#### THE MATCHUP

- Loyola women's lacrosse, which is hosting the Patriot League Final Four for a seventh time in as many seasons, begins its quest for a fifth tournament championship with Thursday's semifinal matchup against Colgate.
- The Greyhounds (9-2) enter on a nine-game winning streak, the program's longest since a 16-game run in 2015. They are ranked No. 9 in the IWLCA Coaches' and No. 11 in the ILWomen media polls.
- Colgate (5-5) advanced to the semifinals following a 15-13 victory over Boston University in Monday's quarterfinal round. The teams previously met in the 2019 semis, with Loyola topping the Raiders by a 20-12 final at Ridley.
- North division No. 1 seed Army West Point (5-3) will face South No. 2 Lehigh (8-3) in Thursday's other semifinal at 7 p.m.

#### **LAST TIME OUT**

- **Elli Kluegel** became the 32nd player in program history to reach 100 career goals, and **Jillian Wilson** scored a career-high five times during a 17-6 victory for Loyola over Furman on April 25.
- **Livy Rosenzweig** added five points (1 G, 4 A) and nine draws for Loyola, which halted an eight-game winning streak for the visiting Paladins (11-4).
- All five of Wilson's goals came in the first half, as Loyola raced out to a 12-2 lead during the opening 30 minutes. She also added a team-high three caused turnovers, three ground balls and four draw controls.
- Kluegel's milestone marker came with 14:09 left on the last of her five goals for the afternoon. That matched a career-high, while her six points were a new career best.

#### PATRIOT LEAGUE TOURNAMENT HISTORY

- The Greyhounds are 10-2 all-time in Patriot League tournament play, winning championships in 2014, 2015, 2016 and 2019.
- Loyola's only two defeats came against Navy in the 2017 and 2018 championship games. Including regular season contests, the Greyhounds are 67-2 against Patriot League opponents since joining the conference in 2014.
- Loyola won its most-recent title with a 21-9 victory over Navy in the 2019 final. Tournament MVP Hannah Powers set championship records for goals (6) and points (9) while Livy Rosenzweig supplied two goals and six assists.

#### **SERIES HISTORY**

- Loyola leads 9-0 in a series which dates back to 1981.
- The Greyhounds are 7-0 against Colgate since joining the Patriot League, with the closest contest during that span an 11-6 road win on April 2, 2016.
- This will be the second PL tournament meeting between the two sides. **Hannah Powers** (8 G, 1 A) and **Livy Rosenzweig** (4 G, 4 A) led the offense in Loyola's 20-12 semifinal victory in 2019.

#### **SCOUTING COLGATE**

- The Raiders, who finished second in the Patriot League's North division standings, snapped a four-game losing streak with their 15-13 win over Boston U on Monday. The last of a season-high five goals for Fr. M Eliza Farriss broke a 13-13 tie with 6:25 remaining.
- Colgate faced two South division opponents in the regular season, falling 13-11 to Bucknell and 12-5 to Navy on back-to-back weekends in April.
- Fr. GK Amelia Cunningham, the Patriot League's Rookie of the Year, leads the conference in saves (87) and is ranked fourth in both GAA (11.13) and save percentage (.442).
- Colgate leads the conference and is ranked 13th nationally in draw controls per game (15.6). Individual leaders are So. M Cara O'Reilly (58, 5.8/gm) and Gr. M Noelle Patterson (38, 3.8/gm).

#### **ROSENZWEIG NAMED TEWAARATON TOP-25 SEMIFINALIST**

- For the second time in her Loyola career, Livy Rosenzweig is a Top-25 semifinalist for the women's lacrosse Tewaaraton Award.
- The award annually honors the top male and female college lacrosse player in the United States. Rosenzweig leads the Greyhounds with 61 points (24 G, 37 A), and she has totaled 5+ points in every contest during Loyola's winning streak.
- Now at 306 career points, she is 12 away from surpassing former teammate Hannah Powers for Loyola's all-time record. Her 171 career assists are also a team record, and she is only seven assists away from becoming the Patriot League's all-time leader.
- In addition to her offensive prowess, Rosenzweig ranks third in team history with 265 career draw controls. She has won a teamhigh 64 draws this season (5.8/qm).

