THE MATCHUP

- Loyola women's lacrosse is back in the Patriot League Championship game for a seventh time in as many seasons, as the Greyhounds host Lehigh at 12:30 p.m. on Saturday looking for a fifth conference title during that span.
- Loyola (10-2) enters on a 10-game winning streak, the program's longest since a 16-game run in 2015, following a 17-6 victory over Colgate in Thursday's semifinal. The Greyhounds are ranked No. 9 in the IWLCA Coaches' and No. 11 in the ILWomen media polls.
- Lehigh (9-3) edged out Navy 13-12 in overtime in Monday's quarterfinal round, and held off Army by a 10-8 margin in the semifinals. The Mountain Hawks are looking for their second Patriot League title, with the first coming back in 1994.
- This will be the second Patriot League tournament between the two sides, with Loyola earning a 13-8 victory during the 2016 semifinal round.

LAST TIME OUT

- Loyola quickly took control of Thursday's semifinal against Colgate, scoring 12 of the game's first 13 goals en route to its 11-goal win.
- Livy Rosenzweig** led the way with four goals, four assists and six draw controls for Loyola, while **Jillian Wilson** added three goals, seven draws and four caused turnovers.
- Kaitlyn Larsson** made seven saves with a .538 save pct. across the first 51:01 in goal, and **Elli Kluegel** chipped in two goals, four grounds balls and two caused turnovers.
- The Greyhounds committed a season-low 10 turnovers, and they held their opponent to single-digit scoring for an eighth time in their current 10-game winning run.

PATRIOT LEAGUE TOURNAMENT HISTORY



- The Greyhounds are 11-2 all-time in Patriot League tournament play, winning championships in 2014, 2015, 2016 and 2019.
- Loyola's only two defeats came against Navy in the 2017 and 2018 championship games. Including regular season contests, the Greyhounds are 68-2 against Patriot League opponents since joining the conference in 2014.
- Loyola won its most-recent title with a 21-9 victory over Navy in the 2019 final. Tournament MVP **Hannah Powers** set championship records for goals (6) and points (9) while **Livy Rosenzweig** supplied two goals and six assists.

LOOKING AHEAD

- Sunday's NCAA Tournament selection show will air at 9 p.m. Sunday night on ESPNU, with first round games set to begin next Friday across eight host sites.

SERIES HISTORY

- Loyola leads 14-4 in a series which dates back to 1982.
- The Greyhounds have won the last 11 meetings, including all eight matchups since joining the Patriot League in 2014.
- Loyola edged out a 15-11 victory in the regular season meeting at Ridley on April 3, with the Greyhounds scoring four of the final six goals after Lehigh had pulled within 10-9 with 11:42 remaining.
- Caitlyn Gunn scored two of those four key goals to close out regulation, while Livy Rosenzweig totaled six points (2 G, 4 A) and eight draw controls in the victory.

SCOUTING LEHIGH

- The Mountain Hawks (9-3) have won nine of their last 10 games overall, with the lone defeat coming to Loyola during that stretch.
- Gr. M Sondra Dickey, a Tewaaron Award watch list candidate and the Patriot League Midfielder of the Year, ranks second nationally in caused turnovers per game (3.08). She also leads Lehigh in points (41 G, 7 A), goals, draws (53) and ground balls (37).
- Lehigh's 12.17 turnovers per game are the eighth fewest in DI, and the Mountain Hawks are also eighth nationally in clear % (91.1).
- Six different players have scored 25+ points this season for Jill Redfern, who was named Patriot League Coach of the Year for a third time in her 13 years at the helm.

ROSENZWEIG NAMED TEWAARATON TOP-25 SEMIFINALIST

- For the second time in her Loyola career, **Livy Rosenzweig** is a Top-25 semifinalist for the women's lacrosse Tewaaron Award.
- Rosenzweig leads Loyola with 69 points (28 G, 41 A), and she has totaled 5+ points in every contest during Loyola's winning streak.
- Now at 314 career points, she is four away from surpassing former teammate Hannah Powers for Loyola's all-time record. Her 175 career assists are also a team record, and she is only three assists away from passing Navy's Kelly Larkin to become the Patriot League's all-time leader.**
- In addition to her offensive prowess, Rosenzweig ranks third in team history with 271 career draw controls. She has won a team-high 70 draws this season (5.8/gm).

