### THE MATCHUP

Loyola women's lacrosse, which is ranked #8 in the latest IWLCA coaches' poll and #10 in the ILWomen media poll heads to Towson for its first road game of the season on Wednesday. The Tigers (2-0) are one of six teams receiving votes in the media poll.

### **LAST TIME OUT**

- Playing the program's first game in 350 days, Loyola opened up its 2021 campaign with a tough 18-6 defeat to #3 Syracuse over the weekend.
- Sam Fiedler registered her 15th career hat trick after totaling three goals for the Greyhounds, who suffered their first setback since the 2019 NCAA tournament.
- Fiedler's first goal tied the score at 1-1 with 21:48 left in the opening half, but Syracuse took control with a 12-2 run over the following 31 minutes of game action.
- The Orange finished with a 33-14 lead in shots and an 18-8 edge in ground balls.
- Saturday's setback ended a 12-game winning streak for Loyola at Ridley Athletic Complex dating back to May 13, 2019.

### **PRESEASON ACCOLADES**

TBD

- Loyola topped the Patriot League preseason poll for an eighth-consecutive season, with the Greyhounds receiving 162 points and all 18 available first-place votes.
- Livy Rosenzweig was named Patriot League Preseason Offensive Player of the Year for a second time (previously in 2019), while Katie Detwiler earned Preseason Defensive Player of the Year accolades.
- Rosenzweig, Detwiler, Sam Fiedler, Elli Kluegel and Jillian Wilson were all Preseason All-Patriot League selections.
- Rosenzweig and Detwiler were two of US Lacrosse's 13 First Team Preseason All-Americans announced in December.
- Rosenzweig, Detwiler and Kaitlyn Larsson were all ILWomen Second Team Preseason All-Americans. Fiedler and **Shay Clevenger** landed on the third team, while Wilson received honorable mention recognition.

### **LOOKING AHEAD**

- Loyola is back at Ridley for another top-10 matchup on Sunday, as the Greyhounds host #6 Florida at 1 p.m.
- Loyola topped the then-No. 4 Gators by a 17-6 final when the teams met in Gainesville on Feb. 22 last season.

### **SERIES HISTORY**

- Loyola leads 35-13 in a series which dates back to the Greyhounds' inaugural season in 1973.
- The Greyhounds have won six of the last eight meetings overall, including a 14-10 home triumph on Feb. 19 last season. Trailing 2-0 with 8:39 left in the first half, a Livy Rosenzweig goal began a 12-3 Greyhound run over the next 32 minutes of game action.
- Rosenzweig had a team-high five points (2 G, 3 A), while Jillian **Wilson** contributed four goals and six draw controls.
- Towson's last win in the series was a 15-8 home victory on Feb. 26, 2017.

### **SCOUTING TOWSON**

- The Tigers have defeated Mount St. Mary's (10-7) and UMBC (12-5) in their first two matchups this season.
- Towson finished with a an abbreviated record of 2-4 in 2020, ending the year with a 21-14 victory over Ohio State on March 10.
- Gr. D Sami Chenoweth was a third team IWLCA All-America selection in 2019 after leading the nation with 64 caused turnovers. Chenoweth was also an ILWomen third team Preseason All-America honoree this season.
- Chenoweth, So. M Blair Pearre and Gr. M Shelby Stack were all Preseason All-CAA selections.
- As a team, the Tigers were 20th nationally in caused turnovers per game (10.2) in 2020, and they led the CAA in assists per game (5.3).

### **ROSENZWEIG MILESTONE WATCH**

- Livy Rosenzweig has totaled 136 assists in 48 collegiate games, a total which is No. 2 all-time at Loyola (12 back of 2015 graduate Annie Thomas) and fourth all-time in the Patriot League (41 behind Navy's Kelly Larkin).
- Rosenzweig is also No. 7 all-time at Loyola in points (247). She is 30 back of Marlee Paton '14 in 6th and 70 behind former teammate Hannah Powers '19 for the top spot.
- In the 2020 finale, Rosenzweig became the third Greyhound to reach 200 career draw controls. Her 208 draws are behind only sisters Taylor VanThof '19 (392) and Taryn VanThof '15 (318).

### **QUICK NOTES FROM SYRACUSE**

- Catie Corolla netted her first collegiate goal in the second half, taking a feed from Livy Rosenzweig and beating Syracuse goalie Asa Goldstock with 14:53 left in regulation.
- With her two assists, Rosenzweig moved up to No. 7 in program history in career points (247), passing Andi Holthaus '87.
- Elli Kluegel matched a career-high with three ground balls, while **Meaghan** Quinn set a new career best with two caused turnovers.
- Rosenzweig totaled a team-high seven draw controls. She was held without a goal for only the third time in her Loyola career.
- Loyola trailed by 10+ goals in a game for the first time since May 5, 2017.