#### **QUICK NOTES FROM FURMAN**

- Loyola won a season-high 19 draws (19-8 overall), led by Livy Rosenzweig (9), Katie Detwiler (6) and Jillian Wilson (4).
- **Elli Kluegel** (3-4 FPS) became the first Greyhound to score three free position goals since 3/15/18, when she had three in a 19-18 win over No. 8 Virginia.
- Senior **Emily Beier** (2 G) recorded her first multi-goal game in her 47th collegiate appearance.
- Meaghan Quinn matched Wilson for the team lead with three ground balls, and she held Furman's leading scorer Kyra LaMotte (52 G overall) to a single goal on four shots.
- Loyola has outscored opponents by a combined margin of 152-57 during its current nine-game winning streak.
- Loyola is now 18-1 in its last 19 games at Ridley Athletic Complex dating back to the start of the 2019 season.

#### ROSENZWEIG, DETWILER, LARSSON WIN MAJOR PL AWARDS

- Loyola accounted for three of the six 2021 major award winners announced by the Patriot League on Monday, as Livy Rosenzweig was chosen as the Attacker of the Year, Katie Detwiler was named Defensive Player of the Year and Kaitlyn Larsson took home Goalkeeper of the Year accolades.
- Rosenzweig leads the Patriot League and ranks second nationally in assists per game (3.36) and she is also the conference's overall leader with 61 points (24 G, 37 A). She was previously named Rookie of the Year back in 2018.
- Detwiler was included on the watch list for this year's Tewaaraton Award and has won three PL Defensive POW awards this season. She has been matched up against three fellow watch list candidates during Loyola's winning run, shutting down Drexel's Karson Harris (1 G, 1 A, 3 TO), Navy's Nicole Victory (0 G, 2 A, 3 TO) and Lehigh's Sondra Dickey (3 G, 0 A).
- An ILWomen Second Team Preseason All-American this spring, Larsson leads the conference and ranks sixth nationally in GAA (8.11), and she is 10th nationally in save percentage (.503)

#### **EIGHT GREYHOUNDS NAMED ALL-PATRIOT LEAGUE**

- Loyola's major award trio also earned First Team All-Patriot League honors, where they were joined by teammates Sam Fiedler, Jillian Wilson and Meaghan Quinn.
- Elli Kluegel and Emily Wills were honored as second team All-Patriot League performers. The Greyhounds' eight all-conference selections were the most in the Patriot League.
- A Tewaaraton Award watch list candidate, Fiedler scored multiple goals in all 10 appearances before suffering a season ending injury on April 16. She totaled 45 points (32 G, 13 A), 14 ground balls, 11 caused turnovers and a .667 shot percentage which is the third highest in Division I.
- Wilson has 3+ points in eight of her last nine appearances, and she has won at least four draws in every game during Loyola's winning streak. She is tied for the team lead in caused turnovers (12), ranks second in draws (48) and is third in both points (36, 20 G, 16 A) and ground balls (16).
- Quinn receives her first-career All-Patriot League recognition in her fifth year
  with the program. A two-time Defensive POW this spring, she leads the Greyhounds in ground balls per game (2.1, 17 total) and caused turnovers per game
  (1.3, 10 total) while aiding a backline which has surrendered single-digit goals
  in seven of the last nine contests.

#### **EYES ON ANOTHER NCAA BID**

- A Patriot League championship would clinch Loyola's ninth NCAA tournament appearance in the last 10 years under head coach Jen Adams.
- The Greyhounds were ranked ninth in the most-recent RPI rankings released by the NCAA on Monday.
- Loyola has won at least one NCAA tournament game in seven of its eight appearances under Adams, including runs to the NCAA Quarterfinals in 2011, 2012 and 2015.
- Loyola has made 21 NCAA appearances overall in program history, advancing as far as the NCAA championship game back in 1997.

#### MORE ON ROSENZWEIG

- **Livy Rosenzweig** was previously a Tewaaraton Award semifinalist in 2019, when she earned first team IWLCA All-America accolades after setting single-season program records in points (116) and assists (70).
- The Preseason Patriot League Offensive Player of the Year and a US Lacrosse Preseason First Team All-American, Rosenzweig is currently ranked second nationally in assists per game (3.36), and she is 10th in points per game (5.55).
- She has recorded at least one point in 50-consecutive games, she has multiple assists in 48 of 58 career appearances and she has 10 career 8+ point games.

#### KLUEGEL EXCELS ON. OFF THE FIELD

- Senior **Elli Kluegel** was named Second Team All-Patriot League for the first time in her career on Monday. She has totaled 20 goals during Loyola's current nine-game win streak, and she continues to lead the Greyhounds in ground balls (21) and caused turnovers (12).
- Kluegel has 27 points (21 G, 6 A) this spring, and will enter the postseason on a nine-game goal scoring streak.
- Off the field, Kluegel continues to maintain a perfect 4.0 GPA while majoring in biology. A two-time COSIDA Academic All-District honoree, she was also an Academic All-Patriot League selection in 2019.