QUICK NOTES FROM COLGATE

- Loyola finished the afternoon with a 14-9 edge in draw controls. The Greyhounds have out-drawn their opponents in 9 of 12 games this season, and they rank ninth nationally in draw control percentage (59.3%).
- Nine different Greyhounds scored in the win. **Caitlyn Gunn** (2 G) and **Catie Corolla** (2 G) each recorded their second multi-goal games of the season.
- Anna Ruby** picked up her first collegiate assist after setting up an **Alanna Wray** goal with 46 seconds remaining in regulation.
- Jillian Wilson** (95 career points, 69 G, 26 A) is now five points away from 100 after registering her second hat trick of the season.
- Loyola has outscored opponents by a combined margin of 169-63 during its current 10-game winning streak.
- Loyola is now 19-1 in its last 20 games at Ridley Athletic Complex dating back to the start of the 2019 season.

ROSENZWEIG, DETWILER, LARSSON WIN MAJOR PL AWARDS

- Loyola accounted for three of the six 2021 major award winners announced by the Patriot League on Monday, as **Livy Rosenzweig** was chosen as the Attacker of the Year, **Katie Detwiler** was named Defensive Player of the Year and **Kaitlyn Larsson** took home Goalkeeper of the Year accolades.
- Rosenzweig leads Division I in assists per game (3.42) and she is also the Patriot League's overall leader with 69 points (28 G, 41 A). She was previously named Rookie of the Year back in 2018.
- Detwiler was included on the watch list for this year's Tewaaron Award and has won three PL Defensive POW awards this season. She has been matched up against three fellow watch list candidates during Loyola's winning run, shutting down Drexel's Karson Harris (1 G, 1 A, 3 TO), Navy's Nicole Victory (0 G, 2 A, 3 TO) and Lehigh's Sondra Dickey (3 G, 0 A).
- An ILWomen Second Team Preseason All-American this spring, Larsson leads the conference and ranks fifth nationally in GAA (8.02), and she is ninth nationally in save percentage (.506).

EIGHT GREYHOUNDS NAMED ALL-PATRIOT LEAGUE

- Loyola's major award trio also earned First Team All-Patriot League honors, where they were joined by teammates **Sam Fiedler**, **Jillian Wilson** and **Meaghan Quinn**.
- Elli Kluegel** and **Emily Wills** were honored as second team All-Patriot League performers. The Greyhounds' eight all-conference selections were the most in the Patriot League.
- A Tewaaron Award watch list candidate, Fiedler scored multiple goals in all 10 appearances before suffering a season ending injury on April 16. She totaled 45 points (32 G, 13 A), 14 ground balls, 11 caused turnovers and a .667 shot percentage which is the third highest in Division I.
- Wilson has 3+ points in nine of her last 10 appearances, and she has won at least four draws in every game during Loyola's winning streak. She leads the team in caused turnovers (16), ranks second in draws (55) and is third in both points (39, 23 G, 16 A) and ground balls (17).
- Quinn receives her first-career All-Patriot League recognition in her fifth year with the program. A two-time Defensive POW this spring, she is among the team leaders in ground balls per game (2.0, 18 total) and caused turnovers per game (1.1, 10 total) while aiding a backline which has surrendered single-digit goals in eight of the last 10 contests.

EYES ON ANOTHER NCAA BID

- A Patriot League championship would clinch Loyola's ninth NCAA tournament appearance in the last 10 years under head coach **Jen Adams**.
- The Greyhounds were ranked ninth in the most-recent RPI rankings released by the NCAA on Monday.
- Loyola has won at least one NCAA tournament game in seven of its eight appearances under Adams, including runs to the NCAA Quarterfinals in 2011, 2012 and 2015.
- Loyola has made 21 NCAA appearances overall in program history, advancing as far as the NCAA championship game back in 1997.

MORE ON ROSENZWEIG

- Livy Rosenzweig** was previously a Tewaaraton Award semifinalist in 2019, when she earned first team IWLCFA All-America accolades after setting single-season program records in points (116) and assists (70).
- The Preseason Patriot League Offensive Player of the Year and a US Lacrosse Preseason First Team All-American, Rosenzweig is currently ranked first nationally in assists per game (3.42), and she is sixth in points per game (5.75).
- She has recorded at least one point in 51-consecutive games, she has multiple assists in 49 of 59 career appearances and she has 11 career 8+ point games.

KLUEGEL NAMED PATRIOT LEAGUE WLAX SCHOLAR-ATHLETE OF THE YEAR

- Senior **Elli Kluegel** became the fifth Greyhound in the last six years to be named the Patriot League's Women's Lacrosse Scholar-Athlete of the Year on Wednesday. A biology major/innovation and entrepreneurship minor, she is the lone Loyola senior student-athlete to maintain a 4.0 GPA.
- Kluegel was previously named Second Team All-Patriot League on Monday. She is tied for fourth on the team with 29 points (23 G, 6 A), leads Loyola in ground balls (25) and ranks second in caused turnovers (14).
- Kluegel was joined on the Academic All-Patriot League Team by teammates **Katie Detwiler** (marketing major, 3.57 GPA), **Sam Fiedler** (finance major, 3.81 GPA) and **Kaitlyn Larsson** (finance major, 3.64 GPA).
- Loyola's four academic team selections led the Patriot League.

