzy Sedwick** (3.94) and **Jillian Wilson** (3.93) were all above a 3.9.
- Kluegel and Corolla both have cumulative 4.0 GPA's; Kluegel is the lone senior Loyola student-athlete to maintain a cumulative 4.0 average.

- Katie Detwiler**, **Elli Kluegel**, **Holly Lloyd** and **Livy Rosenzweig** will serve as Loyola's team captains for the 2021 season.
- The group is comprised of one graduate student (Lloyd), two seniors (Kluegel, Rosenzweig) and one junior (Detwiler). All four were previously captains for the shortened 2020 campaign.

HEAD COACH JEN ADAMS

Innovative. Difference-Maker. Creative. Stellar. Spectacular: All words used to describe Jen Adams throughout her illustrious playing career on the collegiate and international levels. Those same adjectives hold true for her coaching and leadership styles as she enters her 13th season at the helm of the Loyola women's lacrosse program in 2021.

AT LOYOLA

Entering the 2021 season, Adams has a career record of 158-66 in 12 years. During the 2020 campaign, which was shortened due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Greyhounds were a perfect 5-0 on the year, defeating four ranked opponents and earning their highest end-of-year national ranking (No. 3) in the IWLCA Coaches' poll since 2003.

Since coming to Loyola, Adams has directed a resurgence of the program back to national prominence. Her 2011 squad won its first of two-straight BIG EAST Championships, returned to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2004 and tied a school record for wins in a season, posting a 17-3 record.

In conference play, Adams' squads have dominated. In the last seven completed seasons, her teams have posted an overall record of 58-2 in regular-season conference contests, including an unblemished 52-0 mark in Patriot League play for six-straight undefeated Patriot League Regular Season titles - the longest active win streak in the NCAA. Her Greyhounds have also claimed six league tournament titles - back-to-back BIG EAST Championships (2011, 2012) and four Patriot League titles (2014, 2015, 2016, 2019). The BIG EAST title in 2011 was the first for the program, while 2014 win was the school's first-ever Patriot League Championship, a League it joined for the 2013-14 school year.

Nationally, nine of Adams' squads have began the season ranked in the top-15 of the IWLCA Preseason Coaches Poll, while Loyola's stretch of four-straight years ranked in the preseason top-10 made the Greyhounds one of just seven programs in the NCAA to be ranked among the nation's top-10 teams from 2012-15.

As a member of the BIG EAST Conference, Adams picked up co-BIG EAST Coach of the Year honors in 2011 and led the Greyhounds to back-to-back BIG EAST Tournament titles, a 27-12 record in conference games and a 4-2 mark in tournament action.

Adams didn't miss a beat in transitioning to the Patriot League in 2014. Tabbed as the League's preseason favorite each of her first eight years, Adams has been named the League's Coach of the Year five times (2014, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019) and brought 14 major awards to the Greyhounds,

BEFORE LOYOLA

Prior to coming to Loyola, Adams served as the associate head coach under Cathy Reese at the University of Maryland during the 2007 and 2008 seasons. She was also an assistant to Reese at the University of Denver from 2004-06.

COACHING INTERNATIONALLY

Adams took a break from the college game during the summer of 2012 and 2015 and assisted her sister, Trish, at the Under-19 World Championships. The Adams duo led the U-19 Australian National Team to a silver medal in 2012 and to the semifinals in 2015. She served as the Australian's U-19 Co-Head Coach with former Greyhound Stacey (Morlang) Sullivan at the 2019 World Championships.

AS A PLAYER

Adams is regarded as the finest female lacrosse player of all time. Putting together arguably the greatest collegiate women's lacrosse career in the sport's history, Adams led Maryland to four-straight national titles from 1998-2001, including a 21-0 record in 1999 and a 23-0 mark in 2001. She racked up honors like she scored goals and recorded assists, and was named to the NCAA Division I Women's Lacrosse 25th Anniversary Team in April 2007.

The Brighton, South Australia native, was a three-time national player of the year and was the first recipient of the Tewaaraton Trophy in 2001. She set every scoring record for the Terrapins - season and career - finishing her storied career with 267 goals, 178 assists and 445 total points. Her marks for total points stands today as an NCAA record and her goals

total is still a record at Maryland.

In addition to her career marks, Adams had single-season performances that also rank amongst the best in Maryland and NCAA history. During her Tewaaraton-winning senior season, Adams led the nation with 88 goals, 60 assists and 148 total points, setting school single-season marks in the process. Those season totals only added her name one rung higher, as she had set school records with 81 goals, 55 assists and 136 total points the previous season.

Adams' efforts were not limited just to the lacrosse field. In addition to her three All-America honors as a player, Adams earned the 2000 and 2001 Honda/Broderick Award for women's lacrosse excellence in the classroom and on the field. She also garnered CoSIDA Academic All-America First Team honors as a senior, was named the National Attacker of the Year in 1999, 2000 and 2001 and the Atlantic Coast Conference Female Athlete of the Year in 2000 and 2001.