#### WILLS SURGING INTO POSTSEASON

- **Emily Wills**, the lone Loyola sophomore to earn All-Patriot League accolades this season, totaled 16 points (11 G, 5 A) in the final four games of the regular season. She recorded back-to-back hat tricks in key division wins over Navy and Lehigh, and added a season-high six points (4 G, 2 A) vs. Bucknell on April 16.
- Wills has 27 points (17 G, 10 A) overall on the year, and she is second on the team with a .607 shot percentage. She has recorded multiple points in eight of her last nine appearances.

#### **PRESEASON ACCOLADES**

- Loyola topped the Patriot League preseason poll for an eighth-consecutive season, with the Greyhounds receiving 162 points and all 18 available firstplace votes.
- Livy Rosenzweig was named Patriot League Preseason Offensive Player of the Year for a second time (previously in 2019), while Katie Detwiler earned Preseason Defensive Player of the Year accolades.
- Rosenzweig, Detwiler, Sam Fiedler, Elli Kluegel and Jillian Wilson were all Preseason All-Patriot League selections.
- Rosenzweig and Detwiler were two of US Lacrosse's 13 First Team Preseason All-Americans announced in December.
- Rosenzweig, Detwiler and Kaitlyn Larsson were all ILWomen Second Team Preseason All-Americans. Fiedler and Shay Clevenger landed on the third team, while Wilson received honorable mention recognition.

#### **SMART HOUNDS**

- Loyola has a cumulative team GPA of 3.63, including an impressive 3.76 average during the 2020 fall semester. That semester total was the highest among Loyola's 10 women's programs.
- Emily Beier, Catie Corolla, Caitlyn Gunn, Meg Hillman and Elli Kluegel all recorded perfect 4.0 GPA's, while D.A. Coss (3.93), Sam Fiedler (3.93), Regan Kielmeyer (3.93), Anna Ruby (3.92), Izzy Sedwick (3.94) and Jillian Wilson (3.93) were all above a 3.9.
- Kluegel and Corolla both have cumulative 4.0 GPA's; Kluegel is the lone senior Loyola student-athlete to maintain a cumulative 4.0 average.

#### **PATRIOT LEAGUE DOMINANCE**

- Loyola is 57-0 against Patriot League opponents in regular season play since joining the conference. That run is the longest active win streak in Division I.
- The Greyhounds outscored Patriot League opposition by a combined 91-27 during their five victories this spring.
- The NCAA record for consecutive conference wins is a 61-game streak by UMass in Atlantic 10 play which began in 2011 and ended on April 22, 2018.
- The Greyhounds claimed PL championships in each of their first three years in the conference (2014-16), and added a fourth postseason title in 2019.

#### **HIGH-POWERED OFFENSE LAST SPRING**

- Loyola's 17.6 goals per game during the shortened 2020 season ranked sixth in all of Division I. The Greyhounds scored at least 14 goals in all five victories, and outscored opponents by an overall margin of 88-50.
- Loyola was also ranked in the top 10 nationally in assists (8.8) and draw controls (16,6) per game.
- The Greyhounds made the most of their scoring attempts, with Emily Wills
  (5th, .706) and Jillian Wilson (12th, .654) among the nation's leaders in shot
  percentage. Sam Fiedler, who led DI with a .671 shot percentage in 2019, was
  not far behind at .576 last spring.

#### DETWILER, ROSENZWEIG INVITED TO U.S. NATIONAL TEAM TRYOUTS

- Katie Detwiler and Livy Rosenzweig were two of 50 candidates across the
  country invited to compete for spots on the U.S. National Team at the 2022
  World Championships. The tryouts, originally scheduled for December 2020,
  will now take place later in 2021, with the World Championships scheduled for
  June 29-July 9, 2022 in Towson, Md.
- Detwiler was previously part of the U.S. U19 training team in 2019.

#### STRONG DEBUT FOR CLEVENGER

- Shay Clevenger joined Loyola as a transfer in 2020 after spending her freshman season at Louisville, and the Woodstock, Md., native quickly made herself at home with the Greyhounds.
- Clevenger led the Patriot League and ranked 22nd nationally with 3.2 ground balls per game. She had 16 ground balls overall and was also tied for the team lead with seven caused turnovers.
- Clevenger was honored as PL Defender of the Week after picking up a careerhigh six ground balls and causing two turnovers in the season finale at Penn.

#### **2021 CAPTAINS**

- Katie Detwiler, Elli Kluegel, Holly Lloyd and Livy Rosenzweig will serve as Loyola's team captains for the 2021 season.
- The group is comprised of one graduate student (Lloyd), two seniors (Kluegel, Rosenzweig) and one junior (Detwiler). All four were previously captains for the shortened 2020 campaign.