WILLS SURGING INTO POSTSEASON

- Emily Wills**, the lone Loyola sophomore to earn All-Patriot League accolades this season, totaled 16 points (11 G, 5 A) in the final four games of the regular season. She recorded back-to-back hat tricks in key division wins over Navy and Lehigh, and added a season-high six points (4 G, 2 A) vs. Bucknell on April 16.
- Wills has 29 points (18 G, 11 A) overall on the year, and she is third on the team with a .562 shot percentage. She has recorded multiple points in nine of her last 10 appearances.

PRESEASON ACCOLADES

- Loyola topped the Patriot League preseason poll for an eighth-consecutive season, with the Greyhounds receiving 162 points and all 18 available first-place votes.
- Livy Rosenzweig** was named Patriot League Preseason Offensive Player of the Year for a second time (previously in 2019), while **Katie Detwiler** earned Preseason Defensive Player of the Year accolades.
- Rosenzweig, Detwiler, **Sam Fiedler**, **Elli Kluegel** and **Jillian Wilson** were all Preseason All-Patriot League selections.
- Rosenzweig and Detwiler were two of US Lacrosse's 13 First Team Preseason All-Americans announced in December.
- Rosenzweig, Detwiler and **Kaitlyn Larsson** were all ILWomen Second Team Preseason All-Americans. Fiedler and **Shay Clevenger** landed on the third team, while Wilson received honorable mention recognition.

SMART HOUNDS

- Loyola has a cumulative team GPA of 3.63, including an impressive 3.76 average during the 2020 fall semester. That semester total was the highest among Loyola's 10 women's programs.
- Emily Beier**, **Catie Corolla**, **Caitlyn Gunn**, **Meg Hillman** and **Elli Kluegel** all recorded perfect 4.0 GPA's, while **D.A. Coss** (3.93), **Sam Fiedler** (3.93), **Regan Kiemeyer** (3.93), **Anna Ruby** (3.92), **Izzy Sedwick** (3.94) and **Jillian Wilson** (3.93) were all above a 3.9.
- Kluegel and Corolla both have cumulative 4.0 GPA's.

PATRIOT LEAGUE DOMINANCE

- Loyola is 57-0 against Patriot League opponents in regular season play since joining the conference. That run is the longest active win streak in Division I.
- The Greyhounds outscored Patriot League opposition by a combined 91-27 during their five victories this spring.
- The NCAA record for consecutive conference wins is a 61-game streak by UMass in Atlantic 10 play which began in 2011 and ended on April 22, 2018.
- The Greyhounds claimed PL championships in each of their first three years in the conference (2014-16), and added a fourth postseason title in 2019.

HIGH-POWERED OFFENSE LAST SPRING

- Loyola's 17.6 goals per game during the shortened 2020 season ranked sixth in all of Division I. The Greyhounds scored at least 14 goals in all five victories, and outscored opponents by an overall margin of 88-50.
- Loyola was also ranked in the top 10 nationally in assists (8.8) and draw controls (16.6) per game.
- The Greyhounds made the most of their scoring attempts, with **Emily Wills** (5th, .706) and **Jillian Wilson** (12th, .654) among the nation's leaders in shot percentage. **Sam Fiedler**, who led DI with a .671 shot percentage in 2019, was not far behind at .576 last spring.

DETWILER, ROSENZWEIG INVITED TO U.S. NATIONAL TEAM TRYOUTS

- **Katie Detwiler** and **Livy Rosenzweig** were two of 50 candidates across the country invited to compete for spots on the U.S. National Team at the 2022 World Championships. The tryouts, originally scheduled for December 2020, will now take place later in 2021, with the World Championships scheduled for June 29-July 9, 2022 in Towson, Md.
- Detwiler was previously part of the U.S. U19 training team in 2019.

STRONG DEBUT FOR CLEVINGER

- **Shay Clevenger** joined Loyola as a transfer in 2020 after spending her freshman season at Louisville, and the Woodstock, Md., native quickly made herself at home with the Greyhounds.
- Clevenger led the Patriot League and ranked 22nd nationally with 3.2 ground balls per game. She had 16 ground balls overall and was also tied for the team lead with seven caused turnovers.
- Clevenger was honored as PL Defender of the Week after picking up a career-high six ground balls and causing two turnovers in the season finale at Penn.