### ON THE ROAD AGAIN

- As it begins its five-game road schedule for 2021, Loyola will be looking to replicate its 2020 success away from Ridley Athletic Complex.
- The Greyhounds were 3-0 on the road last season, scoring an average of 19.3 goals per game while defeating three ranked opponents.
- Loyola was leading or tied with its opponent in 173:45 out of 180 minutes in its three road contests last spring, trailing for just 6:15 of game action.

### **CONDENSED SCHEDULE INCLUDES SEVEN GAMES AT RIDLEY**

- In response to the continuing COVID-19 pandemic, Loyola and the Patriot League have instituted several changes to the 2021 lacrosse schedule.
- Consistent with the prioritization of health and safety, the 12-game schedule features reductions in travel and overnight stays. Loyola has five non-conference opponents currently on the schedule, with three taking place at Ridley Athletic Complex and the other two short trips to Towson and Villanova.
- The Patriot League is split into two five-team divisions, with Loyola grouped in the South with American, Bucknell, Lehigh and Navy.
- The top two teams in each division advance to the PL tournament, with semifinal games set for May 6 and the championship scheduled for May 8.

### FIEDLER LOOKS TO CONTINUE OFFENSIVE SURGE

- **Sam Fiedler** was on a roll offensively at the time of last season's cancellation, totaling a team-high 20 points (16 G, 4 A) in Loyola's final three contests.
- With her five goals in the 2020 finale at Penn, she became the 31st player in team history to reach 100 for her collegiate career. Fiedler has 105 goals in 48 games at Loyola, and she has scored at least one goal in 39-straight contests.
- Fiedler was selected as the US Lacrosse Player of the Week on Feb. 24 last season after setting career-highs in both goals (7) and points (8) during Loyola's 17-6 victory at No. 4 Florida.

### HIGH-POWERED OFFENSE LAST SPRING

- Loyola's 17.6 goals per game during the shortened 2020 season ranked sixth in all of Division I. The Greyhounds scored at least 14 goals in all five victories, and outscored opponents by an overall margin of 88-50.
- Loyola was also ranked in the top 10 nationally in assists (8.8) and draw controls (16.6) per game.
- The Greyhounds made the most of their scoring attempts, with Emily Wills
  (5th, .706) and Jillian Wilson (12th, .654) among the nation's leaders in shot
  percentage. Sam Fiedler, who led DI with a .671 shot percentage in 2019, was
  not far behind at .576 last spring.

### DETWILER, ROSENZWEIG INVITED TO U.S. NATIONAL TEAM TRYOUTS

- **Katie Detwiler** and **Livy Rosenzweig** were two of 50 candidates across the country invited to compete for spots on the U.S. National Team at the 2022 World Championships.
- The tryouts, originally scheduled for December 2020, will now take place later in 2021, with the World Championships scheduled for June 29-July 9, 2022 in Towson, Md.
- Detwiler was previously part of the U.S. U19 training team in 2019. She was one of just three sophomores in the nation named to the Tewaaraton Award Watch List last season.

### **MORE ROSENZWEIG NOTES**

- **Livy Rosenzweig** became the first Greyhound to earn IWLCA first team All-America accolades since 2012 following a 2019 season in which she broke program records in both points (116) and assists (70).
- She ranked third in Division I in assists, and she was fourth nationally in points that season. She also helped Loyola lead DI as a team in both total assists (197) and assists per game (9.38).
- Rosenzweig has totaled 5+ points in 30 of 48 collegiate games, including 4 of 5 contests in 2020. She has recorded multiple points in 47 of 48 appearances.

### KLUEGEL EXCELS ON, OFF THE FIELD

- Senior **Elli Kluegel** was named to the Preseason All-Patriot League Team for a second-consecutive season on Feb. 4. Her 15 goals ranked third on the team in 2020, and she now has 80 goals in 48 career appearances.
- Off the field, Kluegel continues to maintain a perfect 4.0 GPA while majoring in biology. A two-time COSIDA Academic All-District honoree, she was also an Academic All-Patriot League selection in 2019.