## **HEAD COACH JEN ADAMS**

**Innovative. Difference-Maker. Creative. Stellar. Spectacular:** All words used to describe Jen Adams throughout her illustrious playing career on the collegiate and international levels. Those same adjectives hold true for her coaching and leadership styles as she enters her 13th season at the helm of the Loyola women's lacrosse program in 2021.

#### AT LOYOLA

Entering the 2021 season, Adams has a career record of 158-66 in 12 years. During the 2020 campaign, which was shortened due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Greyhounds were a perfect 5-0 on the year, defeating four ranked opponents and earning their highest end-of-year national ranking (No. 3) in the IWLCA Coaches' poll since 2003.

Since coming to Loyola, Adams has directed a resurgence of the program back to national prominence. Her 2011 squad won its first of two-straight BIG EAST Championships, returned to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2004 and tied a school record for wins in a season, posting a 17-3 record.

In conference play, Adams' squads have dominated. In the last seven completed seasons, her teams have posted an overall record of 58-2 in regular-season conference contests, including an unblemished 52-0 mark in Patriot League play for six-straight undefeated Patriot League Regular Season titles - the longest active win streak in the NCAA. Her Greyhounds have also claimed six league tournament titles - back-to-back BIG EAST Championships (2011, 2012) and four Patriot League titles (2014, 2015, 2016, 2019). The BIG EAST title in 2011 was the first for the program, while 2014 win was the school's first-ever Patriot League Championship, a League it joined for the 2013-14 school year.

Nationally, nine of Adams' squads have began the season ranked in the top-15 of the IWLCA Preseason Coaches Poll, while Loyola's stretch of four-straight years ranked in the preseason top-10 made the Greyhounds one of just seven programs in the NCAA to be ranked among the nation's top-10 teams from 2012-15.

As a member of the BIG EAST Conference, Adams picked up co-BIG EAST Coach of the Year honors in 2011 and led the Greyhounds to back-to-back BIG EAST Tournament titles, a 27-12 record in conference games and a 4-2 mark in tournament action.

Adams didn't miss a beat in transitioning to the Patriot League in 2014. Tabbed as the League's preseason favorite each of her first eight years, Adams has been named the League's Coach of the Year five times (2014, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019) and brought 14 major awards to the Greyhounds,

#### **BEFORE LOYOLA**

Prior to coming to Loyola, Adams served as the associate head coach under Cathy Reese at the University of Maryland during the 2007 and 2008 seasons. She was also an assistant to Reese at the University of Denver from 2004-06.

#### **COACHING INTERNATIONALLY**

Adams took a break from the college game during the summer of 2012 and 2015 and assisted her sister, Trish, at the Under-19 World Championships. The Adams duo led the U-19 Australian National Team to a silver medal in 2012 and to the semifinals in 2015. She served as the Australian's U-19 Co-Head Coach with former Greyhound Stacey (Morlang) Sullivan at the 2019 World Championships.

#### **AS A PLAYER**

Adams is regarded as the finest female lacrosse player of all time. Putting together arguably the greatest collegiate women's lacrosse career in the sport's history, Adams led Maryland to four-straight national titles from 1998-2001, including a 21-0 record in 1999 and a 23-0 mark in 2001. She racked up honors like she scored goals and recorded assists, and was named to the NCAA Division I Women's Lacrosse 25th Anniversary Team in April 2007.

The Brighton, South Australia native, was a three-time national player of the year and was the first recipient of the Tewaaraton Trophy in 2001. She set every scoring record for the Terrapins - season and career - finishing her storied career with 267 goals, 178 assists and 445 total points. Her marks for total points stands today as an NCAA record and her goals

total is still a record at Maryland.

In addition to her career marks, Adams had single-season performances that also rank amongst the best in Maryland and NCAA history. During her Tewaaraton-winning senior season, Adams led the nation with 88 goals, 60 assists and 148 total points, setting school single-season marks in the process. Those season totals only added her name one rung higher, as she had set school records with 81 goals, 55 assists and 136 total points the previous season.

Adams' efforts were not limited just to the lacrosse field. In addition to her three All-America honors as a player, Adams earned the 2000 and 2001 Honda/Broderick Award for women's lacrosse excellence in the classroom and on the field. She also garnered CoSIDA Academic All-America First Team honors as a senior, was named the National Attacker of the Year in 1999, 2000 and 2001 and the Atlantic Coast Conference Female Athlete of the Year in 2000 and 2001.