2021 CAPTAINS

- **Katie Detwiler**, **Elli Kluegel**, **Holly Lloyd** and **Livy Rosenzweig** will serve as Loyola's team captains for the 2021 season.
- The group is comprised of one graduate student (Lloyd), two seniors (Kluegel, Rosenzweig) and one junior (Detwiler). All four were previously captains for the shortened 2020 campaign.

HEAD COACH JEN ADAMS

Innovative. Difference-Maker. Creative. Stellar. Spectacular: All words used to describe Jen Adams throughout her illustrious playing career on the collegiate and international levels. Those same adjectives hold true for her coaching and leadership styles as she enters her 13th season at the helm of the Loyola women's lacrosse program in 2021.

AT LOYOLA

Entering the 2021 season, Adams has a career record of 158-66 in 12 years. During the 2020 campaign, which was shortened due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Greyhounds were a perfect 5-0 on the year, defeating four ranked opponents and earning their highest end-of-year national ranking (No. 3) in the IWLCA Coaches' poll since 2003.

Since coming to Loyola, Adams has directed a resurgence of the program back to national prominence. Her 2011 squad won its first of two-straight BIG EAST Championships, returned to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2004 and tied a school record for wins in a season, posting a 17-3 record.

In conference play, Adams' squads have dominated. In the last seven completed seasons, her teams have posted an overall record of 58-2 in regular-season conference contests, including an unblemished 52-0 mark in Patriot League play for six-straight undefeated Patriot League Regular Season titles - the longest active win streak in the NCAA. Her Greyhounds have also claimed six league tournament titles - back-to-back BIG EAST Championships (2011, 2012) and four Patriot League titles (2014, 2015, 2016, 2019). The BIG EAST title in 2011 was the first for the program, while 2014 win was the school's first-ever Patriot League Championship, a League it joined for the 2013-14 school year.

Nationally, nine of Adams' squads have began the season ranked in the top-15 of the IWLCA Preseason Coaches Poll, while Loyola's stretch of four-straight years ranked in the preseason top-10 made the Greyhounds one of just seven programs in the NCAA to be ranked among the nation's top-10 teams from 2012-15.

As a member of the BIG EAST Conference, Adams picked up co-BIG EAST Coach of the Year honors in 2011 and led the Greyhounds to back-to-back BIG EAST Tournament titles, a 27-12 record in conference games and a 4-2 mark in tournament action.

Adams didn't miss a beat in transitioning to the Patriot League in 2014. Tabbed as the League's preseason favorite each of her first eight years, Adams has been named the League's Coach of the Year five times (2014, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019) and brought 14 major awards to the Greyhounds,

BEFORE LOYOLA

Prior to coming to Loyola, Adams served as the associate head coach under Cathy Reese at the University of Maryland during the 2007 and 2008 seasons. She was also an assistant to Reese at the University of Denver from 2004-06.

COACHING INTERNATIONALLY

Adams took a break from the college game during the summer of 2012 and 2015 and assisted her sister, Trish, at the Under-19 World Championships. The Adams duo led the U-19 Australian National Team to a silver medal in 2012 and to the semifinals in 2015. She served as the Australian's U-19 Co-Head Coach with former Greyhound Stacey (Morlang) Sullivan at the 2019 World Championships.

AS A PLAYER

Adams is regarded as the finest female lacrosse player of all time. Putting together arguably the greatest collegiate women's lacrosse career in the sport's history, Adams led Maryland to four-straight national titles from 1998-2001, including a 21-0 record in 1999 and a 23-0 mark in 2001. She racked up honors like she scored goals and recorded assists, and was named to the NCAA Division I Women's Lacrosse 25th Anniversary Team in April 2007.

The Brighton, South Australia native, was a three-time national player of the year and was the first recipient of the Tewaaraton Trophy in 2001. She set every scoring record for the Terrapins - season and career - finishing her storied career with 267 goals, 178 assists and 445 total points. Her marks for total points stands today as an NCAA record and her goals

total is still a record at Maryland.

In addition to her career marks, Adams had single-season performances that also rank amongst the best in Maryland and NCAA history. During her Tewaaraton-winning senior season, Adams led the nation with 88 goals, 60 assists and 148 total points, setting school single-season marks in the process. Those season totals only added her name one rung higher, as she had set school records with 81 goals, 55 assists and 136 total points the previous season.

Adams' efforts were not limited just to the lacrosse field. In addition to her three All-America honors as a player, Adams earned the 2000 and 2001 Honda/Broderick Award for women's lacrosse excellence in the classroom and on the field. She also garnered CoSIDA Academic All-America First Team honors as a senior, was named the National Attacker of the Year in 1999, 2000 and 2001 and the Atlantic Coast Conference Female Athlete of the Year in 2000 and 2001.