### LARSSON RETURNS BETWEEN THE PIPES

- **Kaitlyn Larsson** made the most of her first five collegiate starts in goal last season, as she finished a perfect 5-0 with 53 saves, a .525 save percentage (9th in Division I) and a 9.78 goals-against average.
- Larsson made double-digit saves in four of Loyola's victories, matching a career-high with 12 in wins over Johns Hopkins (2/15) and Penn (3/7).
- Larsson has a career record of 8-1, including a 7-1 mark vs. ranked teams.

### WILLS HOPES TO BUILD ON STRONG FRESHMEN CAMPAIGN

- **Emily Wills** burst onto the scene during her debut collegiate season last spring, totaling 21 points (12 G, 9 A) while leading the Patriot League and ranking fifth nationally in shot percentage (.706).
- One of two Loyola freshmen, along with Sydney Foster, to start all five games, Wills was named PL Rookie of the Week after collecting three goals and two assists in her Greyhounds debut vs. Johns Hopkins.
- She would add both PL Attacker and Rookie of the Week honors after managing a season-high eight points (3 G, 5 A) in the finale at Penn.

### PATRIOT LEAGUE DOMINANCE

- Loyola is 52-0 against Patriot League opponents in regular season play since joining the conference. That run is the longest active win streak in Division I.
- The NCAA record for consecutive conference wins is a 61-game streak by UMass in Atlantic 10 play which began in 2011 and ended on April 22, 2018.
- The Greyhounds claimed PL championships in each of their first three years in the conference (2014-16), and added a fourth postseason title in 2019.

### **FIFTH YEAR RETURNEES**

- Two Loyola players are taking advantage of the extra year of eligibility granted by the NCAA following the shortened 2020 season, as **Holly Lloyd** and **Meaghan Quinn** both return for the Greyhounds this spring.
- Lloyd started all five games on attack for the Greyhounds last season, while Quinn was a key contributor on the backline, earning her first three collegiate starts to conclude the year.
- **Caitlyn Gunn**, who was already set to return this season after taking a medical redshirt in 2018, is also back as a graduate student after totaling three goals and two assists in a reserve attack role last spring.

### STRONG DEBUT FOR CLEVENGER

- **Shay Clevenger** joined Loyola as a transfer in 2020 after spending her freshman season at Louisville, and the Woodstock, Md., native quickly made herself at home with the Greyhounds.
- Clevenger led the Patriot League and ranked 22nd nationally with 3.2 ground balls per game. She had 16 ground balls overall and was also tied for the team lead with seven caused turnovers.
- Clevenger was honored as PL Defender of the Week after picking up a careerhigh six ground balls and causing two turnovers in the season finale at Penn.

### **SMART HOUNDS**

- Loyola has a cumulative team GPA of 3.63, including an impressive 3.76 average during the 2020 fall semester. That semester total was the highest among Loyola's 10 women's programs.
- Emily Beier, Catie Corolla, Caitlyn Gunn, Meg Hillman and Elli Kluegel all recorded perfect 4.0 GPA's, while D.A. Coss (3.93), Sam Fiedler (3.93), Regan Kielmeyer (3.93), Anna Ruby (3.92), Izzy Sedwick (3.94) and Jillian Wilson (3.93) were all above a 3.9.
- Kluegel and Corolla both have cumulative 4.0 GPA's; Kluegel is the lone senior Loyola student-athlete to maintain a cumulative 4.0 average.

### TAKING CARE OF THE BALL

- The Greyhounds ranked third in the nation in fewest turnovers per game last season, averaging 11.4 giveaways in five contests. They committed just 25 turnovers in their final three victories.
- Loyola had seven turnovers in its 17-6 win at then-No. 4 Florida on Feb. 22, which was tied for the program's second-fewest in a game dating back to the start of the 2016 season.
- Loyola's fewest turnovers in a contest during that span was six, a mark established in the 2019 Patriot League final during a 21-9 victory over Navy.

### **WELCOME TO LOYOLA**

- Eight freshmen (Sydni Black, Camryn Chew, Blake Cunneen, Izzy D'Antonio, Sarah Engle, Caitlin McGuirk, Izzy Sedwick, Alanna Wray) will join the Greyhounds for the upcoming 2021 season.
- Included in the group are six midfielders, one attacker (D'Antonio) and one defender (McGuirk).
- Five are from Maryland, with Florida, Ohio and Virginia also represented in the Class of 2024.

### **2021 CAPTAINS**

- Katie Detwiler, Elli Kluegel, Holly Lloyd and Livy Rosenzweig will serve as Loyola's team captains for the 2021 season.
- The group is comprised of one graduate student (Lloyd), two seniors (Kluegel, Rosenzweig) and one junior (Detwiler). All four were previously captains for the shortened 2020 campaign.

