## Quick Hits About The 'Hounds

- Loyola kicks off the 2019 season with a 7 p.m. non-conference matchup against Saint Francis (Pa.) at Ridley Athletic Complex on Thursday.
  - The match marks the return of head coach **Joe Mallia** to the program. Mallia, who led the Greyhounds to five MAAC championships across seven seasons from 1998-2004, is the winningest coach in team history at 87-45-8.
  - Loyola returns seven starters from a 2018 squad which finished 6-10-1 (2-6-1 Patriot League). Two of the team's four
- All-Patriot League performers from a year ago are back this fall. So, F **Sarah Bayer** was a second team honoree, while Sr. M **Hannah Hoefs** landed on the third team.
- The Greyhounds were projected to finish seventh out of 10 teams in the Preseason Patriot League poll. The top six teams advance to the conference tournament, with Loyola looking for its first playoff appearance since reaching the Patriot League semifinals in 2015.

## Series History

- This will be the sixth meeting between the two teams, with Loyola holding a 4-1 advantage in the previous five contests.
- The teams have met in each of the previous four seasons. Each of Loyola's victories during that span came by a single goal (2-1 in 2015, 1-0 in 2016, 1-0 in 2018). St. Francis earned a 3-0 home victory during the 2017 season.
- 2019 graduate Mia Sardella accounted for the lone strike in a 1-0 Greyhound victory over the Red Flash last fall, directing in a corner kick in the 17th minute to give Loyola its first goal and win of the 2018 season.

## About The Red Flash

- St. Francis went 8-9-3 (5-2-1 NEC) last season, advancing to the Northeast Conference title game for a third year in a row before ultimately falling 2-1 to top-seeded Central Connecticut State.
- The Red Flash were 2-7-2 in road contests last fall compared to a 5-2-1 record at home.
- Three second-team all-conference players return in 2019, including Sr. F Alyssa McGhee, fifth-year GK Julia Hernan and Jr. D Aubrey Suydam. McGhee was the NEC Player of the Year in 2017; Hernan is the program's all-time leader in shutouts (23).
- Ellie Davis, previously an assistant at Sam Houston State, James Madison, St. Bonaventure and Indiana, was hired as the program's new head coach in July.

## Hoefs, Bayer Headline Offensive Returners

- Sr. M **Hannah Hoefs** (6 G, 4 A) and So. F **Sarah Bayer** (4 G, 1 A) accounted for over half of Loyola's 18 goals in 2018, and the duo will look to continue its production this fall. Hoefs ranked tied for third in the Patriot League in both goals and points (16) at the conclusion of the regular season.

## More on Mallia

- This will be new head coach **Joe Mallia's** 12th season associated with Loyola women's soccer. He was an assistant from 1994-97, helping the program claim two MAAC titles during that span, prior to taking over the head role in 1998. The Greyhounds won regular or postseason MAAC championships in nine of Mallia's previous 11 seasons on the coaching staff.
- Prior to rejoining Loyola, Mallia was an assistant at UCLA (2005-06), Tennessee (2012-15) and Navy (2016-18), and he served as head coach at Loyola Marymount (2007-11).

## 2019 Captains

- Sr. M **Maddie Hart** and Gr. M **Kate Reese** will serve as Loyola's team captains for the 2019 season.
- Hart has earned starts in 40 of her 44 career collegiate appearances, netting a pair of GWG goals as a freshman in 2016. Reese, meanwhile, was one of nine Greyhounds to appear in all 17 games last season in a reserve midfield role.

## Home Heavy Schedule

- Loyola will spend plenty of time at Ridley Athletic Complex early on in 2019, with five of the Greyhounds' first seven matches taking place at home.
- Loyola went 5-4 at Ridley last fall, including a 3-1 mark against non-conference opponents. The Greyhounds finished 1-6-1 in road contests during the 2018 season.

## Class of 2023

- Six freshmen (GK **Paige Sim**, M **Arin Sigfúsdóttir**, **MK Barnes**, **Ada Clare Tempert**, **Lea Kristjánsdóttir** and **Alex Searing**) make up Loyola's incoming Class of 2023.
- Tempert, Maryland's Gatorade Player of the Year as a senior in HS, will miss the season due to an offseason injury.
- Sim will compete with Sr. GK **Lily Andres** for playing time in goal, with an offseason injury sidelining So. GK **Grace Li** for the 2019 season.