### **HEAD COACH JEN ADAMS**

**Innovative. Difference-Maker. Creative. Stellar. Spectacular:** All words used to describe Jen Adams throughout her illustrious playing career on the collegiate and international levels. Those same adjectives hold true for her coaching and leadership styles as she enters her 13th season at the helm of the Loyola women's lacrosse program in 2021.

### AT LOYOLA

Entering the 2021 season, Adams has a career record of 158-66 in 12 years. During the 2020 campaign, which was shortened due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Greyhounds were a perfect 5-0 on the year, defeating four ranked opponents and earning their highest end-of-year national ranking (No. 3) in the IWLCA Coaches' poll since 2003.

Since coming to Loyola, Adams has directed a resurgence of the program back to national prominence. Her 2011 squad won its first of two-straight BIG EAST Championships, returned to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2004 and tied a school record for wins in a season, posting a 17-3 record.

In conference play, Adams' squads have dominated. In the last seven completed seasons, her teams have posted an overall record of 58-2 in regular-season conference contests, including an unblemished 52-0 mark in Patriot League play for six-straight undefeated Patriot League Regular Season titles - the longest active win streak in the NCAA. Her Greyhounds have also claimed six league tournament titles - back-to-back BIG EAST Championships (2011, 2012) and four Patriot League titles (2014, 2015, 2016, 2019). The BIG EAST title in 2011 was the first for the program, while 2014 win was the school's first-ever Patriot League Championship, a League it joined for the 2013-14 school year.

Nationally, nine of Adams' squads have began the season ranked in the top-15 of the IWLCA Preseason Coaches Poll, while Loyola's stretch of four-straight years ranked in the preseason top-10 made the Greyhounds one of just seven programs in the NCAA to be ranked among the nation's top-10 teams from 2012-15.

As a member of the BIG EAST Conference, Adams picked up co-BIG EAST Coach of the Year honors in 2011 and led the Greyhounds to back-to-back BIG EAST Tournament titles, a 27-12 record in conference games and a 4-2 mark in tournament action.

Adams didn't miss a beat in transitioning to the Patriot League in 2014. Tabbed as the League's preseason favorite each of her first eight years, Adams has been named the League's Coach of the Year five times (2014, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019) and brought 14 major awards to the Greyhounds,

### **BEFORE LOYOLA**

Prior to coming to Loyola, Adams served as the associate head coach under Cathy Reese at the University of Maryland during the 2007 and 2008 seasons. She was also an assistant to Reese at the University of Denver from 2004-06.

### **COACHING INTERNATIONALLY**

Adams took a break from the college game during the summer of 2012 and 2015 and assisted her sister, Trish, at the Under-19 World Championships. The Adams duo led the U-19 Australian National Team to a silver medal in 2012 and to the semifinals in 2015. She served as the Australian's U-19 Co-Head Coach with former Greyhound Stacey (Morlang) Sullivan at the 2019 World Championships.

### **AS A PLAYER**

Adams is regarded as the finest female lacrosse player of all time. Putting together arguably the greatest collegiate women's lacrosse career in the sport's history, Adams led Maryland to four-straight national titles from 1998-2001, including a 21-0 record in 1999 and a 23-0 mark in 2001. She racked up honors like she scored goals and recorded assists, and was named to the NCAA Division I Women's Lacrosse 25th Anniversary Team in April 2007.

The Brighton, South Australia native, was a three-time national player of the year and was the first recipient of the Tewaaraton Trophy in 2001. She set every scoring record for the Terrapins - season and career - finishing her storied career with 267 goals, 178 assists and 445 total points. Her marks for total points stands today as an NCAA record and her goals

total is still a record at Maryland.

In addition to her career marks, Adams had single-season performances that also rank amongst the best in Maryland and NCAA history. During her Tewaaraton-winning senior season, Adams led the nation with 88 goals, 60 assists and 148 total points, setting school single-season marks in the process. Those season totals only added her name one rung higher, as she had set school records with 81 goals, 55 assists and 136 total points the previous season.

Adams' efforts were not limited just to the lacrosse field. In addition to her three All-America honors as a player, Adams earned the 2000 and 2001 Honda/Broderick Award for women's lacrosse excellence in the classroom and on the field. She also garnered CoSIDA Academic All-America First Team honors as a senior, was named the National Attacker of the Year in 1999, 2000 and 2001 and the Atlantic Coast Conference Female Athlete of the Year in 2000 and 2001.
